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Chapter 1 Operation Instructions

1.1 Open & Close the Unit

The cover of the unit is designed loose-leaf, it is convenient and easy to open or close the unit.

1.2 About Power Supply

This unit is powered by two 3A batteries. If the unit doesn't work properly, which indicates battery voltage is weak, please turn off the unit and replace the batteries with new ones.

Procedures of replacing batteries:

- 1. Turn off the unit.
- 2. Push the battery compartment lock, which is on the back of the unit, to the position of "Unlock", open the battery compartment door and replace the used batteries with new ones.

Note: Please use alkaline batteries.

3. Cover the battery compartment door and push the lock to the position of "Lock", otherwise, the unit can not be switched on.

Cautions:

- 1. Follow the right procedures and make sure that the polarities of the batteries are correct.
- 2. Never leave used batteries in the battery compartment.
- 3. indicates the battery voltage is enough. in indicates the battery voltage is weak, in this case, please replace the batteries with new ones following the information on screen.
- 4. To avoid data loss, please always keep alkaline battery in the unit for sufficient power supply.

Note: When the adapter is in use, there will be no flag indicating the battery voltage.

Using AC adapter:

- 1. Press to turn off the unit before plugging the AC adapter.
- 2. After using, press ower to turn off the unit before unplugging the AC adapter. If the unit hangs because of improper use, simply take out the batteries and replace them again (Please use RESET if necessary).
- 3. Specifications of the AC adapter:

4. You are highly recommended to use the AC adapter provided by our agency or other qualified brands. We assume no responsibility for any damage to the unit arising through the use of AC adapters which do not meet the specification mentioned above.

5. To keep the real-time clock in the unit working properly in case of a sudden power cut, please always keep good alkaline battery in the unit even if you are using an AC adapter.


Data recovery

- 1. The unit is able to recover the data of loss caused by sudden power cut while preparing to save. Don't cut power, reset the unit or open the battery compartment in the process of making data recovery, otherwise, all the data will be lost permanently.
- 2. We strongly suggest the use of alkaline battery with sufficient power supply to prevent from sudden power cut which may result in data loss. Please make sure that there is steady electrical current, 6 volt power pressure and proper plugging while using adapter.

Resetting the Unit

Press free after replacing batteries or press because of malfunction of the unit, a message "Please wait..." appears on the screen, then shows "Time and other setting may be changed, please reset if necessary", meanwhile the system checks itself automatically, and then goes to main menu.


Special Function Keys

The followings are special function keys. You should press (SMFT) first and then press special function key instead of pressing them simultaneously to perform corresponding function.

- 1. Switch display mode between Chinese and English
- 3. SMIFT (有數) Store records in Dict. / mark or unmark the records in Organizer
- 4. Inquire time (Remark: the function is unavailable in input mode or a pop-up window appears)
- 5. (SHIFT) (NEW) Edit record
- 6. (SHIFT) (與行文) Set alarm in Schedule
- 7. SHIFT Delete record
- 8. Switch mode between inserting and overwriting

1.4 Touch Pad Instruction

Besides key entry function, the Touch Pad is specially designed. The operation is specified below.

- Main features of Touch Pad: Handwrite and Touch.
 In input / edit mode, touch to switch between Touch and Handwrite.
- Handwrite mode: in input mode, directly write on Touch Pad to input or edit data. (shows on the upper right corner indicates the mode of handwrite; otherwise it indicates the mode of touch.)



