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Safety Instructions



Before connecting the AC power cord to the DC adapter outlet, make sure the voltage designation of the DC adapter corresponds to the local electrical supply. Never insert anything metallic into the cabinet openings of the Liquid Crystal Display LCD TV: doing so may create the danger of electric shock. To avoid electric shock, never touch the inside of the LCD TV. Only a qualified technician should open the case of the LCD TV. Never use your LCD TV if the power cord has been damaged. Do not allow anything to rest on the power cord, and keep the cord away from areas wherepeople can trip over it.

Be sure to hold the plug, not the cord, when disconnecting the LCD TV from an electric socket.

Openings in the LCD TV cabinet are provided for ventilation. To prevent overheating, these openings should not be blocked or covered. Also, avoid using the LCD TV on a bed, sofa, rug, or other soft surface. Doing so may block the ventilation openings in the bottom of the cabinet. If you put the LCD TV in a bookcase or some other enclosed space, be sure to provide adequate ventilation. Put your LCD TV in a location with low humidity and a minimum of dust.

Place the LCD TV on a solid surface and treat it carefully. The screen is made of thin glass with a plastic front surface and be damaged if dropped, hit or scratched. Do not clean the front panel with keton-type materials (e.g., acetone), ethyl alcohol, toluene, ethylacid, methyl, or chloride - these may damage the panel.

Locate your LCD TV near an easily accessible AC outlet.

Before using it, please read this user's manual carefully and apply it correctly and safely. Please keep this manual close to you so you can refer to it anytime after reading it. Also, for the transportation of the product, please attach this manual without fail. Please observe the notes below.

- Use at the rated power voltage. Use of non-rated voltage may cause fire, electric shock and breakdown.
- 2. Do not open the cabinet and external cover. The high voltage inside of this product may cause the electric shock.
- Do not remodel or disassemble this product. Remodeling or disassembling in wrong method may cause fire, electric shock or breakdown.
- 4. Do not insert or drop any foreign substance such as metals or flammable object inside from the air hole. It may cause fire, electric shock or breakdown. If any foreign substance is inserted inside of this product, turn off the power, pull the plug out of the socket and contact the sales department. Do not use the product with the foreign substance in.
- 5. Never touch the antenna lie or power plug if it stars to thunder. It may cause the electric shock.
- If any impact is applied, the parts inside of the product may be fallen out or broken to be the cause of fire, electric shock or breakdown.
- Clean the dust on the power plug periodically. The dusty power plug may cause the poor insulation due to the moisture to be the reason of fire.
- Do not destroy, process, make closer to heating device, bend or twist forcibly, place any heavy object on nor bind the power cord or power plug. If it is used in the broken condition, it may cause fire or electric shock.

Basic Remote Control Operation

CH.LIST Button

- User can add the wanted channel to favorite lists during watching TV.
- Press the CH.LIST key of remote control.
- You can select the Favorite list1 or 2,3,4 of wanting to add by using the CH key
- You can add present channel at selected list by pressing ENT key.
- (It is also possible at Channel Edit menu. Refer to the Channel Edit paragraph)

TV/RADIO Button

- If radio channel is provided, you can take radio channel after select RADIO mode by pressing TV/RADIO key.
- It will press the TV/RADIO key of the remocon and it will be able to change with RADIO mode, press TV/RADIO key one more time with TV mode again and it is changed.

Volume up(+) / down (-) Button

- 1)It adjusts the volume level of sound.
- 2) It is used to choose a specified mode in the main MENU by pressing VOL(+) button.3) It controls the increase or decrease of each mode you selected.

Channel up ()/ down () Button

It is used to select the channel you want to watch on either upward or downward direction.
 It makes the cursor to move while in main MENU.

INFO Button

Check the current program information, screen status, multi sound status and time.

EXIT Button

When you are satisfied with the settings, Press the EXIT Button repeatedly to return to normal viewing.

The television is automatically turned off after an elapse of the set sleep time.

- 1) The set time ranges from 10 to 180 minutes, which is repeated in sequence each time vou press.

P.STD Button

By pressing the P.STD button, sequentially select one of the 4 pre-sets picture standard.

- Standard : Select this mode to watch TV at standard state.
- Dynamic : Select this mode to watch in a room with bright illumination.
- Mild : Select this mode when the room is dark or to lessen eye fatigue.
- User : Select this mode to view the picture to your set picture state preference.

