## 3 Buttons

Button	Description
 The icon for the Barcode button consists of three vertically stacked elements: two narrow, rounded rectangular buttons at the top and a larger, rounded square button at the bottom with the word "SCAN" centered inside it.	<b>Barcode button</b> Used to operate the barcode functions.
 The icon for the Call button is a single, horizontally-oriented rectangular button with a small L-shaped symbol inside.	<b>Call button</b> Used to start the phone program. If you press this button once while using the phone program, a call is made to the last party in the call list.

	<p><b>End button</b> Ends the phone program. You can finish a call by pressing this button during the call. You can also exit an application program. Press and hold (at least 3 sec) this button to switch off the phone function.</p>

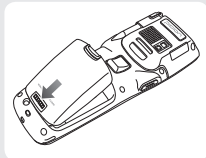

# Learning Basics

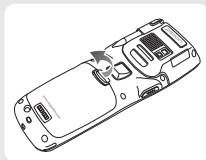
## 1 Connecting/Disconnecting Battery

[To connect the battery]



Align the battery to the groove and insert in the direction of the arrow.

[To disconnect the battery]



Push down using both thumbs to remove the cover.

- We strongly recommend that you use the adapter which was purchased with the product for charging the battery.
- However, the 20pin charger of an ordinary mobile phone may also be used to charge the PDA battery. (Due to the characteristics of a standard charger, there may be small discharge of electricity despite the charger being fully charged.)



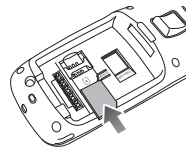
## 2 Insert/Remove the USIM Card

### What is a USIM card?

- USIM (Universal Subscriber Identity Module) is a user identification card which is inserted into a W-CDMA phone.
- This card integrating the SIM card containing subscriber information and the Universal IC Card(UICC) containing communication and banking function provides various functions including user authentication, global roaming, and e-transaction.
- This chip is required for communication with the 3rd generation WCDMA terminals. You can use this card in voice mobile call including international roaming and e-commerce service regardless of type of terminal and communication service provider.

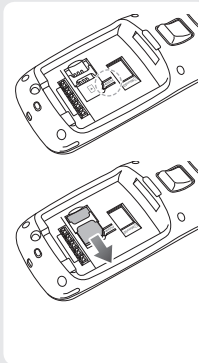


### [Insert the USIM Card]



Insert the USIM card with its gold contacts face down. Its cut off corner should match the cut off corner in the slot.

## [Remove the USIM Card]



To remove the USIM card, lightly slide it away from slot.

## 3 Insert/Remove the MicroSD Card

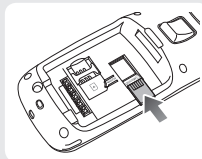


**What is a MicroSD card?** MicroSD card is a micro flash memory media which is used to store and move data.

### [Precautions]

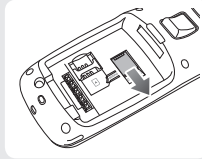
- Applying excessive force to remove the memory card will result in a fault of the device.
- Removing the memory card or shutting power off while using a memory card may result in loss of data, or malfunction of the card and the terminal.
- Make sure to back up critical data in the computer. The manufacturer resumes no responsibility for loss of data in the device.
- If the memory card gets stuck to the device, do not remove the card by force, but visit the nearest after-sales service center. And then, replace or return the card to the dealer from which you purchased the card.

## [Insert the MicroSD]



Please push the MicroSD with facing up toward the arrow.

## [Remove the MicroSD]



When you push MicroSD deeply toward inside by finger, it will come out and take that part out.

## 5 Switching On/Off power



Power Button

- The [Power] button is located on the right side of the product.
- The **[Power]** button should be pressed shortly.
- If the **[Power]** button is pushed for more than 3 seconds, the LCD Back Light will turn On/Off.
- Even when the power is turned off, if the GSM modem is turned on the PDA will also power on automatically so you can answer the phone.



## 6 Communication status indication

For the terminals which support WCDMA communication, you can view the GSM or WCDMA 1xEVDO communication status with the [Communication status indication lamp] on the upper right side of the terminal.

Communication status indication lamp

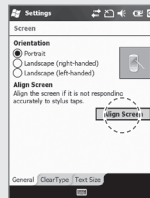


**For the terminals which support GSM communication,** the lamp indicates the GSM communication status.

**For the terminals which support WCDMA 1xEVDO,** the lamp indicates the WCDMA 1xEVDO communication status.

※ The wireless LAN status is not indicated with the lamp.

