Keys and features



Typing tips

- To capitalize a letter, hold the letter key until the capitalized letter appears or press a **Shift** key and the letter key.
- * To type the alternate character on a key, hold the $\left| {}_{\text{AJ}} \right|$ key and the character key.
- To type a symbol, press the *ww* key. Type the letter that appears below the symbol.
- To turn on NUM lock, press the AT key and the Left Shift key.
 To turn off NUM lock, press the AT key.

Home screen tips

- To open the application list, press the **#** key.
- To return to the Home screen, press the _____ key.
- To lock the keyboard, on the Home screen or in the application list, click **Keyboard Lock**.
- To unlock the keyboard, press the $\left[\begin{smallmatrix}*\\ \mathbf{A}\end{smallmatrix}\right]$ key and the $\boxed{\begin{subarray}{c} \mathbf{A}\end{subarray}}$ key.
- To lock the device, set a password. On the Home screen or in the application list, click Lock.
- To unlock the device, type your password. Press the \checkmark key.
- To turn on standby mode, hold the **Mute** key.

Phone tips

- To make a call from the Home screen, type the phone number. Press the
 - key.
- To end a call, press the _____ key.
- To turn on or turn off mute during a call, press the **Mute** key.
- To turn on or turn off the speakerphone during a call, press the $\begin{pmatrix} \bullet \\ \$ \end{pmatrix}$ key.
- To adjust the volume during a call, press the Volume keys.
- To add an extension to a phone number, press the key and the x key. Type the extension number.

Try this

Make a call using a voice command.

- 1. In the address book, press the **#** key.
- 2. Click New Address.
- 3. Type the contact information.
- 4. Click the trackball.
- 5. Click Save.
- 6. In the voice dialing application, wait for the sound.
- 7. Say "**Call**" and a contact name or phone number.

To end the call, press the _____ key.

Message tips

- To move to the top of a message list, press $\begin{bmatrix} t \\ \tau \end{bmatrix}$.
- To move to the bottom of a message list, press $\begin{bmatrix} ! \\ B \end{bmatrix}$
- To move to the next date in a message list, press $\sqrt{}$.
- To reply to a message, press $\begin{bmatrix} \mathbf{z} \\ \mathbf{R} \end{bmatrix}$.
- To forward a message, press $\begin{bmatrix} a \\ F \end{bmatrix}$.
- To highlight adjacent messages, hold a **Shift** skey and roll the trackball.

Try this

Copy text in a message and paste it into another application.

- 1. In a message, place the cursor before the text that you want to copy.
- 2. Press a **Shift** key and roll the trackball.
- 3. Click the trackball.
- 4. Click Copy.
- 5. Place the cursor where you want to paste the text.
- 6. Click the trackball.
- 7. Click Paste.

Browser tips

- To follow a link, click the link.
- To move to a specific web page, press
- To return to the home page, press $\begin{bmatrix} i \\ H \end{bmatrix}$.
- To open the bookmark list, press $\binom{\prime}{\kappa}$.
- To add a bookmark, press $\begin{bmatrix} * \\ A \end{bmatrix}$.
- To view a list of web pages that you have visited recently, press \overline{r} .
- To refresh a web page, press $\begin{bmatrix} \mathbf{3} \\ \mathbf{R} \end{bmatrix}$.
- To stop loading a web page, press the 🗲 key.
- To close the browser, hold the \searrow key.

Try this

Move through a web page line by line.

1. On a web page, press the **#** key.

2. Click Select Mode.

To select only links and fields as you move through a web page, press the **Figure 1** key. Click **View Mode**.

Organizer tips

- To move to the next day, week, or month in the calendar, press the SPACE key.
- To move to the previous day, week, or month in the calendar, press a **Shift** key and the space key.
- To convert a measurement in the calculator, type a number. Press the Click **To Metric** or **From Metric**. Click a conversion type.
- To search for a contact in a list of contacts, type the contact name or initials separated by a space.

Try this

Assign a ring tone to a contact.

- 1. In the address book, highlight a contact.
- 2. Press the 📑 key.
- 3. Click Edit.
- 4. Click the trackball.
- 5. Click Add Custom Phone Tune.
- 6. Set a ring tone.
- 7. Press the 📑 key.
- 8. Click Save.

Media tips

- To zoom in to a picture, press [,].
 To zoom out from a picture, press [,].
 To zoom to the original picture size, press [,], w.
- To rotate a picture, press $\begin{bmatrix} \mathbf{3} \\ \mathbf{R} \end{bmatrix}$.
- To pause a slide show, press the SPAGE key.
- To resume a slide show, press the SPACE key again.
- To pause a video or song, press the **Mute** key.
- To resume playing a video or song, press the **Mute** key again.

Try this

Use a picture as your Home screen background.

- 1. In the media application, click Pictures
- 2. Click My Pictures.
- 3. Highlight a picture.
- 4. Press the 📑 key.
- 5. Click Set As Home Screen Image.

To clear the picture from the Home screen, press the **FF** key. Click **Reset Home Screen Image**.
