INSTALLATION



MOUNT

Attach the mount to the camera using the screw and plastic nut. Press the lever to secure the suction cup mount to your vehicle's windshield.



POWER

Plug the unit into your vehicle's cigarette lighter plug.





When power is applied the unit will automatically turn on and start recording.

Press (OK) to stop or start recording.

Press to lock the current file so that it won't be recorded over.

Press menu and then select to change languages.