S.STD Button

Whenever this button is pressed, the mode will be changed as follows.

Connecting the Aerial or Cable Television Network

To view television channels directly, a signal must be received by the set from one of following sources:

An outdoor aerial An indoor aerial (not recommendable) A cable television network



- 1. In the first three cases, connect the aerial or network input cable to the 75 ohm coaxial socket on the rear of the TFT LCD TV.
- 2. Press the TV button on the remote control.

Connecting the VCR. DVD or Other external devices

- 1. Connect video and audio cable according to the shape and color or the video / audio cable. When an external devices is in MONO, the audio connection cable can be connected to either the left and S.MODE / MTS should be set MONO.
- 2. For optimal visual image, use COMPONENT connector instead of video connector.





Connecting to watch TV, UCR or DVD

Connecting a DVD Player (Connecting to Y, P_b, P_r)

- 1. Connect a set of audio cables between the component AUDIO IN jacks on the TFT LCD TV and the AUDIO OUT jacks on the DVD Player.
- Connect video cables between the Y, Pb and Pr inputs on the TFT LCD TV and Y, Pb and Pr outputs on the DVD Player. (Note : For an explanation of Component video, see your DVD Player's Owner's manual.)

Changing the INPUT SELECT Standard

You can select the type of INPUT which best corresponds to your viewing requirements. The following picture effects are available the order given:

TV, AV1, AV2, COMPONENT

- 1. Press the SOURCE button. Result : The INPUT SELECT menu is displayed.
- 2. Press the CH[] button.
- Select to satisfy your preference by pressing the VOL[+] or VOL [-] button.
- 4. When you have been finished, press the MENU button repeatedly to return to normal viewing.

Selecting the Sound Mode(depending on TV mode)

The "M/S" button displays/controls the processing and output of the audio signal. When power is switched ON, the mode is automatically preset to either "Dual" or "Stereo" depending on the current transmission.

If the receiving conditions deteriorate, listening will be easier if the mode is set to the "Mono" position using the M/S button.

If the stereo signal is weak (or if intermittent Stereo-Mono) and automatic switching occurs, then switch to the "Mono" mode.

When receiving mono sound in the AV mode, connect to the "L" input jack on the panels. If the mono sound comes out only from the left speaker, then press the M/S button.

Adjusting the Volume/Switching the Sound Off Temporarily

You can adjust the volume by pressing the VOL[+] or VOL[-] button on the remote control. You can switch the sound off temporarily by pressing the MUTE button on the remote control, for example you may wish to answer the telephone.

- Press the VOL[+] button to increase the volume. (cursor moves to the right)
- 2. Press the VOL[] button to decrease the volume. (cursor moves to the left)
- 3. Press the MUTE button. Result : The sound is switched off and
- " ¹/₄ Mute On" is displayed.
 When you wish to turn the sound back on at the same volume as before, press the MUTE button again (or either of the volume buttons).





Setup Setting

You can scan the frequency ranges available on your television in your country and store all the channels found

automatically. The channels are stored in the order in which they appear in the frequency bands. It is possible that the automatically allocated numbers may not correspond to those by which you wish to identify the channels. If this is the case, you can then sort them manually.

- After selection the Start Search menu using the CH key, Channel search begin as pressing the ENT key.

- All TV list : It displays whole channel lists.
- <u>Fav List 1</u> : It displays channel lists of the favorite list 1.
- *Fav List 2* : It displays channel lists of the favorite list 2.
- Fav List 3 : It displays channel lists of the favorite list 3.
- *Fav List 4* : It displays channel lists of the favorite list 4.

• Favorite List Name Edit :

It will use the Vol from the *Fav List 1,2,3,4* and it will be able to enter with the *Favorite List Name Edit*. The user wants it will be able to edit the *Favorite List Name* with the name.



