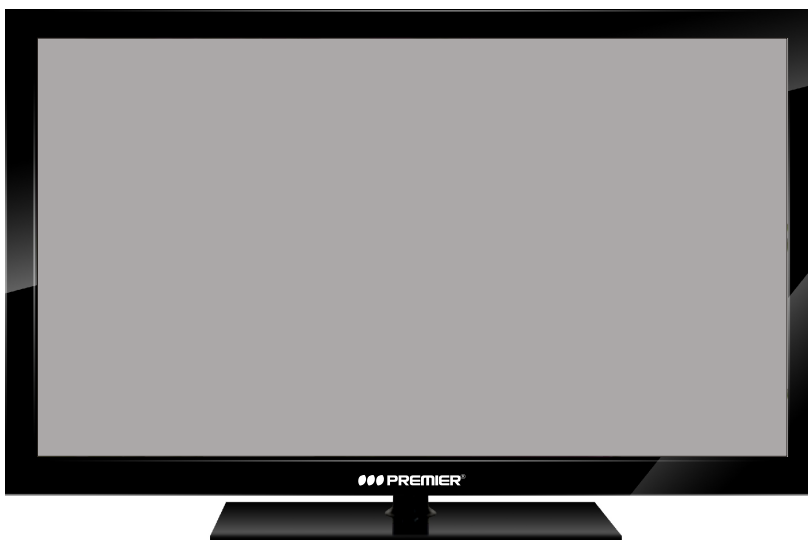

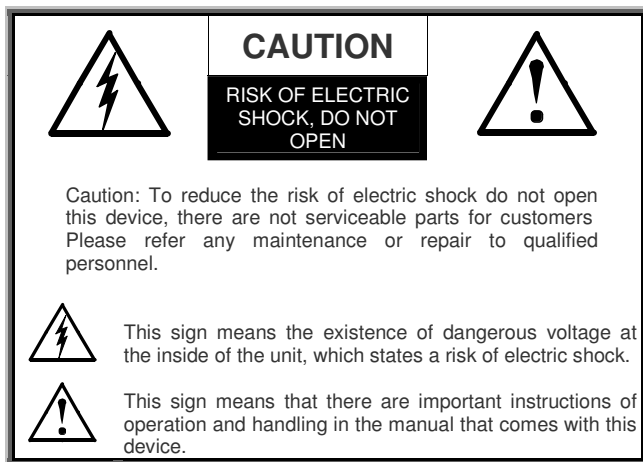

### Attention:

Motionless picture might cause permanent destruction to the display.

- Be sure not to display motionless picture on the PDP TV for more than 2 hours, because it would cause picture remnants to appear, which is called "screen burns". To avoid such picture remnants, please decrease the "contrast" and "brightness" of the display when displaying motionless picture.
- While watching TV program in 4:3 size mode for a long time, there would be traces on the edge of the screen's left, right and center parts because of different transmission of the light on the screen. Similar impact on the screen will occur when playing DVD or connecting games control. Products destroyed by these reasons can't be guaranteed for maintenance.
- It might cause picture remnants to display electronic games and motionless picture of PC more than a period of time. To avoid such effect, please decrease the "contrast" and "brightness" when displaying motionless picture.

## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

If a television is not positioned in a sufficiently stable location, it can be potentially hazardous due to falling. Many injuries, particularly to children, can be avoided by taking simple precautions such as:

- Using cabinets or stands recommended by the manufacturer of the television.

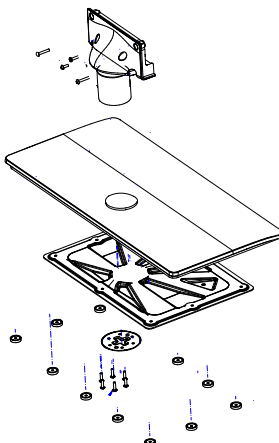

## 1.2 Installation of Stand



1. Place the TV with the front panel facing downwards on the soft cloth or soft pads on a desk.
2. Please put the PVC sticker on the turning axle firstly
3. Insert the stand into the bottom socket of the TV.
4. Insert the screws into the sockets and tighten them.

## 1.3 Installation of Wall Mount Kit(Optional)

The Wall Mount Kit can help install the TV on the wall.

