- 4. If the lamb is alive enter the tag number you are giving it. Select a date of tagging.
- 5. Use the drop down menus to select the breed and sex of the lamb.
- 6. Enter the birth weight of the lamb if known. If not a default weight of 4 Kg is assigned. If you are using imperial pounds (lbs) instead of metric kilogram (Kg) then ignore the Kg symbol beside the weight field.
- Optional: Select Lambing Difficulty from the drop down list or enter values into Lambing Scores. For a full explanation of the lambing trait scoring system refer to Lambing Scores in the Procedures chapter in this user manual.
- 8. Enter any comment that you wish to make on the lambing and click on **Add Comment**. This comment will then appear in the main details section for the dam.
- 9. If the lamb was stillborn/aborted or died before tagging, click the *Lamb lost (Still born or aborted)* button and enter details.
- 10.Click on **OK/Save** to save after entering each lamb. Click on **Cancel/Exit** to exit the screen.