## 7 Adjusting screen



### align screen

Tap the target firmly and accurately at each location on the screen. The target will continue to move until the screen is aligned.



You can set the stylus pen input value on the LCD screen.

### Setting screen

**Start ▶ Settings ▶ System ▶ Screen ▶ Align Screen**

Point the target in the center of the screen with the stylus pen. As the target moves to left top, left bottom, right bottom and right top, point the target accurately.

# Learning Basics

## 8 Using stylus pen

Use a stylus pen to select/execute/move a target on the screen. The stylus pen is attached in the top right of the terminal.



### Tap

You can touch icons on the screen with the stylus pen to select or execute the icon as you click the left mouse button.

### Drag

Used to select multiple items. You can select characters or images as you drag the mouse pointer.

### Tap and Hold

Used to view the functions of the selected item. If you tap and hold with the stylus pen, a menu pops up as you select an item and click the right mouse button.

## 9 Resetting terminal





Press the **[Reset]** button on the front of the terminal slightly with the stylus pen.



- If there is a collision between programs or a program is stopped due to an unexpected situation, you may use the soft reset function.
- It is like rebooting a computer. Any information that is not saved is lost.

## 10 Hard-resetting

Holding  Button for 5 seconds after  
 Button.



- Hard-reset is used when the terminal doesn't respond to soft-reset. Hard-reset initializes the terminal to factory default.
- In case of hard-reset, please be aware that every data gets eliminated except for the datas that are saved in Program store.
- Bluebird Soft assumes no responsibility for loss of data and program. Therefore, you should back up critical data and programs before hardresetting the terminal.

# Using USB Cable



**Start ► Settings ►  
Connections ► USB to PC**

You can use various USB peripherals connected with the terminal by selecting [Use advanced network function].

This menu is enabled as the peripherals are connected with the terminal through USB cables.



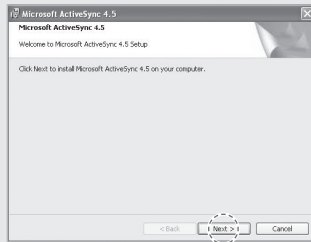
[USB to PC] increases consumption of battery power. You can save battery by deselecting this function when you don't use any peripherals.

## 1 Installing ActiveSync



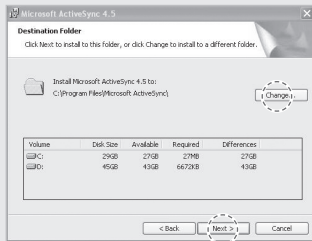
- This is based on Microsoft ActiveSync 4.5 English Version.
- If you use a different version, it may differ from the instructions of the manual.
- You may download the most recent version from the Microsoft website.
- Windows Vista user requires to install the Windows Mobile Device Center not ActiveSync.

- ① Download [Microsoft ActiveSync] from the website of Microsoft, and install the program in the PC.

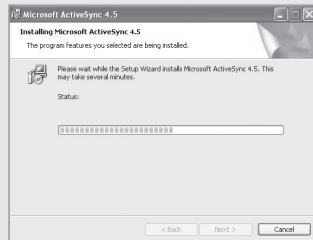


# Connecting ActiveSync

- ② On the [License Agreement] window, select <Agree> ► On the [Customer Information] window, fill in the <User Name> and <Company> field ► On the [Target Folder] window, select the <Installation Location>.



- ③ The [Microsoft ActiveSync] is installed when installation process is ready.



- ④ The [Microsoft ActiveSync] program is installed.

## 2 Using ActiveSync



- The screenshots are for the [Windows Mobile] version. The images may vary depending on the version of the software.
- You must connect the terminal to PC or notebook first to use [Microsoft ActiveSync]. You can copy/paste files, or install/uninstall programs through synchronization with the terminal.
- USB cables are sold separately. Please contact the Customer Care Center if you wish to buy one.

① The terminal with the computer through the <20pin USB cable>.



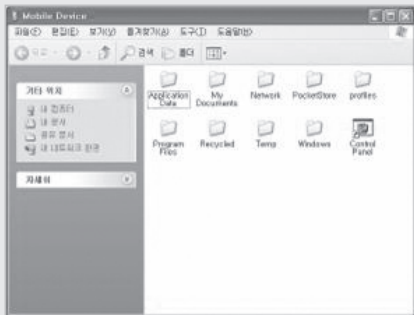
Please do not use both <20pin USB cable> and <Mini USB cable> at the same time. It might cause the failure.

