iPod & iPhone FM Transmitter with Hands-free Bluetooth Technology: Installation Guide & User Manual

Features:

- Power and charge your iPod, IPhone, IPhone3G & Ipad simultaneously through the 30-pin dock connector.
- Support Call Receiving, Call Rejecting And Last Number Re-Dialing
- Digital FM tuner with LED display.
- Full frequency, from 87.5~108.0MHz, 0.1Mhz gap between channels
- Support Line-in; automatically play the music from external audio devices. (Mp3; CD player etc.)
- Last frequency and song memory function.
- Charge your mobile phone, MP3 player and so on through the USB port.
- Flexible goose neck, easily reposit, convenient and safe
- Removable stoppers to keep the device in holder steadily.
- High quality silicon gel on the back & sides to protect your device from being damaged.

Installation:

- 1. Set up the car mount suction cup on the windshield or any other smooth surface in the car. Just hold it in the position you want and lock it.
- 2. Connect the car charger and the unit through the mini USB socket.
- 3. Place your iPod/iPhone/iPad into the holder; adjust the flexible clamp by pressing the crandle lock release button.
- 4. Turn on your car radio and turn to a bare FM channel. Then press the CH+/CH- buttons beside the display to set the frequency of the fm transmitter the same as that of the radio. Then it will automatically play the music from your devices.

Note: USB charger slot can charge your mobile phone and other digital players only when no iPod/iPhone/iPad is connected to the device.

Set up Bluetooth:

- 1. Make sure your phone has Bluetooth turned on and is in discovery mode. (On iPhone, this can be found under Settings > General > Bluetooth.)
- 2. Press and hold the green **phone button** on your PLPADFM2B.
- 3. Your PLPADFM2B will appear in the list of available Bluetooth devices as "B-368BT".*
- 4. Pair your phone with the Bluetooth device. Your phone's name will appear on your PLPADFM2B.
- 5. You can now make phone calls using your car's stereo system as a speaker. Enjoy!
