



- 2. Make sure the unit is in the OFF position before
- plugging the heater into the outlet. Avoid overloading your circuit by not using other high wattage appliances in the same outlet. At 1500 watts, this unit draws 12.5 amps. 3 **NOTE:** This unit is for FLOOR USE ONLY.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. For heater operation, please set the Thermostat all the way to HI. (See Figure 1 and 2)
- 2. Turn the Mode Control to desired heat setting (LO (I) for 750W or HI (II) for 1500W).

- The Power Light will remain lit during operation.
 Caution light illuminates in an overheat situation.

- The temperature may be set too low. Turn the thermostat knob clockwise until the heater restarts.
