



- 8 Microphone




## Switch the Headset On or Off

## Switch on Press the multifunction button

for 3 seconds until the blue LED lights up

#### Switch off

Press the multifunction button for 3 seconds until the red LED lights up



# Pair with Your Smartphone / Tablet

- 1. Switch on the P253 BT by press the multifunction button for 3 seconds.
- The P253 BT automatically enters pairing mode shown by the red and blue LED flash alternately.
- Turn on Bluetooth on your phone and pair it with the headphone.

## Example: iOS

Press Settings > General > Bluetooth and switch Bluetooth on > ARCTIC P253 BT > Pair













#### Example: Android 4.0

Press Menu > Settings > Switch on Bluetooth > Bluetooth > Search for devices > ARCTIC P253 BT > Pair













#### Notes:

- Pairing mode will last up to ten minutes or until a device is found, two tones will sound to let you know when pairing has stopped.
- If you exceed the effective range of approx. 10M (33ft) the headphone will disconnect and will automatically reconnect if the speaker re-enters the effective range within ten minutes.




## **Phone Operations**

If the mobile device that is paired (via Bluetooth) with the P253 BT headphone is a cellular phone you can:

| Answer Call                   | Press Conce.                                   |
|-------------------------------|--|
| End Call                      | Press 	once.                                   |
| Refuse Call                   | Press and hold 	for 2 seconds.                 |
| Redial the last dialed number | Press and hold ▶ for 2 seconds.                |
| Switch Call                   | Press and hold  for 2 seconds while in a call. |

## **Headset Controls**


## Reconnection

- 1. Turn on Bluetooth on phone.
- Switch on the P253 BT by press the multifunction button for 3 seconds.
- If your device was the latest one to be paired with the P253 BT it will connect automatically otherwise please repeat pairing section.

## Charging the Headset

The P253 BT can be charged while switched on or off.

- Insert the micro USB cable into the P253 BT and the USB side into a power source. (We recommend the Home Charger 4500).
- When the Blue light on constantly the P253 BT is fully charged.



It is recommended to fully charge before initial use for better battery life.

## Cautions

- Wireless connections are affected by obstructions such as walls, human body and other devices.
- Keep P253 BT dry, moisture may damage electronic components.
- Exposure to high temperature will shorten the life and damage electronic components.
- · Opening / altering the P253 BT voids all product warranty.
- · Rough handling may damage inside electronic components.
