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Safety

General Statement on RF Energy

The phone is a low-power radio transmitter and receiver. When switched on it intermittently transmits radio frequency (RF) energy (radio waves). The transmit power level is optimized for best performance and automatically reduces when there is good quality reception. Maximum power is only used at the edge of network coverage so under most circumstances the power output is very low. Under poor network conditions the phone transmits at a higher power, may get hot and have a shorter battery life.

Specific Absorption Rate (SAR)

The phone is designed not to exceed the limits for exposure to radio waves recommended by the ICNIRP. The limits include safety margins designed to assure the protection of all persons, regardless of age and health.

The guidelines measure the Specific Absorption Rate, or SAR. The SAR limit for mobile devices is 2W/Kg and the highest SAR value for this device is $1.01\ W/Kg$.

Key Definitions

Key	Function
Power Key	Press to power on your phone. Press to switch to sleep mode. Press to wake up. Hold down for Profile options: Power off, Silent, Vibrate, or Airplane mode.
Home Key	Tap to return to the Home Screen from any screen. Hold to see the recently used applications.
Menu Key	Tap to get the options on the current screen. Hold to open the quick search keypad
Back Key	Tap to go to the previous screen.
Call Key	Press to open the dial pad to make a call. Press to answer a call.
End Key	Press to End a call. Hold for Profile options the same as the Power Key.
Volume Keys	Use to control the volume Up and Down

Insert your SIM card

Power off your phone before inserting the SIM, or memory card.


1. Remove the battery cover.




2. Insert your SIM card carefully into the SIM slot as shown. There is a diagram showing the correct orientation of the SIM above the SIM slot.



3. The handset supports microSD memory cards up to 32GB. Follow the steps shown below to insert your microSD card into the card holder:



4. Insert the battery as shown with the gold contacts located against the gold springs.





5. Replace the battery cover and press it gently until you hear a click.

Charge the Battery

Charge before initial use. The plug and socket are keyed so they only fit together one way.

- Do NOT use excessive force which may damage the USB port.
- Physical damage to the USB port is NOT covered by warranty.
- The phone can also be charged by connecting it to a computer using the USB lead supplied.
- Disconnect the charger when the battery is fully charged

Insert the charger lead carefully:



Notes:

- If the battery is low, there will be a pop-up message on the screen and the status indicator light will be red.
- When you charge your phone, the indicator light will change according to the battery level:

Status Indicator	Battery level
Red	Less than 10% charge
Orange	More then 10%, but less than 90% charge
Green	More than 90% charge

Power On & Off

- 1. Make sure that your SIM card and battery are inserted.
- 2. Press the **Power Key** to power on your handset.

To power off your handset, press and **hold** the **Power Key** select **Power off** > **OK**.

Switch your handset to sleep mode

Press the **Power Key U**

Sleep Mode suspends your handset to a low-power state with the display off.

Sleep Mode activates automatically when the handset is idle for a period of time as defined by:

Settings > Sound & display settings > Screen timeout

Wake up from sleep mode

- 1. Press the **Power Key** to activate the display.
- 2. Drag the padlock icon to the right as shown:



If you have set an unlock pattern for your handset you need to draw the pattern to unlock your screen.

(see **Settings > Location and security > Set unlock pattern**),

Using the Touch Screen Controls

The touch screen controls change dynamically depending on the tasks you are performing:

- 1. **Tap** buttons or icons to select the function or open applications.
- 2. **Hold** an item for options related to that function.
- 3. Slide up & down to scroll through lists.
- 4. **Drag** items to move or perform other operations.
- 5. **Swipe** sideways to view the extended desktop.



Tip

In most modes the screen will automatically switch between portrait or landscape mode when changing the orientation of the handset. Some screens assume a preferred orientation and will not change.

Slide the Home Screen left or right to view additional pages. **Tap** and **hold** to add Shortcuts, Widgets, Folders and Wallpapers.

Move and Delete a Home Screen item

- 1. Tap **Home** to return to the Home Screen.

- 1. Tap **Home** to return to the Home Screen.
- 2. Tap and hold the Google Search bar, then move it down the screen.