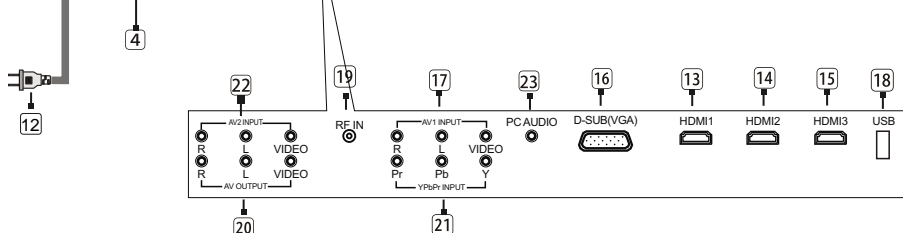
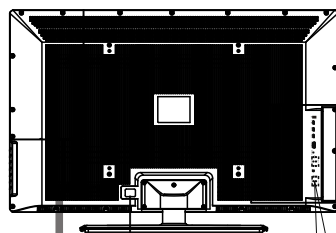
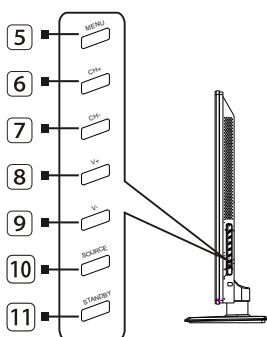
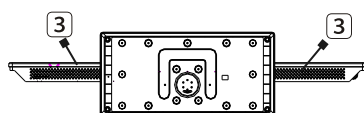
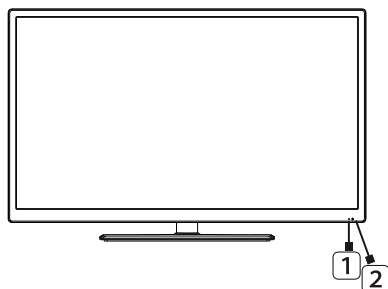

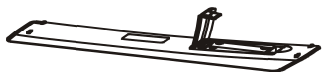


## 1.5 Remote Control



1. STANDBY(⏻): Standby turn on and off.
2. SOURCE: Select the signal source.
3. 0~9: Continue to press the keys to select a channel.
4. DISPLAY: Display the information of current video and audio.
5. RECALL: Return to previous channel.
6. FREEZE: Freeze the picture.
7. FAV+: Add favorite.
8. CH LIST: Channel list
9. FAV.LIST: Favorite channel list
10. VOL+: Increase the volume.
11. CH+: Select the channel forward.
12. MUTE: Mute sound.
13. VOL-: Decrease the volume.
14. CH-: Select the channel backward.
15. MENU: Enter or exit menu.
16. EXIT: Exit menu or operation.
17. ▲,▼,◀,▶ key: The menu item selection.
18. ENTER: Confirm or enter.
19. S.MODE: Select the sound mode.
20. CCD/⏸:
  - TV mode: Change the CCD mode ;
  - MEDIA mode: Press one time to pause, press twice to playback.
21. MTS/■:
  - TV mode: Change the MTS mode;
  - MEDIA mode: ■ Stop the playback and return to filelist.
22. P.MODE: Select the picture mode.
23. ZOOM: Zoom in or out the current picture. (Some pictures or videos may not be operated.)
24. A-B: Setup repeat play segment.
25. REPEAT: Allows you to repeat single, random, shuffle and folder.

## 1.6 Installation of Batteries



1. Open the back lid of the remote control.

2. Install two 7#(AAA)1.5V batteries.  
Ensure the correct polarity of the batteries.



3. Cover the back lid.  
Please take out of the batteries from the remote control for long time of no use.



If the remote control doesn't work properly, please carry out the following checks.



- Check the TV is turned on.
- Check the polarity of the batteries are correct.
- Check the batteries are not drained.
- Check the power supply is normal or the power cord is correctly connected.
- Check there are no special fluorescent light or neon light around.

## 2. Basic Operation

### 2.1 Standby ON/OFF

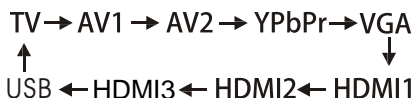
- Insert the power cord into the appropriate socket. then press **STANDBY** button to turn on the unit.

