







The situation of assign and setting will be displayed in the list, the four pages and 1~16 items in every page are corresponded to which of the main interface.

**Search**: Click this icon; it will display all of the NVS and corresponding information on the network.

Add: Click this icon, adding NVS belongs to list2 to list1, select certain line belongs to list1 automatically", it will add all the selected channels belong to list2 to list1, otherwise one interface of "Window Configuration" appears as follows: in list2 indicates add all channels of the NVS, indicates only add some channels of the NVS, indicates add no channel.


Sequencing: There are three sequencable modes according to "NVS Name", "Channel Number", "IP" in list2, click list head to raise preface or descending order arrange. For example: According to "NVS Name", click the list head of "NVS Name", move at following function: "Up", "Down", "Delete", "Setup" aim at the channel selected in list1. Up and Down can change by channel related window symbol NVS.

**Up:** Decrease the number of NVS Channel Window, can't operate this function when the channel of NVS selected is linked to next channel

**Down:** Increase the number of NVS Channel Window, can't operate this function when The channel of NVS selected is linked to next channel

**Delete:** Can't operate this function when the channel of NVS selected is in the state of Connection or Login.

**Set:** Pitch on the window you want to set, double-click or click "Set" icon, figure about setting window appears as follows:



Camera Description: Display information of the camera in the status bar , This content is optional .

Server's Name: The name of the Video Server connected, it is an unique identifier in the same domain, which as to be identify mark when make a DDNS service or transmit connection .Avoid repetition while setting up, for different channel window in one NVS, Server's Name, Login User's name, Password ought to be the same entirely.

**Server's Address:** NVS's IP address or domain.

Communication Port: Default Value is 5000

**Channel:** Which channel is connected to current window, channel number begins from 1,

Four- channel NVS from 1~4.

Communication Mode: Network communication protocol: TCP,UDP or Multicast.

User's name Password: User's name and Password when Login.

NOTE: 1) Different window, login one NVS, user's name and password ought to be the same entirely

2) Those video have been opened or channel that logged in can not modify these information.

**Decoding Way:** Whether current video adopt hardware DSP decoding output TV Wall, this option can't


be set, record it when operate on the main interface.

**Decorder Protocol:** Adopt transparent protocol, put it in the PC end. Use different Decoder protocol according to different requirement because there are quantities of decoder protocol in the market at present, it is very easy to add new increased decoder protocol when adopt this manner.

In this figure, select decoder protocol's name, decoder address, RS232 or RS485 communication port, communication baud rate and so on corresponded with current window.

#### 4.5.1 Common Set



Interface of common set as above:

- 1 Set record and disk which used to save images
- 2. Set User's name and password, the first is administrator, others are operators, the Administrator has all of the authorities, others can not set NVS.


Note: The administrator can add and delete users, change operator's authority, but can't change the operator's user name; password. The operator can only revise his own user name, password.

- **3. (**Record File Pack Time**)**: Set up the video length of each video file store;
- **4. Start Pre- Record** : Set on/off prerecord alarm and time in length pre-record.
- 5. **Start Alarm Record** On/Off alarm linkage record and time in length.
- 6. 【 Start Local Audio Alarm】: Set On/Off audio alarm and time in length, when it alarms, output alarm voice via PC Audio Card.
- 7. 【Auto-delete past files when disk is full】: Set when the record disk is full, whether auto-delete the past files or stop record and gives a prompt of disk is full.
- 8. 【Start Auto-connection】: Set whether auto-connection & Times of auto-connection when the images connected interrupted abruptly.
- 9. 【Display E-map when alarm】: Set whether open the E-map when alarm.
- 10. 【High-quality Image Display】: On/Off
- 11. [Decoding Card output Standard]: PAL or NTSC
- 12. [Break Alarm]: Gives an alarm when connect to NVS failed.

















Clear All: Delete all information in the list.






the biggest, grade 10 is worst but its bit rate is smallest.),set the mask area(the image is divided into 22\*18 blocks, double-click the block that you want to mask, you can set or cancel image mask of the current block),adjust image parameter(lightness, chroma, contrast, saturation)

NOTE: While adopting CBR, bit rate and quantization coefficient should be regulated at the same time, if bitrate is very low, coefficient should be strengthened correspondingly in quantization. For instance: (25 frames) when bit rate is set as under 384K, coefficient can be set as 7 or 8 in quantization. When the network is lower in bandwidth, for improve, transmit frame rate can with appropriate to reduce code frame rate, increase coefficient of quantizing, reduce I frame interval.

How to set Video Parameter is clear at a glance. So we will not give you more unnecessary details







We call it built-in protocol when PTZ be downloaded to NVS. Set correct RS485 serial port baud-rate, data bit etc when adopt built-in protocols.


You must set RS232 serial port baud-rate; data bit correctly when adopt RS232 data acquisition function.

## Appendix II FAQ



## A Can't visit NVS via Digital Surveillance Central Management Software?

Possible Reason: Network is not through.

Solution: Connect your PC to network ,checking whether it works normally or not. Excluding faulty of cable first, faulty network caused by computer virus until it is expedite with the command of Ping.

Possible Reason: IP Address has been occupied by other devices

Solution: Stop the connection between NVS and Network, hook up NVS to the PC separately, and reinstall IP Address according to the proper operations recommended.

Possible Reason: IP Address is in the different subnet.

Solution: Check IP address, subnet masking address of the NVS and the setup of Gateway.

Possible Reason: Web port has been modified?

Solution: Contact Netware Administrator to obtain correlatived information.

Possible Reason: Unknown

Solution: Press RESET to retrieve default settings then connect it again, the default IP Address is 192.168.55.160, and Subnet Mask is 255.255.255.0



## The color of image is abnormal (Green or other kinds of color)?

It can not display normally sometimes for the difference between Graphics Cards, you can see the image presents green or other colors, then you should run the programmer Config.exe that decompressed, and set displaying buffer space ,auto-detection, use fixable Display Card Memory or System Memory. Then restart programme.



## PTZ, Lens out of control

Possible Reason: Signal cable connection is not proper or not correct.

Solution: Redo the step connected to server.

Possible Reason: Installation of relative decoder protocol, address or baud rate is not correct.

Solution: Check the installation is right or wrong carefully.

## There is no sound while monitoring?

Possible Reason: No audio input connection

Solution: Check the audio connection

Possible Reason: Without opening the audio option

Solution: Check audio parameter installation to see if you have opened the audio.



## Audio effect is not very good?

Possible Reason: If there are much cacophony and sound distortion is very serious, please check whether the input signal is lined input or not. Most time when the input signal is not lined (such as microphone with amplifier) cause saturation distortion because the PWL not matched.



#### Normal Data can not through the Switch?

#### Possible Reason:

- 1. If it is double-layer switch, the address has been wrongly written.
- If it is three-layer switch, whether binding port and MAC, Address.
- Whether install firewall regulations without considering Server

Ensure connect to others with the command of Ping in the command lines mode before looking for fault -network. Examining the information responded is very important. If it is obstructed, it proves that there must be some troubles in this network. If bind the IP address and MAC definitely, then need to carry on such setup within the Switch: Add a new binding regulation (Bind IP Address of the NVS and MAC definitely). Please consult the port number used by the NVS and reconfig Switch if having not considered the Server while disposing the rule of the File Wall.
