Add users to a product

- With the product still highlighted, click on Login Access (Fig 3)
- Tick *Auto Login* for each user that needs to use the Auto Login facility (see below for more details on the Auto Login facility).
- Tick Allow Login for each user that needs to have access to the product.
- Click on *OK* to save changes.

Auto Login

Auto Login allows authenticated EMIS Web users to connect to Partner products without having to re-enter their credentials. If Auto Login is enabled and the user is already logged into an EMIS Web client session, the API will automatically use their EMIS Web credentials to authenticate the login of a Partner product.

After Installation - Using Map of Medicine for the First Time

The user will be prompted to enter their EMIS Web username and password when a Partner product connects to their machine for the first time (*Fig5.*).