The Notifications Panel

The Notifications Panel at the top of the Home Screen shows useful device and status information:

- 1. Hold the top bar until appears at the top of the display.
- 2. Drag the panel downwards to view the notifications:



Tip

You can also open the Notifications Panel from the Home Screen by tapping **Menu > Notifications**.

Multi-Tasking

You can run multiple applications simultaneously. Press the Home key from any application to launch, open or view something else. The original application will be suspended until you return to it.

Installing Applications



Tap Market from the Home Screen to download and install applications from the Android Market. Select the item and tap **Install**.

To install non-Market applications you need to go to **Settings** > **Applications** > **Unknown sources**.

- 1. Tap Home 🕡 > Menu > Settings > Applications > Manage applications
- 2. Tap on the application you want to remove.
- 3. Tap **Uninstall**, and tap **OK** to confirm.





Making Calls

Make a Call from the Dial Pad

- 1. Press the Call Key from the home screen to open the dial pad.
- 2. Enter the phone number on the number pad. Tap to delete numbers entered, hold this key to clear all digits.

Your phone automatically lists matching contacts. Tap to hide the keypad to see if there are more matching numbers or contacts.

- 3. Tap _____ or ___ to make the call.
- 4. Press the End Key 🕋 to end the call.

Make a Call from Contacts

- 1. Tap from the Home Screen. Contacts are displayed in alphabetical order.
- 2. Slide your finger to scroll through your Contacts list.

3. Tap to select the Contact then tap to call.





Search for a contact by tapping **Menu > Search**.

Press on the right hand side of the Contacts list to use the scroller to scan through your Contacts.

Make a Call from Call History

- 1. Press the **Call Key** from the home screen to open the Dial pad.
- 2. Tap to open Call History.
- 3. Scroll and tap the required number. Tap 🚺 to start the call

You can also open your Call History by tapping - Call log from the Home Screen

Make a Call from a Text Message

If a text message contains a phone number you can make a call from the text message:

- 1. Tap **Home** \bigcirc > \bigcirc and tap the thread that contains the phone number to call.
- 2. Tap the number required then tap to start the call.
- 3. Press the End Key 🖚 to end the call.

Making a Conference Call

You can make a conference call between yourself and two or more other parties.

- 1. Call the first number.
- 2. While you are connected, tap Menu > Add call.
- 3. Call the second number.
- 4. While you are connected to the second number, tap **Menu** > **Merge calls**.

- 5. To add the third party, tap **Menu** > **Add call**.
- 6. Dial the number, and when connected, tap **Menu** > **Merge calls**

Turn the Speaker On/Off (Handsfree)

Tap Menu > Speaker during a call. The speakerphone icon displayed.



Making an Emergency Call

- 1. Press the **Call Key** from any screen to open the Dial pad.
- 2. Enter the Emergency Number for your location and tap Call.

It is possible to dial emergency numbers when the SIM card is not inserted. Tap **Emergency call** to bring up the dial pad and enter the emergency number for your current location.

Making an International Call

- 1. Press the Call Key to open the Dial pad.
- 2. Hold down to enter the "+" symbol for the International Dialling Prefix
- 3. Enter the full phone number.
- 4. Tap Call or to make the call.
- 5. Press the End Key 🖚 to end the call.

Mute a Call

During a call tap **Menu > Mute** to mute your microphone. The mute icon is displayed.

End a Call

Receiving Calls

Answer an Incoming Call

When there is an incoming call, the phone will display the information on the screen.

Drag to the right to answer the call:

Reject an Incoming Call

Drag to the left to reject the call.

Place a Call on Hold

During a call tap **Menu** > **Hold** to place the call on hold. The 🚾 icon is displayed.

If you are already on a call and accept the new call, the first call will be put on hold automatically. Tap **Swap** to switch between the two calls.

