The Country Flame Fireplace Furnace is a full masonry unit, to be installed according to Chapter 37 of the Uniform Building Code.



This cutaway drawing shows the Country Flame Fireplace Furnace's inside heat exchanger area. This advanced design transfers fireplace heat to moving air masses; two 525 CFM blowers move this warmed air gently through the duct system into the home. While BTU outputs of up to 175,000 per hour are easily generated, the design of the Fireplace Furnace allows it to provide adequate heat levels from a bed of coals or smaller-size fires.