### 2.2 Setting of Standby Mode

- Press (  ) button to turn on the unit.
- Press (  ) button again to return the display to standby mode. The power indicator turns red.
- Be sure not to set your TV in standby mode for a long period of time.

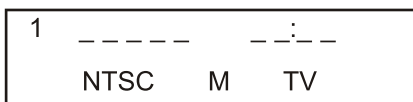
### 2.3 Selection of Input Mode

This set has different signal source modes, you may continue to press the **Source** button to select a signal source.



When selecting the signal source, the screen will display the information.

TV mode



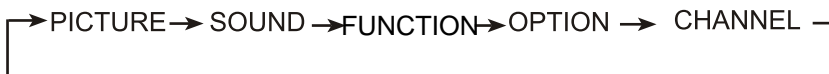
When there is no signal from the selected source, the warning message will be displayed as per illustration. Either change the channel in TV mode or press **Source** button to change source.



## 2.4 Menu Option Adjustment

After you have installed the batteries into the remote control, you will need to set some preferences on the PDP TV, using the menu system.

- The buttons for menu option adjustment include: **Menu**, **▲**, **▼**, **◀**, **▶** **Enter** buttons.
- Press the **Menu** button to open the OSD Menu, then press **▲**, **▼** button to select the pages. The pages are displayed in the following sequence (circular display):



*Note: "CHANNEL" is only for TV.*

- 1 Press the **Menu** button to display the menu system.
- 2 Press **▲**, **▼** button to select the menu pages.
- 3 Press **▶**, and then press **▲**, **▼** button to select an item.
- 4 Press **◀**, **▶** button to select or adjust a setting.
- 5 If you do not make a selection within 15 seconds, the menu will close automatically.
- 6 Press the **Menu** button to return or exit OSD menu.

## 2.5 Menu Functions

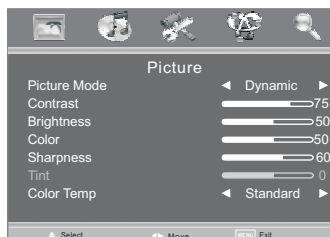
### 2.5.1 PICTURE Function

1. Press **MENU** key to display the main menu on the screen.
2. Press "**◀▶**" key to select "Picture" option.
3. Press "**▼**" key to enter "Picture" submenu.
4. Press "**▲/▼**" key to select the items.

#### **Picture Mode**

Your TV has four picture settings (Standard, Mild, user, dynamic) that are preset at the factory. You can set to your preference by adjusting particular items such as Contrast, Brightness, Sharpness, Tint, Color.

1. Press **▲/▼** key to select "Picture Mode" option.
2. Press **◀▶** key to select one picture mode.



Standard: Selects the picture for optimum display in a normal environment.

Dynamic: Selects the picture for high-definition in a bright room.

MILD: Selects the picture for comfortable display in a dark room.

User: Select to view your favorite display settings (see User settings for PICTURE).

#### **User settings for PICTURE (Contrast, Brightness, Color, Sharpness, Tint)**

Your set has several settings which allow you to control picture quality.

1. Press **▲/▼** key to select a particular item.
2. Press **◀▶** key to decrease or increase the value of a particular item.

Note: The adjusted values are stored according to the selected particular item.

Contrast: Adjusts the lightness and darkness between objects and the background.

Brightness: Adjusts the brightness of the picture.

Color: Adjusts the colors, making them lighter or darker.

Sharpness: Adjusts the outline of objects to either sharpen them or make them more dull.

Tint: Adjusts the color of objects, making them more red or green for a more natural look.

Tint can only be adjusted when signal is NTSC.

#### **Adjusting the Color Temp**

You can change the color of the entire screen according to your preference.

1. Press **▲/▼** key to select "Color Temp" option.
2. Press **◀▶** key to select one color temp.

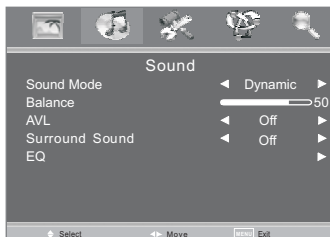
Standard: Keeps whites white.

Warm: Makes whites reddish.

Cool: Makes whites bluish.

