Merlin Control Panel User's Manual

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Welcome To A New Dimension In Spa Control Systems.

Quick Start Guide - You can use your Merlin Smart Control & Video Display three ways: (1) One Button Touch in Spa Shortcut

Mode to turn a function On, like a Pump or Light without any navigation or additional steps. (2) Spa Navigation Mode where you utilize the full opportunities on the Full Color Screen. (3) One Button Touch in Entertainment Shortcut Mode to directly turn On and Control Entertainment functions, like Play or Pause for an iPod or DVD Player. The Mode Button quickly Changes from Spa Shortcut Mode, to Spa Navigation Mode, and to Entertainment Mode. All of the Numbered Buttons are Multifunction Buttons, which perform different Functions depending on the Mode. This Section is a Quick Start Guide to get you started in Navigating the Merlin Control Panel Menu System. For the Best Button Response when Touching a Button, use the Tip of your Finger or Thumb in the Center of the Button, rather than flattening out your thumb or finger on the Button.

Spa Shortcut Mode System Control

The Key to the **Button Functions** is on Screen.





These are the **Spa Shortcut Mode** Active Buttons.

In **Spa Shortcut Mode**, all of the buttons Except the **Select** Button and the **Back** Button can be used to Directly Control the Spa System equipment and other functions. A Yellow Icon on the Screen indicates that the Function is On. The **Back** Button is not used in the **Spa Shortcut Mode**.

The **Pump 1** Button is the Jet **Pump 1** Control Button.

The **Light** Button is the Spa **Light** Control Button.

The **Temp** Button is the Water **Temp**erature Control Button.

The **Invert** Button is the **Invert** Display Screen Button.

The ②, ③, ④, ⑤, ⑥, ⑦, ⑧, and ⑨ Buttons are the Spa Option Control Shortcut Buttons as defined on the Screen, which may be the Air **Blower**, Jet **Pump 2**, Jet **Pump 3**, another **Light**, or other Option.

The Select Button is used to Change from Spa Shortcut Mode to Spa Navigation Mode. The Mode Button Changes from Spa Shortcut Mode to Spa Navigation Mode, and then to Entertainment Shortcut Mode.

Spa Navigation Mode System Control

The **Foot** * Icon on the Home Screen is Highlighted.





These are the **Spa Navigation Mode** Active Navigation
Buttons.

In the **Spa Navigation Mode**, all of the **Main Functions** at the Top of the Screen can be Scrolled either Up or Down to access all of the Main Functions, rotating like a Wheel. In the Center of the Screen, all of the **Icon Functions** can be Scrolled either Left or Right to access all of the Icon Functions, rotating like a Wheel. All of the Buttons Except the Option **2**, **3**, **4**, **5**, **6**, **7**, **8**, and **9** Buttons can be used to **Navigate** and **Select** from the Menu System.

The **Up** Button Scrolls **Up** from **Intertainment** at the Top of the Screen.

The **Down** Button Scrolls **Down** from **Intertal Imment** at the Top of the Screen.

The **Left** Button Moves **Left** to the next **Icon Function** Left.

The **Right** Button Moves **Right** to the next **Icon Function** Right.

The **Select** Button is used to **Select** a Menu Item, or turn an item On or Off.

The Back Button is used to go back one level in the Menu System. From the Spa Navigation Mode Screen, the Back Button is also used to immediately Change to Spa Shortcut Mode. The Mode Button Changes from Spa Navigation Mode, to Entertainment Mode, and then to Spa Shortcut Mode.

The **2**, **3**, **4**, **5**, **6**, **7**, **8**, and **9** Buttons continue to operate as the Spa Option Control Shortcut Buttons in the **Spa Navigation Mode**.

When Navigating the Menus, if the Yellow Highlighted Menu Bar you are on has an Arrow at the Right End of the Menu Bar, use the **Right** Button to Navigate to the Next Menu, and use the **Back** Button to Return to the Previous Menu.