② When the terminal is connected with the computer successfully, the [Microsoft ActiveSync] program is started automatically. Click the [Search] button.



# Connecting ActiveSync

- ③ The <Mobile Devices> folder shows the image, music or document folders in the terminal. You can save the files in the computer.



## [Precautions in using ActiveSync]

- The message “Unknown Device” pops up after the computer detects the USB device

This message may be displayed when you switch on the terminal as it is mounted on the <20pin USB cable>. If you dismount the terminal and then mount it back to the <20pin USB cable>, the ActiveSync program works properly.

- The message “Connecting...” continues

Dismount the terminal from the <20pin USB cable> to disconnect it from the computer.

On [ActiveSync], select File ► Set Connection ► <Allow USB Connection>, and then, click [OK] button. Connect the terminal again.

- If connection attempts continue to fail and the message “Unknown Hardware Device” pos up  
Abnormal status of the USB host in the computer may result in connection fail.



Remove the terminal from the <20pin USB cable>, reboot the computer, and then, return the terminal to the <20pin USB cable>.

- **The terminal does not work when you remove and return the battery**

To prevent this problem, you should press the **[Send]** button or select **[End]** button in the Start menu with the stylus pen so that Windows Mobile (or Windows CE) should "Exits System" before you remove the battery.

If you had to remove the battery due to an unavoidable situation, and the terminal does not work properly, press the **[OK]** button and the **[Reset]** button at the same time for hard-reset.

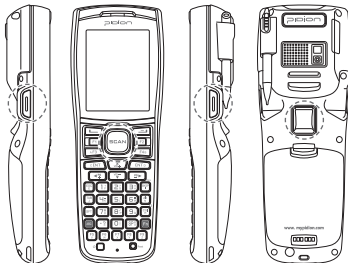
Note that hard-resetting deletes data from the memory. Only the data in the file storage are preserved.

# Using Barcode Reader

## 1 Using Scanner

Press the **[Front Scanner]**, **[Back Scanner]** or **[Side Scanner]** button to start scan a barcode.  
The scanned barcode information is automatically saved in the PDA.

Scanner Button



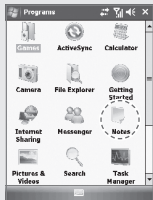
## 2 Scanning Barcode

To scan a barcode, keep a distance of about 10 cm between the barcode and the barcode scanner window and scan the barcode at the correct angle.



To use a barcode in a specific program, contact the manufacturer of the specific program.

### 3 Checking the scanned barcode information



**Start ► Programs ► Notes**

Run **<Memo>** program and select **[New...]** before scanning.

Scanned barcode information is appeared in **[New]** file.

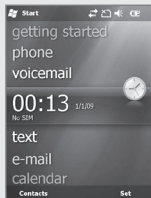
The scanned barcode is automatically saved in **[Memo]**.

The barcode information will not be saved if close **[Memo]** program without saving.

Select **<Menu>** from **<Memo>** program, and select **[Attach]** to save the scanned barcode.

# Today Screen

## 1 Viewing today screen



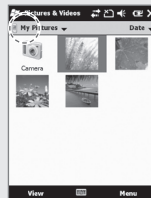
Terminal states such as [Start], [Wi-Fi], [Com Status], [Volume] and [Battery] are indicated on the top of the screen.

Depending on the settings, [Today Screen] may display [Date], [Time], [Wireless Access Setting], [User Info.], [Message], [Work], [Schedule] or [Lock Status].

## 2 Setting photo image as the background image



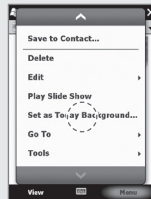
You can set the photo taken by yourself as the background image.

① Select **Start ► Pictures and Videos ► My Pictures**.

② Select the **[Menu]** button in the right bottom of the screen.

③ Select **[Set as Today Background...]**.


④ Select the transparency level of the background image, and select **[OK]** button.



### 3 Adjusting volume

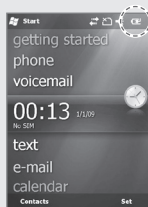



You can adjust volume of the folder/menu selecting tone or the ringer.

