Hello everyone! Today I am going to introduce a special and recently-invented product, wiper helmet. A wiper helmet is a helmet equipped with a wiper. A wiper is a long and thin device that is originally fitted on a car to remove rain and dirt from the windshield in order to improve the visibility and enhance safety while driving. And recently, this device is applied to the new kind of helmet, called wiper helmet, invented by a Taiwanese. The wiper helmet has an additional visor. The wiper and the small motor are fixed under the visor. And there is also a remote controller that can be fixed on the handlebar of the motorcycle.

When pressing the bottom on the remote controller, the wiper will start moving back and forth on the face guard of the helmet. Keeping the face guard of the helmet is important for safety of riding. When I was riding on ^{a lot} rainy day, the face guard on my helmet was always covered with raindrops. As I tried to wipe ^{the way} away the ^{off} water on the face guard, it didn't work and even ^{rain} got worse because the ^{a quite} small raindrops were mixed by my hand and become a ^{spread} shoal of water, which ^{with what? and blocked my view} made it more difficult to see things clearly. To a motorcycle rider, it is quite dangerous that the sight is dim. But with a wiper on the helmet, the face guard can easily be cleaned just by pressing the bottom on the remote controller, and the rain is wiped away immediately. This smart invention effectively keeps the motorcycle rider's sight much clearer on rainy days than the common helmet. The wiper helmet is a product combined with originality, technology and security. And this kind of helmet is already on the market in other countries like Japan, England, France and Australia, etc.