## 2.5.2 SOUND Function

1. Press **MENU** key to display the main menu on the screen.
2. Press "**◀/▶**" key to select "Sound" option.
3. Press "**▼**" key to enter "Sound" submenu.
4. Press "**▲/▼**" key to select the items.
5. You can also press the **SOUND** key on the remote control to select one of the sound settings.



### Sound Mode

You can select the type of special sound settings to be used when watching a given broadcast.

Your TV has ten sound settings ("Standard", "News", "Movie", "Sports", "Dance", "Classic", "Pop", "Rock", "Jazz", "Soft") that are preset at the factory.

1. Press **▲/▼** key to select "Sound Mode" option.
2. Press **◀/▶** key to select one sound mode.

- Standard: Selects the normal sound mode.
- Movie: Provides live and full sound for movies.
- News: Provides smooth and sound for news.
- Sports: Emphasizes bass over other sounds.
- Dance, Classic, Pop, Rock, Jazz, Soft: Emphasizes music over voices.

### Balance

If the volumes of the left speaker and the right speaker are not the same, you can adjust the "Balance" to suit your personal preference.

1. Press **▲/▼** key to select "Balance" option.
2. Press **◀/▶** key to decrease or increase the value of the item.

### Auto Volume

Each broadcasting station has its own signal conditions, and it is inconvenient to adjust the volume every time the channel is changed. "Auto Volume" automatically adjusts the volume of the desired channel by lowering the sound output when the modulation signal is high or by raising the sound output when the modulation signal is low.

1. Press **▲/▼** key to select "Auto Volume" option.
2. Press **◀/▶** key to select "On" or "Off".

### Surround Sound

You can select the type of surround sound settings to be used when watching a given broadcast.

Your TV has three sound settings ("Off", "Surround") that are preset at the factory.

1. Press **▲/▼** key to select "Surround sound" option.
2. Press **◀/▶** key to select one surround sound mode.

## EQ

Your set has several settings which allow you to control sound quality(120Hz, 200Hz,500Hz, 1.2KHz, 3KHz, 7.5KHz or 12KHz).

1. Press ▲/▼ key to select a particular item.
2. Press ◀/▶ key to decrease or increase the value of a particular item.

Note: The adjusted values are stored according to the selected particular item.



## 2.5.3 FUNCTION Function

1. Press **MENU** key to display the main menu on the screen.
2. Press "◀/▶" key to select "Function" option.
3. Press "▼" key to enter "Function" submenu.
4. Press "▲/▼" key to select the items.

### Noise Reduction

1. Press▲/▼key to select "Noise Reduction" option.
2. Press ◀/▶key to select "Off", "Low", "Middle", "High" and "DEFAULT" to improve the picture sharpness.



Note: Noise Reduction doesn't work in Full Defi mode in VGA source.

### Aspect

You can select the picture size which best corresponds to your viewing requirement.

1. Press ▲/▼ key to select "Aspect" option.
2. Press ◀/▶ key to set the scale mode.

You can also press "Zoom" key on the remote control to select one of the scale modes.

**TV/AV:** 16:9,4:3,Movie,Subtitle.

**USB:** Auto, 16:9, 4:3.

**YPbPr:** Fullview, 16:9, 4:3.

**HDMI :** Fullview, 16:9, 4:3, Full Defi.

**VGA :** 16:9, Full Defi.

### Caption

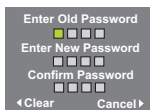
1. Press ▲/▼ key to select "Caption" option.
2. Press◀/▶key to select Caption, "Off", "CC 1", "CC 2", "CC 3", "CC 4", "Text 1", "Text 2", "Text 3" and "Text 4".

### Enter Password

1. Press ▲/▼ key to select "Enter Password" option.
2. Enter your 4 digit code(factory default code is "0000"),unless previously changed to enter the submenu.

### Change Password

1. Press ▲/▼ key to select "Change Password" option.
2. Press ENTER or ◀/▶ key to display the "Change Password" submenu.



### System Lock

Press ▲/▼ key to select "System Lock" option. then press ◀/▶ key to select On or Off.

### USA TV

1. Press ▲/▼ key to select "USA TV " option. then press ◀/▶ key to "TV RATING" menu.
2. Press ▲/▼ ◀/▶ key to select item. then press ENTER key to BLOCK or UNBLOCK.