- 1. Write on Touch Pad, your handwriting will be displayed on LCD.
- 2. After system makes recognition on your handwriting, relative letters / characters will be displayed on the bottom of LCD, press numeric key to choose desired one directly.
- 3. If no desired letter / character is found in the short list, press or click twice to cancel, then write on the Touch Pad to input again.
- Touch mode: you can tap up /down / left / right arrow on Touch Pad to complete relative operations same as pressing up /down / left / right key.
- 1. In menu screen, tap up / down / left / right arrow to move the highlight bar. Hold on the key, the highlight bar moves circularly.
- 2. In input screen of Organizer, tap up / down / left / right arrow to move the cursor. When you tap the down arrow, the cursor moves to the next field.
- 3. In index screen of Organizer and menu screen of Reference, tap up / down arrow to move the highlight bar; press (or to enter view screen or submenu screen.
- 4. In input screen of Dictionary, tap up / down arrow to move the highlight bar; hold on the key, the highlight bar moves circularly. Tap 🕶 or to enter explanation screen.
- 5. In explanation screen of Dictionary, tap up / down / left / right arrow on the Touch Pad to highlight a word or character for cross-search.
- 6. In view screen of Organizer, Dictionary, Currency Exchange and Reference, tap up / down arrow to view the content if there is more than one page. Hold on the key to turn page up or down automatically.

1.5 Input Methods

11 input methods are available in the unit, they are English & Number, Symbol, Cangjie, Simple, Radical, Mandarin, Taiwan, Cantonese, Wang Ma 5-strokes, 5-strokes and Strokes. Cangjie and Simple only exist in traditional Chinese mode, Wang Ma 5- stokes only exist in simplified Chinese

mode.



Input English word, e.g. input "close", press (CAPS) to switch between uppercase & lowercase.




In Chinese input mode, press (NAXX) to select a desired input method, meanwhile, the icon which represents the selected input method shows on lower left corner. e.g. Press numeric key to choose directly.

Note: You must switch to Chinese input mode, then press ্ষ্পার্ট (জ্ঞার) to select a Chinese input method.





—**Simple** (Only exits in traditional Chinese mode)
Input the first and last of Cangjie codes of a character, e.g. input "手一", and then press the corresponding numeric key to choose the desired one from the short list on the bottom of LCD.



-Radical

After choosing the desired radical by pressing numeric key, input the number of remaining strokes. e.g. choose the radical of the character "行", and input remaining stroke






number "4", then press (4"). All relative characters are displayed, press numeric key to choose the desired character;

-Mandarin


Input Mandarin phonetic alphabets, e.g. input "GUANG", and then input tone, e.g. input "V". Press numeric key to select the desired character.



Note: press \bullet for the first tone; press \bullet for the second tone; press \bullet for the third tone; press \bullet for the fourth tone; press \bullet for the soft tone; press \bullet to input " \bullet ".

—Taiwan

Input characters by inputting Taiwanese Pinyin. e.g. input " $\overline{\mathcal{F}} \mathcal{F}$ ", then input the tone (same as Mandarin), e.g. press $\underbrace{ \mathbf{F} \mathcal{F}}$ is to input the first tone, and relative characters are displayed on the bottom of LCD, then press the numeric key to choose the desired one.



-Cantonese


Input Cantonese phonetic alphabets, e.g. input "YIN", relative characters are displayed on the bottom of LCD, press the numeric key to choose the desired one.



—Wang Ma 5-strokes (only exists in simplified Chinese mode)

Usually, to find a character, input the codes of first three roots and the last root. If the character has less than 4 roots, just input the codes of its roots plus a recognition code to make it 4 codes. If this still cannot make 4 codes, use SPACE key to make the balance.

e.g. input "sgct", the corresponding character "酸" is shown.







After inputting, press e.g. input "12345", the relative characters are displayed on the bottom of LCD, press numeric key to choose the desired one.



-Strokes

Input the number of the total strokes, then press e.g. input "4", and press from the relative characters are displayed on the bottom of LCD, press numeric key to choose the desired one.



1.6 Automatic Power-off

- —The unit will be automatically switched off if it is left idle within the automatic power-off period.

 Press () button to restart it. (the default automatic power-off period is 3 minutes)
- —If the unit is automatically powered off, the data you have inputted or edited will not be saved.
- —The alarm will still function upon the set time even if the unit is power off.

1.7 Categories of Content

4 main Categories such as Dictionary, Organizer, Calculation and Others are particularly designed for your convenient operation. Besides this, the hot menu for which you can select desired applications in System Setting is added.

