
Electrical Information

This appliance is fitted with a BS1363/A 13 amp plug. If it is not suitable for your supply sockets it must be removed and replaced with an appropriate plug. If the plug becomes damaged and/or needs to be replaced please follow the wiring instructions below. The plug removed must be disposed of immediately. It must not be plugged into a supply socket as this will be an electrical hazard. If the fuse needs to be replaced it must be of the same rating and ASTA approved to BS1362. If the plug is changed, a fuse of the appropriate rating must be fitted in the plug, adapter or at the distribution board. If the fuse in a moulded plug is replaced, the fuse cover must be refitted before the appliance can be used.

Wiring Instructions

The supply cable will be either 2-core or 3-core. Follow the appropriate wiring instructions given below. In both cases ensure that the outer sheath of the cable is firmly held by the cable clamp.

GETTING STARTED

Switching on

- Turn on your TV set and select the corresponding AV input (For Instructions, please consult the
 instruction manual supplied with the TV).
- If you use the "Digital TV Recorder" for the first time or have deleted all channels in the "Digital TV Recorder", the "TV Setting" is shown.
- Press "LEFT" or "RIGHT" cursor button to choose either "16:9" (widescreen) or "4:3" (traditional) according to the TV shape you have.
- Make sure that the TV aerial is connected to the unit then, press "OK" button to continue installation.
- "Scan Progress" menu will appear and list the channels as they are found.
 A bar appears below the found channels indicates the progress of the channel search.
- When all channels have been found, the channel at the top of the list will be shown on the TV.

It may take upto several seconds for the Hard Drive to start, therefore there may be a short delay after pressing the standby button and the unit turning on.

Automatic / Manual channel scan

If new channels are broadcast, you will need to rescan the "Digital TV Recorder" before they are added to the channel list. Please follow one of the below methods to add these channels.

- (1) Press the "SETUP" button to enterthe main menu of the "Digital TV Recorder".
- Press the cursor button to select "System Setting", then "Channel Setting", then "Channel Tuning".press the "OK" button to enter Channel Tuning menu.
- ③ Use "LEFT" or "RIGHT" cursor button to select "Auto scan" or "Manual scan".
- (4) If "Auto" is selected press the "OK" button to automatically scan for auto channels. If Manual scan (recommended for advanced users only) is selected, the UHF channel number that the required channel is on will need to be entered before scanning.
- (5) Press "EXIT" button to cancel scan for new channels.

Accessing the Electronic Programme Guide (EPG)

From the EPG, you can change channels available, check programme information, access one-week programme schedule which details the times and programmes for the next seven days and set reminders/recording timers.

- 1) Press the "GUIDE" button to enterthe Channel Schedule.
- ② Press "UP "or "DOWN" cursor button to select the desired channel.
- (3) Press "LEFT" or "RIGHT" cursor button to navigate the selected channel.
- 4 Press "Yellow" or "Blue "button to view information for previous or next days.
- (§) Press "OK" button to add a reminder, then a white line will appear under the selected event. When the reminder programme is about to start, a reminder window will appear.

The "Digital TV Recorder" will change automatically to the selected channel after the countdown is shown.

- If you select "Yes" and press OK button, the "Digital TV Recorder" will change the channel immediately.
- If you select "Postpone 2 min" and press"OK" button, thereminder window
 will be shown again in two minutes (this can be useful if the programme that
 you are currently watching is overrunning and therefore you need to delay
 the channel change).
- To cancel the reminderand continue watching thecurrent channel, select "No" and press"OK"button.
- (6) Press "EXIT" button to exit the channel schedule.

Recording

Recording current event:

When viewing a channel, press "Record" button to record the current event directly, to record the following event press the record button again.

Your "Digital TV Recorder" can record two events at same time. When there is a recording on current event, it is possible to view a different channel.

If there are two recordings you can only watch either of the channels being recorded or a program previously recorded from the library

Press "STOP" button to stop the desired recording and return to live TV.

- 1 Press the "SETUP" button and select "1. Record a new program" (or press the guide button on the remote control) to display the EPG.
- ② Use the cursor button to select desired programme,
- 3 Press the "Record" button, If the series information is broadcast for the selected eventa pop-up will be shown. To record only that occurrence select "Single Event". To record the entire series, select "Entire Series", this will then add bookings for every event that is signalled as being part of that series - Please note, this information is broadcast by the channel.

Conflict Resolution:

Your "Digital TV Recorder" can record from two channels at once. If you tryto add athird recording the timer list screen will be shown (Pic-1).