### USA MPAA

1. Press ▲/▼ key to select "USA MPAA" option.
2. Press ◀/▶ key to select N/A、X、NC-17、R、PG-13、PG、G .

### Canada English

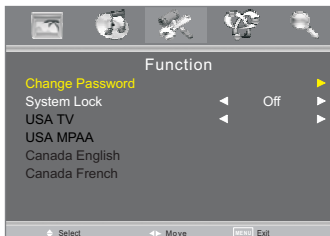
1. Press ▲/▼ key to select "Canada English" option. then press ◀/▶ key to select EXEMPT、18+、14+、PG、G、C8+、C.

### Canada French

1. Press ▲/▼ key to select "Canada French" option. then press ◀/▶ key to select EXEMPT、18ans+、16ans+、13ans+、8ans+、G.

### Panel Protect

1. Press ▲/▼ key to select "Panel Protect" option.
2. Press ◀/▶ key to select On/Off

TV-Y :Suitable for all the children  
 TV-Y7:Suitable for all the children above 7 years old  
 TV-G :Suitable for all people  
 TV-PG:Children under parents' guidance  
 TV-14 :Not suitable for children under 14

## 2.5.4 OPTION Function

1. Press **MENU** key to display the main menu on the screen.
2. Press "**◀/▶**" key to select "Option" option.
3. Press "**▼**" key to enter "Option" submenu.
4. Press "**▲/▼**" key to select the items.

### **OSD language**

You can modify the OSD set to suit your user preferences.

1. Press **▲/▼** key to select "OSD language" option.
2. Press **▶** key to select the proper language.



### **Sleep Timer**

1. Press **▲/▼** key to select "Sleep Timer" option.
2. Press **◀/▶** key repeatedly until the desired time appears (Off, 10min, 20min, 30min, 60min, 90min, 120min, 180min, 240min).

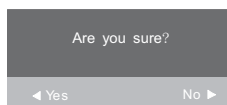
**Notes:** The sleep timer you have set will be cancelled when the TV turns off or if a power failure occurs.

When the time is less than 60 seconds, remind information will be displayed on the screen. Press any key button to cancel timer function.

### **RESET**

Select the "Reset" option and press OK or **▶** key to display a confirm box, and select "Yes" or "No".

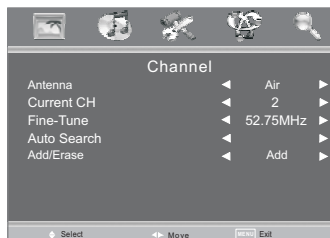
**Note:** Please use the "Reset" option with caution as it will return all settings and channel memories to factory default.





## 2.5.5 CHANNEL Function

1. Press **MENU** key to display the main menu on the screen.
2. Press "**◀/▶**" key to select "Channel" option.
3. Press "**▼**" key to enter "Channel" submenu.
4. Press "**▲/▼**" key to select the items.



### **Antenna**

1. Press **▲/▼** key to select "Antenna" option, you can see the current channel Antenna Type.
2. You can also press **◀/▶** key to select Antenna Type Select ("Air", "CATV-STD", "CATV-IRC" or "CATV-HRC").

### **Current CH**

1. Press **▲/▼** key to select "Current CH" option, you can see the current channel number.
2. You can also press **◀/▶** key to change the current channel.

### **Fine-Tune**

In case of unfavorable image or sound of TV program, you can use "Fine Tune" function to obtain satisfied image or sound.

1. Press **▲/▼** key to select "Fine Tune" option.
2. Press **◀/▶** key to conduct fine tuning from high frequency to low frequency or from low frequency to high frequency till best picture or sound effect is obtained.

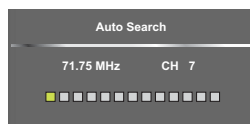
### **Auto Search**

The TV automatically cycles through all of the available channels and stores them in memory.

1. Press **▲/▼** key to select "Auto Search" option.
2. Press **▶** key to start channel searching and end automatically.
3. After all the available channels are stored, the "Channel" menu will exit and TV will turn to the first stored channel automatically.

Note: 1. Press EXIT or MENU key to interrupt the memorization process.

2. You must use "Auto Search" to search TV channels in order to memorize all channels when use the TV for the first time.
3. If the TV is not in TV input state, you must switch it to TV state.



