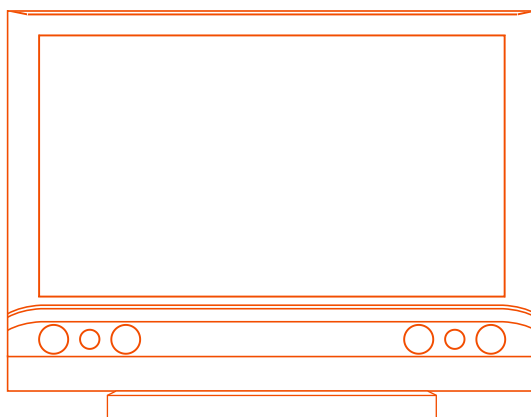



1.INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing our product. You can use it as a color television or as a PC monitor. To be able to make use of all application options, we recommend that you should read this operating manual carefully and keep it somewhere where you have quick access to it, if required.

Do not touch any parts in the set and do not make changes to any settings not described in this operating manual.

The LCD/LED screen is a high-tech product consisting of more than 900000 control elements. Any non-active red, blue or green spots that might appear on the screen occasionally have no effect on the performance of the screen.

2.WARNINGS AND SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

Warning :

To prevent damage to the TV which may result in a fire or electrical shock hazard, do not expose the TV set to rain or excessive moisture.

Do not rub or strike the Active matrix LCD with any thing hard as this may scratch, mar or damage the active matrix LCD permanently.

For safety, do not place vessels or any container which contain fluids including water, on or near the TV.

Do not insert any objects in the ventilation slots.

Service :

Do not remove the back cover of the set as this can expose you to very high voltage and other hazards. If the set does not operate properly, unplug it and call service person.

Antenna:

Connect the antenna cable to the socket marked ANT IN on the back cover. For the best reception an outdoor antenna should be used.

Location:

Position the set so that no bright light or sunlight falls directly on to the screen.

Reflections on the screen affect the picture quality.

Soft and indirect lighting is recommended for comfortable viewing.

Care should be taken not to expose the set to any unnecessary vibration, moisture, dust or heat.

Adequate ventilation is essential to prevent set failure.

Ensure that the set is placed in a position to allow a free flow of air. Do not cover

ventilation opening on the back cover. Do not place the set in an enclosure or very close to walls.

Avoid excessively warm locations to prevent possible damages to the set.

Place the television on a solid and flat surface.

Cleaning :

For safety, remove the AC plug from the wall outlet before cleaning the set.

Clean the dust on set by wiping the screen and the cabinet with a soft, clean cloth. If the screen requires additional cleaning, use a clean, damp cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners or aerosol cleaners or liquid containing benzol, petroleum or a chemicals.

Power :

Do not allow anything to rest upon or roll over the power cord, and do not place the set where the power cord is subject to damage.

Remove the AC plug from the wall outlet when the TV set is not used for a prolonged period of time.

In the event of thunder storms or power cuts please remove the mains power plug and the aerial plug.

Unplug the set in case of abnormal operation e.g. Smoke, odd sound or smells.

Use the mains power cord provided for connecting TV to the mains.

No warranty claims are accepted for damage caused by incorrect handling.

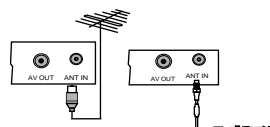
This LCD TV Set is designed to receive and display video and audio signals and for use as PC monitor. Any other use is prohibited.

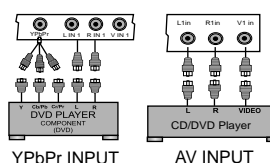
Despite the high quality of the television, a random disturbances or interference may cause occasional malfunctioning, in this case the correct function of the apparatus can be restored by switching Off the TV through the main On/Off button or removing the main plug, then switches ON as soon as the LED light disappears

3.ANTENNA AND EXTERNAL EQUIPMENT CONNECTION

You can connect antenna, external equipment such as VCR, Camcorder, DVD player and PC to your set. Examples are shown below.



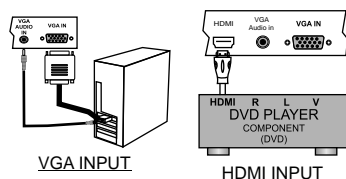
ANTENNA CONNECTION: -
Connect Antenna cable to the ANT IN Socket on rear of the TV. For Good operation of the set, good signal is required. In the strong signal area, an indoor antenna could be used, otherwise an outdoor antenna should be used.
Note: - The aerial cable should not be bundled to the power cord.



COMPONENT (YPbPr) DVD INPUT: -
1. Connect the component outputs (YPbPr) of DVD player to the component (YPbPr) input of the TV.
2. Connect audio outputs (L/R) of a DVD player to the audio input YPbPr.
3. Press the PLAY button on the DVD player.
AV INPUT: - 1. Connect the composite VIDEO output of player to AV1.
2. Connect audio outputs (L/R) of a player to the audio input AV in.
3. Press the PLAY button on the Player.

Note : Selecting a Source

Press TV/AV key on remote or SOURCE key on front panel keypad. A source OSD will appear to select a source press OK/Right or Left key on the remote or VOL + key from front panel. Press TV/AV key or source key repeatedly to change and select source. Up/Down key on the remote or CH+/- on front panel can be used to change sources.

