
2. To charge the battery, please connect this player to ACmains via theAC adapter and the charge indicator will turnon in red, and the indicator will turninto green when the battery is fully charged. This will take about 2-2.5 hours if the player is inoff mode or 4.5-6 hours if the player is in working mode.

<u>Using and maintaining yourrechargeable batteries</u>

1. Please make sureyou always use only the AC adapterincluded with the player to recharge your batteries.

2. Recharge efficiency will degrade when the environmental temperature drops below 50 F (10 $^{\circ}$ C) or exceed 95F (35 $^{\circ}$ C).

Phone Jack Function

Insert the earphone into the earphone jack, to listen the music or movie privately.

Battery charging

When the unit battery is powered out, connect the AC adapter onto the unit. the battery will charge automatically.

Use VOLUME CONTROLLin the side of the unit to adjust the volume.



3 In 1 Card Reader Function

This unit have a3 in1 card jack. You can insert (MMC, SD, MS) three kinds of cardwith card port interface. Press the <SOURCE> button to choose CARD mode to play the MP3 music or MPEG4 movie and JPEG files. All the function is the same to play adisc.