### **Add/Erase**

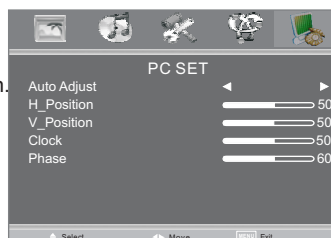
Channel No. is available when this item is set to Add or Erase.

## 2.5.6 PC SET Function

### PC SET

This option is only used when PC mode has signal.

1. Press **MENU** key to display the menu on the screen.
2. Press "**◀/▶**" key to select "PC SET" option.
3. Press "**▼**" key to enter "PC SET" submenu.
4. Press "**▲/▼**" key to select the items.



- ♦Auto Adjust: Allows you to set the TV to self-adjust to the incoming PC video signal. The fine, coarse and position values are adjusted automatically.
- ♦H-Position: Set horizontal position of picture.
- ♦V-Position: Set vertical position of picture.
- ♦Clock/Phase: Remove or reduce picture noise.

### Initialization Interface

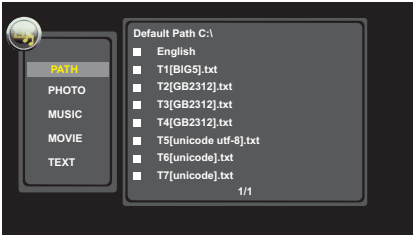
Into the USB channel, the interface shown in Figure 1. If no inserted U disk, the system will be prompted to insert the USB device, while the lower right corner screen displays "No Device" message. When you insert a U disk, select the first letter located in the C drive, shown in Figure 2. The corresponding buttons as follows:

UP and Down keys: Select the drive letter.

ENTER / Right key: to enter the selected letter.

## 2.6.2 USB Funtion

### 1. Photo

**Features:** Browse and play under the specified path (the default path is specified in the current disk, set the photo interface methods please refer to the specified path: path - Set) picture.

**Content:** Browse and play all the images under the specified path.

**Photos View** Shown in Figure 3

**Features:** Displays thumbnails of all images path, bmp and png format does not support thumbnails.

**Key operation:** Up, Down, Left, Right: Option key to switch up and down.

**Right Key:** elected in the entry photo option on the left, the switch to the image preview area, was elected in the image preview area in the right section, then play image files.

**Exit Key:** elected in the entry in the right image preview area, select the entries to switch back to the left side of photo options, the elected option in the entry on the left picture, the switch back to the USB interface initialization.

**Photo Play interface** (Shown in Figure 4)

**Key operation:**

The following key: Play on a picture / next picture

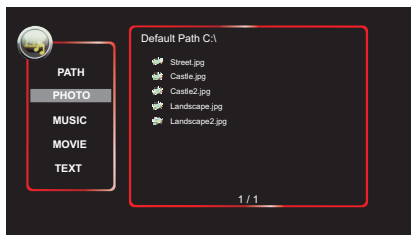
Left, Right: Reverse / Rotate the image clockwise

Confirmation: play / pause image

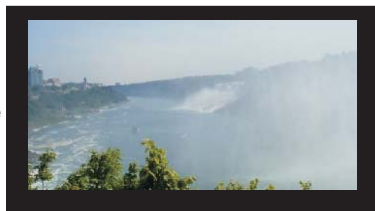

No Input Signal message appears.	-Check that the signal line is connected properly. -Check that the power of the relevant peripherals is turned on. -Check that the Input option that has been selected matches with the input signal.
The remote control does not function properly.	-Check the batteries are not drained.(Use new batteries.) -Check that the remote control is within the operating range. -Check that the remote control is pointed to the remote control window on the display. -Check that there are no obstacles between the remote control and the remote control window.
Flashing spots or stripes appear on the screen.	-Check that there are no emission (Car, HV cable or Neon lamp) or other possible interference sources.
Image colour or quality deteriorates.	-Check that all the video settings are adjusted appropriately, such as brightness, contrast, colour etc. -For more information about video settings, refer to OSD Functions in Chapter 2.
Screen position and size are incorrect.	-Check that the screen position and size is adjusted appropriately.
Image or colour is incorrect.	-Check that the signal line is connected properly. -When connecting to a PC, you can change the resolution of the PC to acquire the correct image. The discrepancy of the PC output signal may affect the display of the image.
