Books and much, much more

Books

French and foreign novels, whodunits, manga and comic books, poetry and theatre plays, and more. Documents on every topic ranging from social and current affairs to science and history and on to cooking, DIYing and further.

And, of course, books for kids including picture books, albums, graded novels and extracurricular books.

DVDs

Films for kids or grown-ups in every category: adventure, romantic comedies, Bollywood, cartoons, documentaries and the classics you must watch (or want to watch again).

CDs

World music, classical or contemporary, rock, jazz, French and international pop, rap and soul: it's all here.

Newspapers and magazines

From dailies to cooking, sports and cinema magazines.

Looking for something specific?

Ask the staff: they are there to help you and give you any advice you need.

Did you know?

The media libraries are committed to bringing you the latest releases – books, DVDs and CDs – as soon as they are available.

Some media libraries also have books in foreign languages, large-print and audio books, language-learning methods and musical scores. **Ask us!**

How to use one of the computers at the media libraries

The media libraries also provide computers for everyone to use free of charge.

For an hour

You can browse the internet and use a full range of office and other software applications in the multimedia areas for an hour a day (provided you book beforehand).

You are also welcome to bring a flash card and print out documents provided you bring your own paper.

Once in a while

Some computers are also there for any quick searches you might want to run.

We want to keep this feature as fair as possible, so please follow the instructions you will see in the area. And please do not alter workstation configurations.

Did you know?

The staff is there to help you. And we organise workshops – using computers for beginners, games or digital creation – on a regular basis so feel free to ask the librarians for details.

Did you know? We look forward to hearing about your suggestions for books that the media library network does not yet have.

How to use the médi@TiC

Sign up

You need to sign up specifically to use this service, with your borrower card (see page 6).

Log in on the media library website www.mediatheques-plainecommune.fr then go to La média@TIC, and click on Se connecter.

Your ID and Password are exactly the same as the ones on your user account (see page 7).

After logging in, you can access all the available documents, manage your personal space, and share your opinion on any given resource.







What's up at the media libraries?

The cultural programme

You are welcome to come along to a choice of film screenings, workshops, live shows, and to talk about books you have read, free of charge, all year long. You can also enjoy the fun playtimes for the young and young at heart, including video games, reading with families, Histoires Communes festival stories, and more.

Anything else?

The media libraries are providing more and more practical services such as beginner to advanced computer workshops, French language conversation workshops, public writer services, and discussions revolving around parenthood. Ask about the ones at your nearest media library.

You can also work at media libraries. Some of them set aside dedicated areas for students during exam periods.

Did you know?

You will find a choice of highlights throughout the year, centred on a constantly updated range of topics. The features include exhibitions, original creations and unexpected artistic expressions.

Did you know?

Professionals working in child-care, educational, health-related, social, job-integration and cultural jobs are welcome to come along and talk about their projects at the media libraries.



Did you know?

Media libraries and book buses may change their opening hours during school holidays, or be closed for renovation work. So think about checking the website for updates!



Signing up and taking out

How can i get my borrower card?

Borrower cards are free of charge and allow you to borrow documents from the 25 media libraries and 3 book buses in the network, and provide access to Médi@TIC (see page 4).

We will issue a card when you bring us your ID and a recent letter providing your name and address. If you are under 18, you will need your parents' authorisation (there is a form to fill out in media libraries or on the website) instead of your ID.

If you lose your card, let the media library staff know as soon as possible.

How many documents can i borrow and for how long?

Your card allows you to borrow up to 30 documents including 5 DVDs for up to 4 weeks.

You can return the documents you borrow to any media library or book bus in the network, regardless of where you borrowed them or signed up.

Why do i need an account?

When you sign up for a borrower card, you are automatically given a user account.

Did you know?

You don't need to live in Plaine Commune to sign up... But, if you change your address, please let us know as soon as you can. Memberships are renewed each year, and a librarian will check that your details are still up to date each time.

Did you know?

If you find that a document is damaged, please let the media library staff know, so they can repair it. You will be asked to replace any document that is damaged beyond repair or lost. You will not be able to reimburse documents (librarians are not allowed to handle cash).

Logging in

Go to the media library website *www.mediatheques-plainecommune.fr* and click on *Mon compte*. Your ID is the number you will find on the back of your card.

Your password is made up of the last 2 digits of the year you were born followed by the first 3 digits of your surname (e.g. 60SMI for a Jane Smith born in 1960).

Reserving documents

You can reserve up to 4 documents (including 1 DVD) and have them delivered to the media library or book bus of your choice. When the document is ready at the pick-up point you selected, we will let you know by post or by phone that you can come and collect it within the coming 2 weeks.

Checking the documents you have borrowed

Before coming to the media libraries or book buses, you can use your account to list the documents that you are due to return.

Extending loans

Don't wait until your loans are overdue! You can use your account to extend your loans by an additional 4 weeks. If another user has reserved the documents, you will receive a message asking you to return the documents as soon as possible.

You can also talk to the staff at the media libraries of you want to reserve documents or keep them for longer.



Did you know?

If any documents are overdue, you will not be allowed to extend loans or borrow other documents. You will be able to borrow other documents once again when you return the overdue documents.
