LED	Status
Red Light	Charging
Flashing Red Light	Low battery
Blue Light	Playing
Purple Light	Bluetooth Music is connecting status for charging
Rapid flashes of Blue Light	Searching the previous pairing
Slow flashes of Blue Light	Searching new pairing / Phone incoming call
First flashing purple light then blue light of flicker	Power On
Interlace the Red and Blue Light of flicker	Power Off

Function	Operation
Push Button	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ When playing music <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Tap to button → Pause - Tap to button again → Playing - Double tap the button → Playing the next song ➤ When phone incoming call <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Tap to button → answer call - Tap to button again → End call ➤ When Bluetooth Music don't find pair or you go away over 10 meters distance about 2 minutes , it will standby mode → Press and hold button, it will working
Micro USB Port	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ When flashing red light of Bluetooth Music, it mean low battery. You have to plug in the Micro USB Charging Cable charging.(Charge directly from your PC with Micro USB Charging Cable provided) ➤ Light is red, the Bluetooth Music is charging. ➤ When the Red Light is gone out, the Bluetooth Music is fully charging.
Reset	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Reset power

■ 1.3 Function Table

Function	Operation
Power ON/OFF	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Press and hold the power button about 3 seconds ➔ Power On ➤ Press and hold the power button again about 3 seconds ➔ Power Off ➤ When you want to search the new pairing ➔ Press Power Button
3.5mm to 3.5 female phone jack	Plug the audio cable to 3.5mm female phone jack input

2.Setting the Bluetooth Music

Step1. Connect the audio cable input on your home stereo system.

Step2. And the blue light will flash and listening to buzzer reminding when turn on the power, now Bluetooth Music is ready to be paired to your device.



Note: * Please charge the battery about 3-5hours before using the Bluetooth Music for first time.

*The Bluetooth Music can be record 5 sets of devices.

When Bluetooth Music pairs the recorder of device, it will rapid flashes of blue light.

Or when Bluetooth Music pairs the new device, it will slow flashes of blue light.

3. Pairing the Bluetooth Music

Bluetooth setup for iPhone/iPad/iPod

- Go to the Bluetooth manager of your iPhone/iPad/iPod and turn on the “Bluetooth”



1. Click the "Settings"



2. Inside the settings, tap on "General"

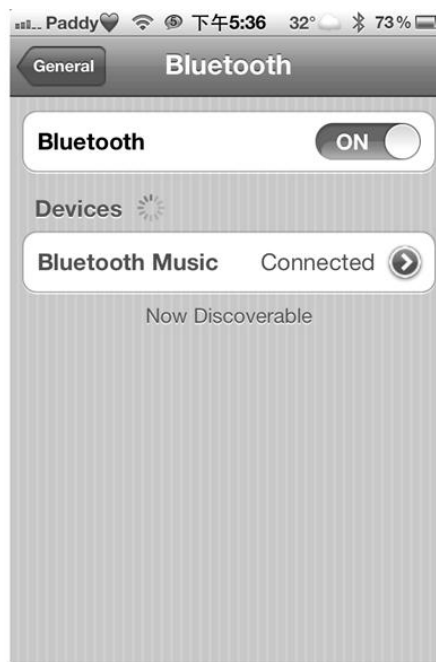


3. Inside the general, tap on "Bluetooth"

- Follow the onscreen instruction on smartphone. Click the pair, the Bluetooth Music will be connected.



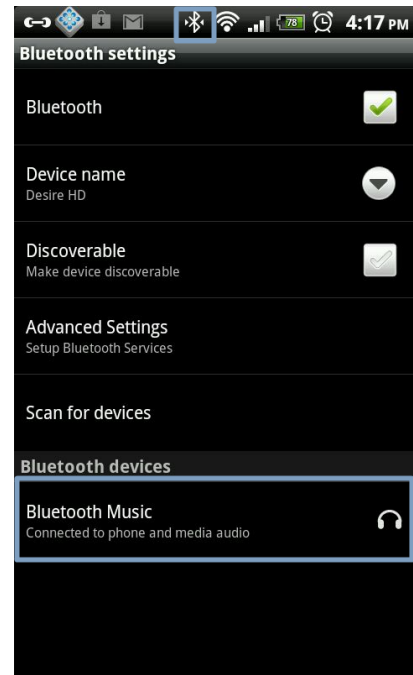
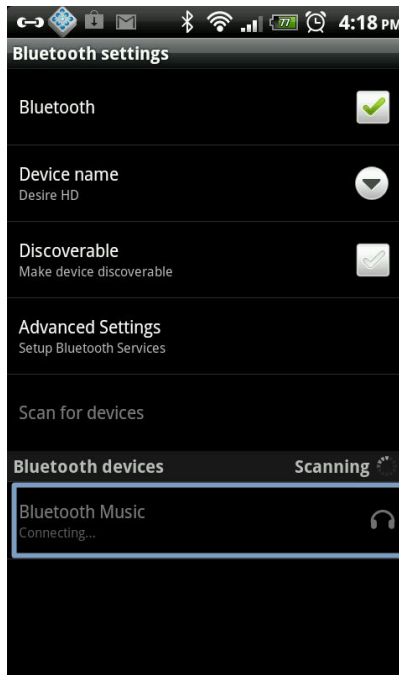
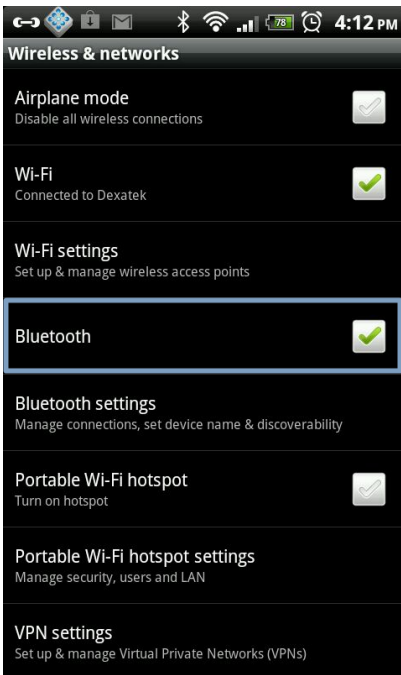
1. Click the "Pair"



