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




Mounting the Stand













Front View

CH+/-: Press to scan through channels.


VOL+/-: Press to adjust the volume.

Tint

Press $\blacktriangle/\blacktriangledown$ button and then use $\blacktriangleleft/\blacktriangleright$ to adjust the tone of colour when your system is in NTSC.

Colour temperature

Press ▲/▼ button and then use ◄/▶ to adjust the optimum colour temperature mode to suit your eyes for viewing.

The picture looks more brighter when the COLOUR TEMPERATURE is higher.

Aspect Ratio

Press ▼/▲ button to select Aspect Ratio, then press OK button or ▶ button to enter.

Noise Reduction