Call Settings

From the Home Screen press Menu > Settings > Call settings:

Fixed Dialing Numbers	Restrict outgoing calls to a fixed set of numbers. This requires support from your network provider and the SIM PIN2 code.		
Voicemail service	Select a voicemail service provider.		
Voicemail settings	Specify a voicemail number.		
DTMF Tones	Set Long DTMF tones if required eg. Telephone Banking

Insert a Pause or Wait symbol into a phone number

Insert a Pause symbol ',' to add a 2 second delay.
Insert a Wait symbol ';' to wait until the next key press.

- Enter the phone number on the Dial pad.
- Tap and hold the Menu key to bring up the QWERTY keyboard.
- Add the required symbol directly from the keyboard.
- Press Back to return to the dial pad.

Contacts



Contacts can be stored on the (U)SIM card or phone. Contacts stored on the phone provide more fields to enter information such as a photo, home address, email, fax etc.

Tap **Home** > to enter the Contacts Screen.

Contacts Screen



Importing / Exporting Contacts

You can import or export contacts to and from your (U)SIM card or microSD™ card.

Tap **Home** > to enter the Contacts Screen.

Import / export contacts to the SIM card

- 1. Tap Menu > Import / Export from the Contacts Screen.
- 2. Select to import or export contacts from/to your (U)SIM card. Your Smart Touch will automatically read the contacts.
- Select the contacts you want to import/export.
 To import/export all contacts, tap Menu > Select all.
- 4. Tap **Done**.

Import / export contacts to and from the memory card

- 1. Tap **Menu > Import / Export** from the Contacts Screen.
- 2. Select to import or export contacts from/to microSD™ card.

 If you want to import contacts from microSD™ card, you should have vCard files saved in the microSD™ card. If there is more than one vCard file, you need to select the vCard file.
- 3. Tap **OK**.

Create a New Contact

- 1. Tap Menu > New contact from the Contacts Screen.
- 2. Select the location to save your contact If the Contact is stored on the phone (local) then you can add a photo and extra fields such as email, home address etc.
- 3. Tap the Given name field to start entering the Contact details
- 4. Tap **Done** to save the contact.

Add a Contact to Favourites 🔯



- 1. **Tap** the contact from your Contacts Screen.
- 2. **Tap** the Star symbol to add to Favorites
- 3. You can also **Hold** the contact to see the pop up menu
- 3. Tap **Add to favorites**.

Search Contacts

- 1. Tap **Menu > Search** from the Contacts Screen.
- 2. Input the name to search for. The matching contacts will be listed.

Edit a Contact

- Select the contact from the Contacts Screen.
- 2. Tap Menu > Edit contact.
- 3. Edit the contact and tap **Done**.

Delete a Contact

Select the contact from the Contacts Screen. Tap Menu > Delete contact
 OK

You can also **hold** the Contact and select **Delete contact** from the pop-up menu.

Save a Contact from a Message

- 2. Tap Menu > Add to Contacts
- 3. Complete the Contact details and tap **Done** to save

Set a dedicated Ringtone

- 1. Select the contact from the Contacts Screen.
- 2. Tap **Menu > Options > Ringtone** to add a unique ringtone.


Using the On-screen Keyboards

SMS and MMS Messages

Tap **Home** 🟠 > 😕 to access SMS and MMS messages.

Unread message(s) will display the icon in the status bar.
Open new messages from the Notifications Panel or the Messaging Screen.
Tap the message to read it.

Composing an SMS

- 1. Tap Home 🕡 > 📁 > New message
- 2. Tap the **To** field to enter the recipient's number. You can also enter the first letters of their name to display matching **Contacts** and select a recipient from the list or tap to see your Contacts list.
- 3. Tap the **Type to compose** field and enter the content of your SMS.
- 4. Tap **Send** to send your SMS.

Composing an MMS

- 1. Tap Home 🕡 > 🤛 > New message
- 2. Tap the **To** field to enter the recipient's number. You can also enter the first letters of their name to display matching **Contacts** and select a recipient from the list or tap to see your Contacts list.
- Tap Menu > Attach to add an attachment to your MMS
- 4. Choose your attachment type from the available list:
- 5. Tap **Send** to send your MMS.





Adding or removing the **Subject** or **Attachments** will convert the message from SMS to MMS and vice-versa.

Tap **Menu** > **Add subject** to enter the subject if required.