Use the **Up** Button to Scroll Up to the next Menu Bar Above, or use the **Down** Button to Scroll Down to the next Menu Bar Below.

If the Blue Area at the Bottom of the Menu says **More** and has Arrows pointing Down and/or Up, as indicated, use the **Down** Button to Scroll from the Bottom Menu Bar to the



Next Menu, or the **Up** Button to Scroll from the Top Menu Bar to the Previous Menu.

Entertainment Shortcut Mode - iPod*, iPhone*, USB Device & MP3 Player

The Key to the **Button Functions** is on the Side Menus.





These are the iPod
Entertainment
Shortcut
Mode Active
Buttons.

When the **Entertainment Side Menus** with the iPod Control Shortcut Button Functions are displayed on screen, the System is in **iPod Entertainment Shortcut Mode**, and All of the buttons Except the **Select** Button and the **Back** Button can be used to Directly Control the iPod Entertainment equipment.

The **Left** Button is the Move **Left** Navigation Button.

The **Right** Button is the Move **Right** Navigation Button.

The **Down** Button is the Scroll **Down** Navigation Button.

The **Up** Button is the Scroll **Up** Navigation Button.

When the **Side Menus** are turned On, the Numbered Buttons are the Entertainment Control Shortcut Buttons as defined on the Side Menus.

On Side Menu Page 1: 2 Power, 3 Page 2, 4 Volume Up, 5 Play, 6 Pause, 7 Volume Down, 8 Mute, 9 Stop.

A **Volume Level Indicator** at the Bottom of the **Right Menu Bar** will Display the Volume Level. Full Volume is shown to the Right.

The **Select** Button is used to **Select** a Menu Item.

The Mode Button Changes from iPod Entertainment Shortcut Mode to Spa Shortcut Mode, and then to Spa Navigation Mode.

The **Back** Button turns the **Side Menus** On and Off.

In the **Entertainment Mode**, when the **Side Menus** are turned Off, all of the Buttons except the **Back** Button are in **Spa Shortcut Mode** and control the Spa Functions. The **Side Menus** will automatically turn Off in 30 seconds if a Button is not touched.

Setting Up Your Spa Control System

This Section of the **Merlin Control Panel User's Manual** provides more Detailed Instructions for properly Setting Up and Configuring your Spa Control System. All of the initial Spa Control System Options and Settings, like Time and Date, Filter Cycles, Heating Mode, and Language, are located in the **Settings** Menu. In case of Power Failure, all of your Options and Settings will be remembered by the Control System.










In **Spa Navigation Mode**, with the Default **Intertal Impart** Highlighted, Move **Down (b)** to **Settings**, and Touch the **Select (c)** Button to open a **Settings** Menu.

Set the Heating Mode - The Heating Mode determines when the Heater will heat and how the Water Temperature will be maintained. There's a Description of the Heating Mode in each Heating Mode Menu.











In the Settings Menu with Heating Mode Highlighted, Touch Select to open the Heating Mode Menu. The Default Heating Mode is the Standard Mode. To change Heating Modes, from the Heating Mode Menu Bar, Move Down and Right to the Heating Mode Set Menu.









To change to this Heating Mode, Touch Select , or to Exit back, Touch Back .

Set the Filter Cycles - The Filter Cycles determine when the Filter Pump will turn On to Filter the Water. The Default is two 2 hour Filter Cycles every day of the week, 12 hours apart. You can Set up to four Filter Cycles on any days of the week, and with any Start Time and End Time you want.

The Filter Cycle Days and Time also determine when the Heating will take place in the **Economy** and **Vacation** Heating Modes. In these Modes, the Heater will only operate during the Filter Cycle Filtration times, and will not operate between Filter Cycles.









In the Sattings Menu with Heating Mode Highlighted, Move Left (2) to Filter Cycles and Touch Select (2) to open the Set Filter Cycles Menu.









