Using the Remote Controls


Remote controls have different color keys to identify which unit they operate. The remote control with green keys operates Unit A which has a green stripe on the front of the unit.

The remote control with blue keys operates Unit B with a similar blue stripe on the front of the unit.



Using your unit

- Slide the STANDBY / ON switch on the side of the unit to "ON".
- To watch same DVD on 2 DVD players, press the DVD / AV IN button on the GREEN remote control or press and hold the STOP / AV IN button for 3 seconds on the Unit A to select AV IN mode. "AV IN" will be shown on the screen of Unit A for a while.
- To watch different DVDs on 2 DVD players, press the DVD / AV IN button on the GREEN remote control or press and hold the STOP / AV IN button for 3 seconds on the Unit A to select DVD mode.



TIP: Press the STOP button once before turning off the car power or switching off the unit. This will allow you to resume DVD playback at the same place the next time the unit is turned on.


Using in a Vehicle