Setup Setting

- Sort: If you press INFO key, channels are sorted in alphabetical. If you want to return, press Display key one more time. Sorted information is not stored.
- Lock channels: It is available to lock or unlock the resired channel. You can lock the channel by pressing ENT key after select the channel. And the check mark will be shown on the locked channel. It should be input the password to relase the locked channel.
- Favorite channels: User can make four favorite lists which is composed of the most wanted channel. Each list is able to have one hundred channels up to.
- If you want to compose each favorite list 1, 2, 3, 4 you can add by pressing the ENT key after selecting to add the channel by using the CH Vol key. Added channel is displayed as a check mark.
- Delete channels: If you want to delete some channel, you can delete by pressing the ENT Key after selecting the channel. If you want to return the deleted channel, you should do channel search again.
- Channel Name Edit: The user wants it will be able to edit with the name. When it selects channel which it wants edit it will enter in Channel Name edit mode and the user will be able to change a name with option.
- Channel Number Edit: The user wants it will be able to edit with the Channel Number. It enters into Channel Name Edit menus and when it inputs a number key 4, it will be able to use Channel Number Edit and again it presses number key 4 and it goes back with Channel Name Edit.

- Change Password: You can change to the wanted password. The first default is " 0000 ". If you don 't know the password, your right may be restricted about several functions.
- *Time Zone:* If service provider offer GMT (Greenwich Mean Time), user can set the time as selecting just located region of themselves.
- Summer Time: You can select the summer time ' s ON/OFF for GMT by using the Vol+,- key.
- *Factory Setting:* To enter this menu, you should input the password.
- <u>Factory Default:</u> This is the function of returning to the early state from the factory.
- <u>Delete all Lists:</u> You can delete all the searched channel lists.
- Program Transfer: If user wants to copy present perfect program of DTV to other DTV, user should use this function.

- *TV Screen Format :* You can select the Screen Size among three options like letter box, combined, pan scan.

Teletext is an information system that displays text on your TV screen. Using the teletext control buttons you can view pages of information that are listed in the teletext index.

NOTE The TV menus are not available while viewing teletext pages.

Enter Text Mode

Make sure that the TV programme that you are watching transmits a teletext signal.

Press the CCD/TXT button to display the text page.

Exit Text Mode

Press the CCD/TXT button again. The text will disappear and the TV will return to the programme you were watching.

Selecting a Page

Find the number of the page in the index and enter it using the numeric buttons. Teletext pages comprise three numerics and all three have to be entered. The number of the page will appear in the top left corner of the page. The page counter will search for your page and display it once it is found.

Page Search While Watching TV

Some pages can take time to load. While waiting you can view the TV picture by mixing the text and picture.

Enter the page number. Press the Red, Green, Yellow, Blue key to move to specific page.

Nanov Waterproof LCD TV/Monitor is intended for use in moist, humid and wet environmental conditions. The brightness has been increased to make the unit viewable outdoors during the day. With the high brightness, it can also serve as a source of light at night in dark outdoor surroundings or the swimming pool area. However, the unit should not be kept or used under direct sunlight as it may cause overheating of the liquid in the LCD panel. The device is not designed to be used in hot areas where there could be overheating. The operating temperature of the Device is -20 centigrade to +50 centigrade. If the unit begins to blacken due to exposure to direct sunlight, we recommend letting the unit cool down. The unit will resume normal operation once it cools down. This devise in not intended to for use underwater. The IP67, underwater models must be installed by pre-approved professionals who use the instructions from the installation manual received from the factory including instructions on how to seal the connectors. The company does not offer warranty on any opened device which has water damage on model NKLT201WP.





APPENDIX A: Troubleshooting

If you have a problem setting up or using your LCD TV, you may be able to solve it yourself. Before contacting customer service, try the suggested actions that are appropriate to your problem.

What you see	Suggested Actions
Screen is blank and power indicator is off	Ensure that the power cord is firmly connected and the LCD TV is on.
"NO SIGNAL" message	Ensure that the signal cable is firmly connected to the PC or video sources. Ensure that the PC or ideo sources are turned on.
The image is too light or too dark	Adjust the Brightness and Contrast.
Vertical bars appear to flicker, jitter or shimmer on the image	Adjust the Frequency function. Auto Tracking will clear it automatically.
Horizontal bars appear to flicker, jit- ter or shimmer on the image.	Adjust the phase function and then adjust the clock function. Auto tracking will clear it automatically.
Screen is blank	The monitor is using its power management system. Move the computer's mouse or press a key on the keyboard.
Image is not stable and may appear to vibrate	Auto tracking will clear it automatically Check that the display resolution and frequency from your PC or video board is an available mode for your monitor. On your computer check: Control Panel, Display, Settings