Hot menu:

- —Press to select an item, or tap up / down / left / right arrow on Touch Pad to move the cursor to the desired item, then press to enter the application.
- —Press to switch into main menu of the previous or next category.

Main menu

- —Press to select an item, or tap up / down / left / right arrow on Touch Pad to move the cursor to the desired item, then press to enter the application. You can also press numeric key to enter corresponding application directly.
- —Press (*) to switch into main menu of the previous or next category.
- —Press ☐ to toggle among the categories circularly.
- —Press (中) to switch display language between Chinese and English.
- —Press (現出) to return to hot menu.

1.8 Cautions

- —Avoid humidity. Never let water or other liquids flow into the unit.
- —Don't place the unit under direct sunlight or near heat.

- —Don't repair the unit by yourself! Bring the malfunctioned unit to our Customer Service Center for repair.

This unit provides various English/Chinese Dictionaries for your usage, and the total number of vocabularies amounts to 280,000.


2.1 Oxford Dictionary

You can find an English word or phrase by using either of inputting method or browsing method. It is available in this dictionary to view the phonetic alphabet and Chinese explanation; view the relative or general grammars; cross-search to Chi-Eng Dictionary or Chi-Chi Dictionary; listen to pronunciations of Chinese/English words in Mandarin, Cantonese or English.

2.1.1 General Search

Choose "Oxford" in the Dictionary menu, then input the desired word/phrase by pressing keys or handwriting, then press to confirm, e.g. input "close".

Press (*) to browse word/phrase orderly, press (*) to browse word/phrase page by page.





2.1.2 Spell-check & Nearest Word

These two functions are usually used when the inputted word/phrase is wrongly spelled or unavailable in Oxford Dictionary.

Input "clowe" (misspelled word), then press (** arres) to confirm.

Press numeric key or press (*) and (*) and (*) to choose "Nearest Word" or "Spell-Alternative".


If you choose "Nearest Word", you can view the explanation of the nearest word.

If you choose "Spell-Alternative", it will list the corrected words (or show "Not Found!" alert on screen, if no results).

Press (A) (T) to highlight the desired words (or show "Not Found!")

Press to highlight the desired word in the list, then press to view the explanation.

Note: The searching time may be longer, you can stop searching by pressing (SRE).

2.1.3 Wildcard search

If you are not sure about the spelling of the desired word/phrase, you can use wildcard "?" or "*" to confirm. ("?" represents one uncertain letter, "*" represents one or more uncertain letters.)

Input "appl?", then press 🕶 to confirm.

The first word matched will be shown on screen.

Press (*) to view the previous/ next

matched word.





2.1.4 Grammar Inquiry

While viewing some English word, you can inquire the Oxford Built-in Grammar, Instant-Dict Grammar, or Oxford Paradigm. The Oxford Built-in Grammar includes phrase, compound word, derivative, others and example; the Instant-Dict Grammar includes grammar, homonym, example, run-ons, synonym, antonym, confuse word in meaning, adjective.

Note: The indicators that appearing on the upper right corner indicate available grammars.

In the view screen of some word, press numeric key to inquire relevant grammar according to the indicators.

e.g. in the view screen of "close",

press (2π) for Phrase; press $(3\sqrt{})$ for Compound





2.2 Chinese-English Dictionary

You can search the desired Chinese character/phrase through inputting or browsing method. You can input Chinese character by handwriting method or Chinese input methods, including Cangjie, Simple, Radicals, Mandarin/Cantonese, Taiwan, Wangma, 5-Stroke and Strokes.

2.2.1 General Search

Choose "Chi-Eng Dict." in the Dictionary menu. Input the desired character/phrase, then press (**) to confirm, e.g. input "才".

Press (to browse word/phrase orderly, press (to browse page by page.

When "[國語]" appears on the upper left corner, press 12 to enter Chi-Chi Dictionary to view its explanation, press (REE) to return to Chi-Eng Dictionary.



2.2.2 Nearest Word


