What You'll Need

- PC

- Microsoft Kinect

Connecting the Kinect

The Microsoft Kinect connects directly to your computer's USB drive via the included connection cable. It also requires an external power source, the cable for which is also included.

Type the path to a directory that contains some jpg images. It can contain other files as well, but should contain at least one .jpg.

Sweeping your arm to the side will cause the next image in the file to load. Sweeping it the other way will cause the previous image to load.