Tap **Type to compose** to enter text content if required.

Forwarding a Message

Tap and hold the individual message to get further options such as Forward, Delete, View message details etc.

Managing Messages and Messages Threads

SMS and MMS messages sent and received are grouped into message threads in the Messaging screen. Message threads show you the history of messages from a specific contact. Threads are sorted by received time, with the latest one at the top.

Reply to a message

- 1. Tap the message you want to reply to from the Messaging Screen.
- 2. Tap **Type to compose** and enter the contents of your message.
- 3. Tap **Send**.

Access Draft Messages

Tap **Messages** > **Menu** > **Draft** to view your draft messages.

Delete a message (thread)

- 1. Tap Menu > Delete threads from the Messaging Screen.
- 2. Select the messages or threads you want to delete.
- 3. Tap **OK**.
- 4. To delete an individual message (not a thread) tap and **hold** the message and select **Delete** from the available options.

You can also delete a message by opening it from the Messaging Screen and tapping **Menu > More > Delete messages**.

Message Settings

From the Messaging Screen Tap **Menu > Settings** to configure your message settings:

Storage settings:

- Delete old messages: Select to delete old messages as limits are reached.
- **Text message limit**: Set the maximum number of text messages allowed in a single thread.
- Multimedia message limit: Set the maximum number of MMS messages allowed in a single thread.

Text message (SMS) settings:

- **Delivery reports:** Request a delivery report for sent SMS messages
- Manage SIM card messages: Manage messages on your SIM card.
- Service Center: View and edit the service center number

Multimedia message (MMS) settings:

- **Delivery reports**: Request a delivery report for each sent MMS.
- **Read reports**: Request a read report for each sent MMS.
- Auto retrieve: Select to retrieve MMS messages automatically.
- Roaming auto-retrieve: Retrieve MMS messages automatically when roaming.

Notifications settings:

- Notifications: Display message notifications in the status bar.
- **Select ringtone**: Select a ringtone for your incoming messages.
- Vibrate: Set vibrate mode when receiving a new message.

Multiple SMS Message Charging:

A standard SMS message can contain up to 160 characters. If you exceed this length the message will be sent as more than 1 SMS. You will be charged for multiple SMS messages depending on the length.

Using MyEmail @

- 1. Tap the **Home** \bigcirc > <a> MyEmail to configure your account:
- 2. Select the type of account, incoming server settings and tap Next/Next[Check].

If you tap **Next[Check]**, your phone will check the incoming server settings and finish the setup automatically. If you the setup fails then check your service provider and Email provider details.

- Enter the outgoing server settings and tap Next/Next[Check].
 If you tap Next[Check], your phone will check the outgoing server settings and finish the setup automatically.
- 4. Set the Email checking frequency, select whether to use this account by default or be notified when Email arrives, and then tap **Next**.
- 5. Give your account a name and set a name displayed on the outgoing message, and then tap **Done**.

Composing and sending an Email

After creating an Email account you can compose and send Emails:

- 1. Tap **Menu** > **Compose** from the Email Screen.
- Tap the To field and enter the recipient's address. Tap Menu > Add Cc/Bc to add more recipients if required.

When you enter the address, the matching addresses saved in your Contacts will be displayed. You can tap the recipient from the list.

- 3. Enter the subject and the content of your Email.
- 4. Tap **Send**.

Reply to or Forward an Email

- 1. Open the Email to reply to or forward from the Email Screen.
- 2. Tap Reply, Reply all or Menu > Forward.
- 3. Enter the contents / recipients of your Email. Tap **Send**.

Email Settings

Tap the account from the Email Screen and tap Menu > Account settings:

General settings

- Account name: Set your account name.
- Your name: Set the name displayed on the outgoing message.
- Email address: View or edit the email address.
- **Use signature:** Select to use a signature.
- **Signature:** Edit your signature.

- Email check frequency: Set the email checking frequency.
- Power-saving mode: Enable automatic email synchronization time.
- **Default account:** Send email from this account by default.

