The RAC seal is a trust-mark that indicates quality and commitment to sustainable farming practices. Companies using the RAC seal gain the reward of a marketplace where consumers are increasingly asking for responsibly produced products.

Producers whose farms are Rainforest Alliance Certified™ and buyers who source products from these farms are granted conditional permission to use the Rainforest Alliance Certified™ (RAC) seal on their products and in related marketing materials as set forth in our guidelines.

The process is simple. Once you have added the seal and/or copy to your design layout complete the Approval Request from, upload/attach your files and press submit. Our review process generally takes about five (5) days. If the artwork does not meet our guidelines, you will be promptly notified with requested changes.

The RAC seal is a proprietary, single graphic unit that must never be altered from its original form. Our Use of Seal Guidelines was developed to protect the value and integrity of the RAC seal. You are advised to read though our Guidelines carefully before applying the seal to any of your packaging and/or marketing materials. Trust us, it will save you time in the long run! Minimum Sine Requirements

Following minimum size guidelines ensures that the seal is consistent and legible in all applications. For product prolonging and marketing materials the RAC seal should never be reproduced smaller than one inch (25 mm) across.

Scaling the size of the seal to the size of the marketing material is permitted, on large marketing materials such as between or displays, the seal size must be increased in diameter proportionately to the size of the material to ensure highest visibility.

Approved Color of the RAC Seal.

To ensure consistency, the RAC seal is approved for use in only one color: Fantons* 625 green. No other color versions of the seal are parmitted. The green RAC seal is set on a white background, and has a tim white cettine around the edge of the seal to ensure that it stands out from any background color. For black and white premotional materials only, the RAC seal is available in black on a white background colors are parmitted to show through the seal.

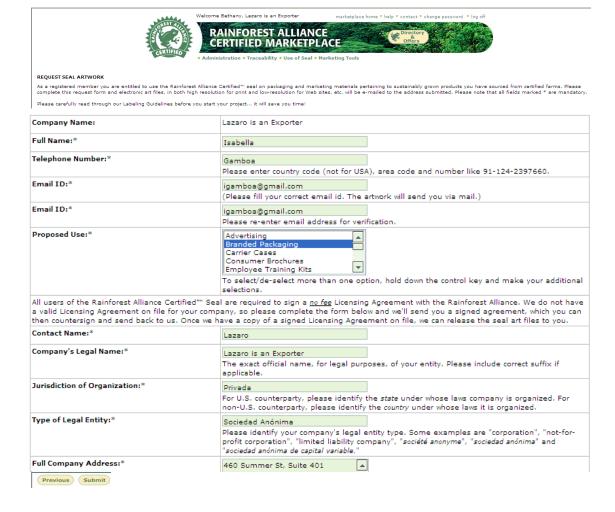

- <u>License</u>. Subject to the terms and conditions of this agreement, we, Rainforest Alliance, Inc., a New York not-for-profit corporation, are pleased to grant to you, <u>Licensee's legal name</u>, a/an jurisdiction of organization type of legal entity, a non-exclusive, non-transferable, royalty-free license to reproduce the Seal on product packaging and off-product promotional materials for agricultural products from farms certified under the economic and social sustainability standards of the Sustainable Agriculture Network (each such farm, a "<u>Certified Farm</u>," and each such product derived from a Certified Farm, the "<u>Certified Farm Product</u>").

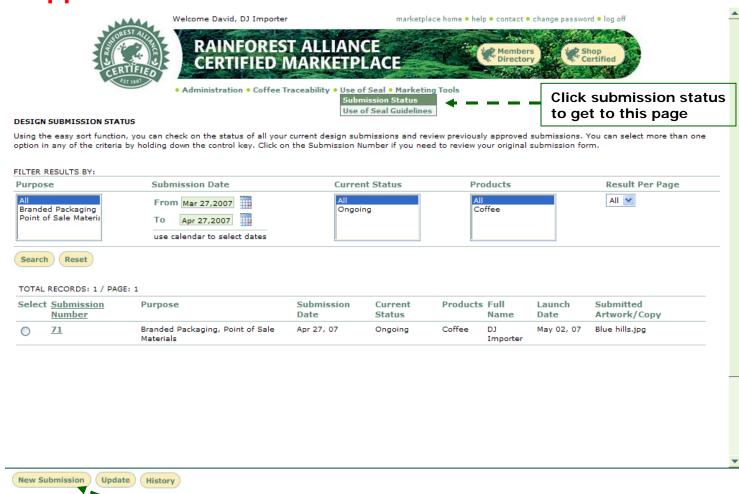

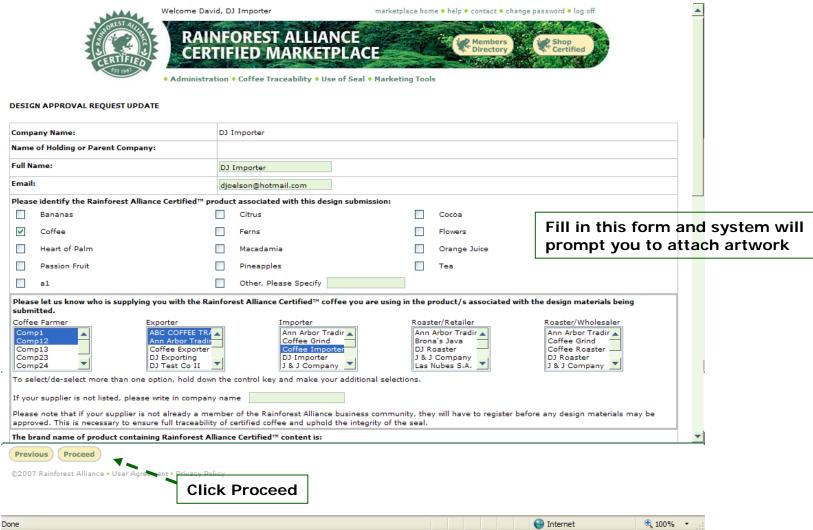

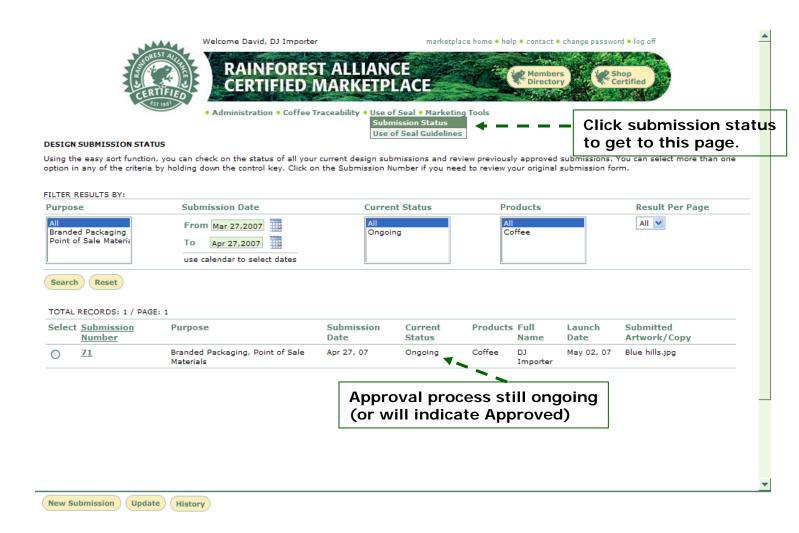
