POWER SUPPLY AND CONNECTION

Battery Operation

- > Remove Battery Compartment Cover.
- Insert 8 X C size batteries (UM-2 or equivalent) in correct polarity as indicated inside the compartment.
- > Replace the cover.

Note

Check your batteries regularly, old or discharged batteries should be replaced. If the unit is not going to be used for some time or is being run exclusively on alternative power, remove the batteries to avoid leakage and damage.

To remove batteries from compartment, open the cover and simply shake the unit gently or place it slightly downward.

We recommend using Alkaline type batteries.

AC Main Operation

Take the supplied AC Power Cord and connect the corresponding end to the AC Socket and household mains outlet. Make sure the voltage is compatible.

Nota:

If you plug the AC power cord off from the AC socket and from the unit, the unit will operate with DC power.

RADIO OPERATION

Operation

- > Set Function Selector to "RADIO" position.
- > Select the desired radio frequency band with Band Selector.
- Rotate Tuning Control to set the Dial Pointer against the station frequency as marked on the dial scale.
- Adjust Volume Control to the desired level. To turn off the radio, set Function Selector to "OFF" position.

Antenna

For FM stations, extend the Telescopic Antenna to full length, for the best reception. However, medium wave signals are picked up through the built-in ferrite antenna. You may have to orientate the set to obtain the clearest reception.

PLAYING COMPACT DISC

Getting Start

- Set the Function Selector to "CD" position. Open the lid, insert a disc on the CD tray then close the lid.
- 2. The display will show the total number of tracks of the disc.
- 3. Do not swing or shock the unit when playing CD, otherwise it may not function properly.

General Operation

Play/Pause Button

Press once to start play. The right hand side indicator will on. Press twice to stop playing disc temporarily. The right hand side indicator will flash. Press once more to play again.

Stop Button

Press to stop play. Total number of track will show again.

Skip Up Button

Press and release skip up key to go to next track. Press and hold skip up key to fast forward the track being played. After CD head has read disc, press and hold the key to fast search the track desired.

Skip Down Button

Press and release skip down key to go back to the beginning of the track being played. Press twice to go back to previous track. Press and hold skip down key to fast backward the track being played.

Repeat 1

Press repeat key once, the track No. shown will be repeated. The left hand side indicator will flash.

Repeat All

Press repeat key twice, all tracks will be repeated. The left hand side indicator will on. Press again will resume to normal play, repeat indicator will go off.

Program Button

At stop mode, press PROGRAM button, the track no. on display will flash. Use the SKIP UP/SKIP DOWN button to choose the tracks you wish to program, then press PROGRAM button again to finish the first track programming.

Repeat the above steps to program more tracks. Maximum 20 tracks can be programmed. Press play button to start, the tracks will play in programmed orders. To clear the program memory, press STOP/CD open.

Random Button

Press the RANDOM button in play/stop mode, press the SKIP/UP button. Playback will start from any one track (not in the order of the disc).

MAINTENANCE & CARE

- Check your batteries regularly, old or discharged batteries should be replaced.
 If the unit is not going to be used for some time or is being run exclusively on alternative power, remove the batteries to avoid leakage and damage.
- Electronic products of this kind should never be subjected to extreme temperatures or high humidity to ensure normal functioning and a long life-time. For instance, this set should not be placed in bathing areas, nor close to stoves and radiators.
- If necessary, clean the unit with a piece of soft dry cloth only. (Be sure the AC Power Cord is disconnected from the Mains) Never use a polish nor a strong detergent as this will damage the finish of the cabinet.