Notification settings

- Email notifications: Enable status bar notification for new Email
- **Select ringtone:** Select the ringtone for incoming Email notification.
- Vibrate: Enable vibrate with ringtones when Email arrives.

Server settings

- **Incoming settings**: Set the incoming server settings.
- Outgoing settings: Set the outgoing server settings.

Getting Connected

Connecting to the Internet

You can access the Internet through the mobile network or via Wi-Fi.

Your mobile network settings are pre-configured by your service provider and there is no need to change any settings.

Wi-Fi

Wi-Fi provides wireless Internet access over distances of up to 100 meters.

- 1. Tap Home > Menu > Settings > Wireless & networks.
- 2. Select the Wi-Fi check box to turn Wi-Fi on.

Connect to a Wi-Fi network

- 1. Tap Home Menu > Settings > Wireless & networks > Wi-Fi settings
 The available Wi-Fi network names and security settings (open or secured) are displayed.
- 2. Tap a network to connect.
- An open network will automatically connect,
- If you select a secured network you need to enter a password.

Check the Wi-Fi network status

You can check the Wi-Fi network status from the status bar and from Wi-Fi Settings.

- 1. Check the icon in the status bar.
- 2. Tap Home Menu > Settings > Wireless & networks > Wi-Fi settings, then tap the current wireless network to view the network status.

Using the Browser



You can use your Browser to visit most websites. Some web pages may not be displayed properly as some web technologies such as Flash are not supported.



Tap the **Google Quick Search** box from the **Home Screen** and enter your search request. Tap **Search** to launch the browser.

Tap the **microphone icon** to use speech recognition. Speak your search request clearly into the microphone.

- Tap the address bar, enter the website to browse and tap Go.
- Tap Menu > Bookmarks to select an item from your Bookmarks, Most Visited or History tabs.

Browser Menu:



- 1. Tap Menu > Refresh to reload the page. (Stop if still downloading)
- 2. Tap Menu > More > Find on page to search the page.
- 3. Tap **Menu > More > Select text**. Slide your finger to select text to copy to the clipboard.
- 4. Tap **Menu > More > Share page** to send the page by Bluetooth, Email, Messaging etc.
- 5. Tap **Menu > More > Page info/Downloads** to view the page or download history.

Open a new browser window

- 1. Tap **Menu > New window** to open a new browser window.
- 2. Tap the address bar and enter the website address to browse.

Switch between different browser windows

- 1. Tap **Menu > Windows** to view <u>all the</u> open windows.
- 2. Tap the page to browse. Tap **X** to close a window

Open links in web pages

- 1. Open a web page that contains a link.
- 2. **Tap** a link to open the page. **Hold** the link to open the menu:
- Open: Open the web page.
- Open in new window: Open the web page in a new window.
- Bookmark link: Save the link to your Bookmarks.
- Save link: Download the linked web page to your phone.
- Share link: Send the link by Bluetooth, Email, Messaging etc.
- Copy link URL: Copy the link to the clipboard.

Download applications from web pages

- 1. Open a web page that contains an application link.
- Tap the link or hold on the link and select Save link to download the application to your phone.

Add a new bookmark

- 1. Open a web page.
- 2. Tap **Menu > Bookmarks**.
- 3. Tap **Add**.
- Enter a name of the bookmark and tap OK.
 Bookmarks are sorted by time with the latest at the top.

Edit a bookmark

- 1. Open a Browser window.
- 2. Tap Menu > Bookmarks.
- 3. Select an item to edit and hold it until the shortcut menu pops up.

- 4. Select Edit bookmark.
- 5. Edit the name or location, and then tap **OK** to save it.

Delete a bookmark

- 1. Open a Browser window.
- 2. Tap Menu > Bookmarks.
- 3. Select an item to delete and hold it until the menu pops up.
- 4. Select **Delete bookmark** and tap **OK** to confirm the deletion.

Browser Settings

Tap **Menu > More > Settings** from the browser to adjust the Browser settings:

Page content settings

- Text size: Adjust the browser text size.
- **Default zoom:** Set the browser default zoom.
- Open pages in overview: Show an overview of newly opened pages.

Bluetooth