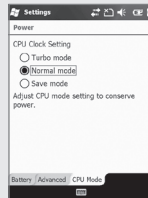
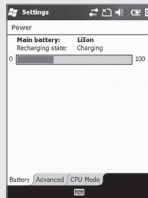
Select  in the top right of the screen, select Setting, and you can adjust system/ringer volume.

If you select Vibration, the terminal is switched into the vibration mode. If you select Release, the terminal is switched into the mute mode.

### 4 Checking battery



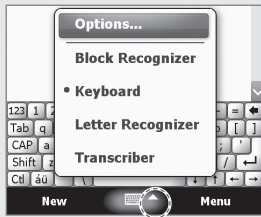
Select  in the top right of the screen, and you can check the battery status.



# Inputting Text

## 1 Selecting text input mode

There are five different character input methods available.



## 2 Block recognizer

This input method uses the traditional writing area box split in the middle.

The left side is used to write letters and the right side is for number entry.

Symbols and common functions are located in other smaller boxes located in the right of the writing box area.



### 3 Keyboard

This input method displays an on-screen keyboard that can be used to input characters by tapping the screen using the stylus pen.

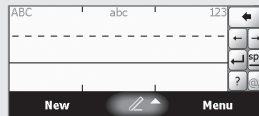


### 4 Letter recognizer

This option allows you to enter text using your own handwriting.

The screen is divided into three different areas. A capital letter area, small letter area, and a number area.

Characters are entered by printing letters in each area. The character is then analyzed and typed on the screen automatically.



# Inputting Text

## 5 Transcriber

The transcriber option is similar to the letter recognizer, except instead of entering characters into a designated area, you can enter entire words and sentences using your own handwriting.

Transcriber supports both printing and cursive writing styles and then automatically types the information on the screen.









## 1 Making a call



Execute the phone program by selecting the **[Phone]** button, enter a telephone number, and press the **[Call]** button to make a call.

### Redialing

If you press the **[Call]** button without entering a phone number, the terminal automatically makes a call to the last call party.

-  : Cancel numbers one by one.
-  : You can make a call with speed dial number. If you select menu in the bottom right of the speed-dial screen, you can add/edit/delete speed-dial numbers. (You can save up to 98 speed-dial numbers.)
-  : You can view the list of received calls/originated calls/missed calls.
-  : Enter a phone number and press this button to make a call.

# Phone Program

## 2 Receiving a call



If the terminal rings and a call receiving message is displayed, click the **[Call]** button or select the **[Answer]** button in the bottom of the screen.

- ※ The calling party information message can be indicated differently from the one of normal phones.

## 3 Rejecting calls



Select the **[Ignore]** button in the bottom of the screen or press the **[End]** button on the keypad to cut off an incoming call.

The reception sound gets blocked when the volume button is pressed for a short time.

## 4 Ending calls



Select the **[End]** button in the bottom of the screen or press the **[End]** button on the keypad to automatically end a call.

# Phonebook

## 1 Searching phonebook



- ① Select the **[Contact]** button in the bottom left of the Today Screen, or select **Start ► Contacts**.

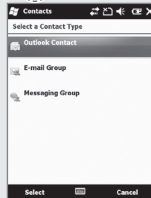


- ② Enter a name in the **[Enter a Name...]** field to search for the phone number.

## 2 Registering entry



- ① Select the **[New]** button in the bottom left of the Phonebook screen.



- ② Select the type of phone number.





If you press and hold the selected phonebook entry, you can use various menus.

**Call Work/Home/Mobile :** A call is made to the registered number.

**Send E-mail :** An e-mail is sent to the registered e-mail address.

**Send Text Message :** An SMS message is sent to the registered number.

**Copy Contact :** You can copy the selected entry.

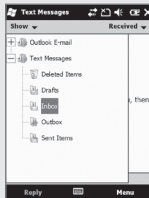
**Delete Contact :** You can delete the selected entry.

## 1 Creating a text message



Start ► Email ► Text Message or on the Today screen, tap Text.

Go to Text Message screen, tap **[Menu]** and select **[New]** or Go to Phone screen, Select a contact name from Call History.  
Select the **[SEND]** button in the bottom left of the Phone screen



Tap Inbox on Text Message screen.  
Inbox shows Deleted Items/ Drafts/Outbox/Sent Items folders.

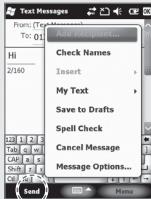

## 2 Sending a text message



**Start ► Email ► Text Message ► Outbox**

After creating Text message including message receiver, tap Send on the Text Messages screen.