- To try and automatically resolve the conflict press the GREEN button. If the "Digital TV Recorder" can find alternative occurrences of the event, it will record this instead. This will be indicated by a green tick in the mode column.
- If no alternatives can be found the unit will inform you by displaying a pop-up window, press the OK button to close this pop-up. In this case the conflict will have to be resolved manually.
- To do this press OK button with the timer screen (Pic-1) shown. From the new on screen display that is shown (Pic-2) select a recording that should be cancelled by highlighting it and pressing the GREEN button.
- Finally, press the OK button to confirm any changes that have been made.

Timeshift:

Timeshift allows youto pause the currently showing programme, for example when the phone rings. It is not possible to change channels when the timeshift function is active.

- If the recording starts, Timeshift will be cancelled.
- When viewing live TV, press the "PAUSE" button to activate timeshift function.
- 2 Press "PLAY" button to continue watching.
- 3 During playback,

Press "FRW" or "FFW" button repeatedly to cyclethrough the available search speeds.

Press "SKIP BACK" or "SKIP FWD" button to skip backward or forward by 30 seconds.

Press "PAUSE" button once to pause playback, press again to advance frame by frame.

Press the SLOW button repeatedly to cycle through the available slow motion playback speeds.

Press "STOP" button to stop timeshift playback and then return the live TV, the timeshift function is then cancelled.



Playback of recorded files

Press "SETUP" and select "2. Playback a recorded program" (or press the "PLAY" button on the remote control) to display the Video Library.

- Press "UP" or "DOWN" buttons to select a recording, then press "OK" buttonto play.
- ② Press"RED" button to continue from the last viewed point.
- ③ Press "GREEN" button to Rename the selected recording.
- Press the "GREEN" button, the rename windows is shown,
- Press "UP" and "DOWN" button to input character, press "LEFT" or "RIGHT" button to move cursor.
- Press "OK" button toconfirm the new name after finish allrevision.





(4) Press" YELLOW " button to delete the selected recording.

- Press"BLUE" button to keep the selected recording. If this is selected then the PIN code will need to be entered before the file can be deleted in the future.
- To view the synopsis of the recorded event press the i button, a pop-up will be shown detailing the synopsis that was broadcast at the time of recording.

Search Forward:

Press the "FFW" button repeatedly to cycle through the available search forward speeds as follows:



Search Backward:

Press the "FRW" button repeatedly to cycle through the available search backward speeds as follows:


Pause/Step:

Press the "PAUSE" button to pause playback. Once paused, press the "PAUSE" button repeatedly to advance frame by frame.

<u>Search</u>

Use "SEARCH" function to jump to a specific point.

- 1 Press "SEARCH" button, the Searchmenu window is shown.
- ② Use the numeric button to input the desired time and press "OK" button to confirm. Then playback will jump to that time.



Channel List

The Channel List presents a list of all channels found during the channel search. From the Channel List you can select a channel to watch, delete a channel or Lock/Unlock the channel.

- (1) Press "CH.LIST" button, Channel listappears.
- (2) Press "UP" or "DOWN" cursor button to select the desired channel.
- ③ Press "OK" button to view the channel.
- Press "YELLOW" button to delete the channel.

Timer:

Enter this menu,PVRcan display Timerlist in which include details for the reserved recordings and events such as Event name, Start Date reserved, start time reserved,End timereserved and event mode. In timer list

Press "UP" or "DOWN" button to select the desired reserved event.

EPG style

Select the default style of EPG that should be shown when pressing the "GUIDE" button. The two styles be cycled through by pressing the "SETUP" button with the EPG shown on screen.

Change the colours used for all on screen displays.

Factory Reset

This menu allows you to Restore default settings, Delete all channels, Format Hard Disk,

Factory Reset

Use this option to delete all channels and settings and reset "Digital TV Recorder" to the first time installation mode.

Delete All Channels

Use this option to delete all existing channels.

Format Hard Disk

Use this option to format the hard drive. You will be asked to input Pin code. All recordings will be deleted.

Software Update

Use this option to Update software by Auto or Manual mode.

Auto Mode:

Select "Auto Mode", Set status to "ON" and set the desired time you want to start updating . Then the "Digital TV Recorder" will uptate software automatically if a update is available.

Manual Mode:

Select "Manual Mode", highlight " Scan" and press "OK" button, "Digital TV Recorder" will update to the current software.

Change Pin Code

Use this option to Change pincode.

TV Shape

Software Version

This menu allows users to view software version.