2. Bluetooth Music will be connected.

Bluetooth setup for Android phone

- Go to the Bluetooth manager of your Android phone and turn on the "Bluetooth"



1. Turn on "Bluetooth"

2. You will see "Bluetooth Music" to show on screen and it's connecting.

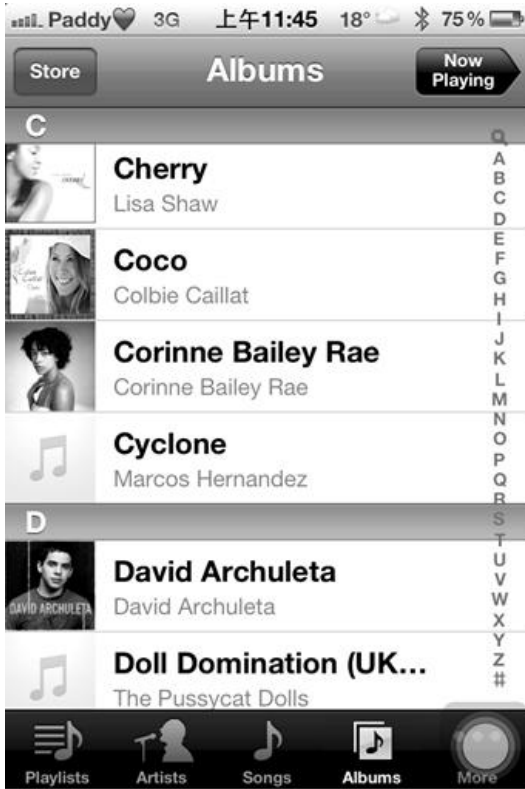
3. You'll see "Connected to phone and media audio " after connecting. This situation stands for succeeding to be pairing.

Note : If you just show "Connected to phone audio" or "Connected to media audio" on screen.

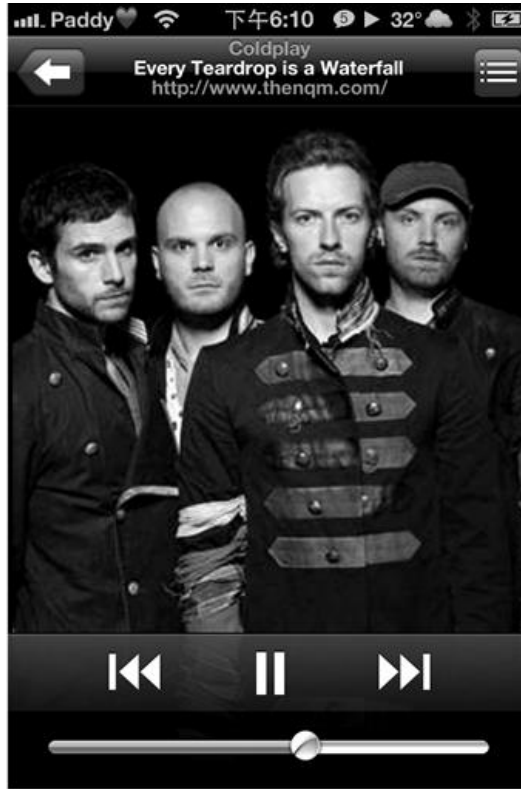
Then Bluetooth Music just have one function. Ex: If you just show "Connected to media audio" on screen, Bluetooth Music don't have phone audio function, you only play music on Bluetooth Music. And if you will meet "Connected to phone audio" or "Connected to media audio" of situation, please reconnect to Bluetooth Music or resent it.

4.Using the Bluetooth Music

1. Start playing music on your smartphone.
2. You can play/pause music on Bluetooth Music or your smartphone.
Tap the button on Bluetooth Music → Play/Pause music
Double Tap the button on Bluetooth Music → Playing the next Song
And you can directly control volume on your smartphone/stereo.