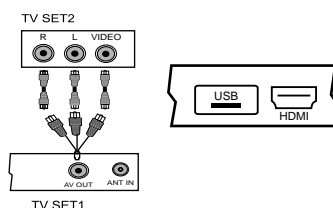


VGA INPUT: - 1. Connect the VGA cable from the monitor output socket of the PC to the VGA IN socket of the TV.
2. Connect the audio cable from the PC to the VGA Audio IN socket of the set.
3. Switch on the PC and PC screen appears on the TV set.
The set can be operated as PC monitor.

Note: - A. If the set is cold, there may be a small flicker when the set is switched ON. This is normal, there is nothing wrong with the set.
B. Some dot defects may appear on the screen, like Red/ Green/Blue spots. However, this will have no impact or effect on the TV/Monitor performance.

HDMI INPUT: - 1. Connect the HDMI(High Definition Multimedia Interface) cable from the DVD HDMI Output socket to the HDMI socket of the TV.
2. Set the HDMI mode in DVD Player (Refer User Manual of DVD Player).

Note: - TV can receive the Video and Audio signal simultaneously by using HDMI cable.



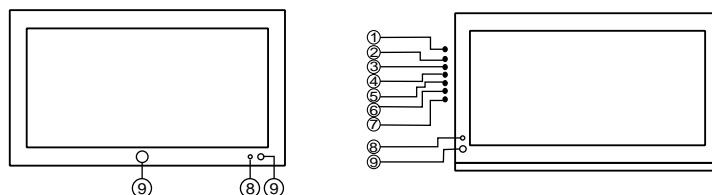
AV OUT: - This connection is used for connecting the TV/AV, signal from TV SET 1 to TV SET 2.

MULTIMEDIA: - Connect / Insert standard USB and select Multimedia source on source OSD by pressing TV/AV key. Press OK / Right key on remote, connected USB is listed, press OK to enter in selected USB Multimedia. Similarly front panel keys CH+/- and VOL+ can be operated as Up/Down and OK/Right keys on remote respectively.

NOTE: - CH +/CH- keys on Remote are represented by CH+/CH- on the TV set.
VOL+/VOL- keys on remote are represented by VOL+/VOL- on the TV set.

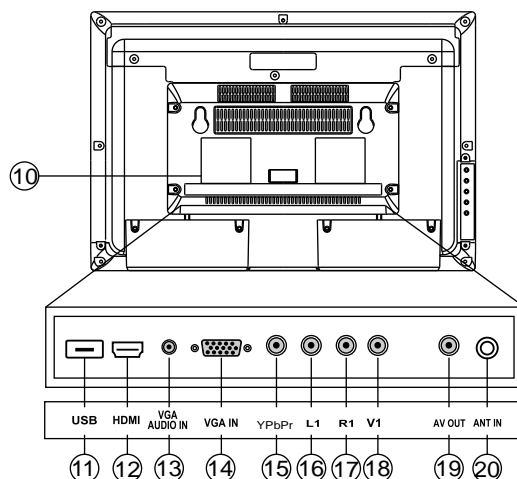

6. BATTERY INSTALLATION

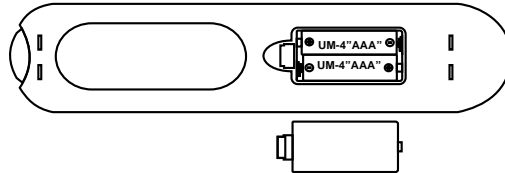
1. Remove the battery compartment door.
2. Insert two pieces of 1.5V size UM-4 "AAA" batteries or equivalent with the correct polarity as indicated by (+) and (-) symbols.
3. Replace the battery compartment door.

NOTE : Remove batteries when they are exhausted or if the remote control is not to be used for a long time.

BATTERY PRECAUTIONS :

Incorrect use of batteries can cause electrolyte leakage which will corrode the remote handset or cause the batteries to burst.

- Replace both batteries at the same time.
- Don't Mix battery types (alkaline with carbon, zinc etc.).
- Don't recharge.



	FR	Select this option with Navigation key and OK key of TV remote. This is used to fast Rewind the running file of connected player.
	FF	Select this option with Navigation key and OK key of TV remote. This is used to Fast Forward the running file of connected player.
	Prev.	Select this option with Navigation key and OK key of TV remote. This is used to select Previous file in Player list.
	Next.	Select this option with Navigation key and OK key of TV remote. This is used to select Previous file in Player list.

 Up  Down  Left  Right	These functions are used to navigate in the Player menu and player functions in Up/Down and Left/Right directions. These controls work same as TV remote navigation keys.
 Setup	When select this function with TV navigation and OK keys, then it will display the Setup menu of the connected Player.

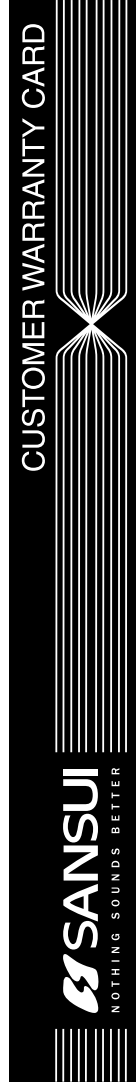

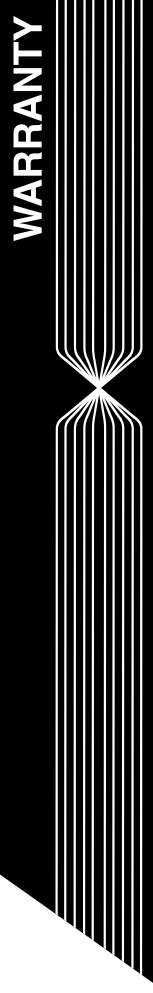
