

The system can be accessed through our college website with address: http:// <a href="http://www.hct.edu.om/student-portal/">http://www.hct.edu.om/student-portal/</a>



#### 4.2.1. Appeal Against Exams Results



**Decided**: The submitted appeal form processed and decision has been made.






Upon click the Submit Appeal button, your online will be submitted and the system gives you confirmation of the same.
