


OPERATION MANUAL



Operation

- 1 / On standby mode LCD indicates the time.
- 2 / Make sure to slide the lock switch to off position for normal operation.
- 3 / Press power button to turn the radio on.

Manual/Auto Tuning

- 4 / Press band button to select AM or FM band.
- 5 / Press up (\triangleright) or down (\triangleleft) button once to increase or decrease the exiting frequency by one step.
- 6 / Press and hold up (▷) or down (◁) button for 2 seconds for auto tuning, once frequency proceeds forward or backward,release the button for auto tuning. Auto tuning stops when broadcast station signal is received.

Memory Setting

- 7 / Tune radio to desired station.
- 8 / Press memory button once to initiate memory writing process
- 9/ Press up (\triangleright) or down (\triangleleft) button to desired memory location (1-10 memory location).
- 10/ Press memory button once to save memory to desired location.

- 11/ To recall the memory press preset button.
 - 12/ Last AM/FM frequency and memory can be preserved, if the time of replacing the batteries is not more than 30 seconds(radio off mode).

Time Setting

- 13/ Turn off the power.
- 14/ Press clock-adjust button for 2 seconds, LCD hours digit will blink. Press up (\triangleright) or down (\triangleleft) button to adjust hour setting, then press clock-adjust button once, LCD minutes digit will blink. Press up (\triangleright) or down (\triangleleft) button to adjust minute time setting.

Volume level setting

15/ Press volume button (+) or (-) once to increase or decrease the output level by one step.

DBBS switch

16/ Slide the DBBS switch on or off for dynamic bass boost system function on or off.

Other function

17/ Lock switch is designed to prevent any unwanted function change during radio on or off mode. No other function buttons operate on lock mode, except DBBS function. Switching on lock mode LCD displays the locker symbol.