By Default, Filter Cycle 1 is On and Preset. To Change the Days and Time for Filter Cycle 1 or to Set or Modify other Filter Cycles, scroll to the Filter Cycle, then Move Right to the Filter Cycles Set Menu. To turn On (Enable) or turn Off (Disable) a Filter Cycle, with Filter Cycle 1 Highlighted, Touch Select . If the Filter Cycle is Set to Off, the System ignores the Days and Times Set, and the Filter Cycle is Disabled.










To Set the Days for the Filter Timer to Operate, from the **Days To Filter** Menu Bar, Move **Right** to the **Days To Filter** Menu. By Default, all days are turned On. To turn a day Off or On, Move **Left** or **Right** to that day and Touch **Select** . Touch **Back** to the previous Menu.

Filter Cycles (Continued)









To Set the Filter Timer Start Time, from the **Start Time** Menu Bar, Move **Right** to the **Start Time** Menu. To change the Filter Timer Start Time, Move **Left** or **Right** to Hours or Minutes, and then Touch **Up** or **Down** to change the Time. Touch **Back** to Exit back to the previous Menu.









To Set the Filter Timer **End Time**, from the **End** Menu Bar, Move **Right** to the **End Time** Menu. To change the Filter Timer **End Time**, Move **Left** or **Right** to Hours or Minutes, and then Touch **Up** or **Down** to change the Time. Touch **Back** to Exit back to the previous Menu.

Set Over Temperature - If you want a temporary Water Set Temperature higher than 104°F (40.0°C), you Must Set it in the **Over Temp** Menu. Underwriters Laboratory requires this type of Control because the Consumer Product Safety Commission has determined that soaking in Water Temperatures above 104°F (40.0°C) can sometimes be Dangerous.










To Increase the Water Set Temperature to 105°F (40.5°C) or 106°F (41.0°C), From the Settings Menu with Heating Mode Highlighted, Move Right to Over Temp and Touch Select to open the Over Temp Menu.

Over Temp (Continued)









You must confirm your intention to temporarily Set a Water Temperature higher than 104°F (40.0°C). Touch **Select** to continue to the **Over Temp** Menu to raise the Water Temperature above 104°F (40.0°C). Scroll to the desired Water Set Temperature and Touch **Select** to Set that Water Temperature.









Touch **Select** again to verify your selected Set Temperature. Touch **Select** again to clear the last Warning Message, and your **Over Temp** selection will be recorded to the Event Log. The Water will be Heated to the selected Set Temperature one time. You will have to come back to the **Over Temp** Menu to raise it above 104°F (40.0°C) again.

Set Time and Date - Once you Set the Current Time of Day, Day of the Week, and Calendar Date, it will be maintained in System Memory, and it should not have to be Set again except for Daylight Savings Time changes. The Calendar Date is only used for the **Event Log** which is in the **Service** Menu and **Settings** Menu. Only the Time of Day and Day of the Week are used for Setting Filter Cycles and other Timers. You also have a choice of regular 12 Hour Time Display with AM and PM, or 24 Hour Military Time.









In the Sattings Menu with Heating Mode Highlighted, Move Left (2) to Sat Time/Date and Touch Select (2) to open the Set Time & Date Menu.

Time & Date (Continued)









To Set the Time of Day, from the **Set Time** Menu Bar, Move **Right** to the **Set Time** Menu. To change the Time of Day, Move **Left** or **Right** to Hours or Minutes, and then Touch **Up** or **Down** to change the Time. To Exit back, Touch **Back**.









To Set the Day of the Week, from the **Set Day** Menu Bar, Move **Right** to the **Set Day** Menu. To change the Current Day of the Week to a different Day, Move **Left** or **Right** to that day and Touch **Select**. To Exit back, Touch **Back**.









To Set the Calendar Date, from the **Set Date** Menu Bar, Move **Right** to the **Set Date** Menu. To Set the Calendar Date, Move **Left** or **Right** to Month, Day, or Year, and then Touch **Up** or **Down** to Set the Date. To Exit back, Touch **Back** .







To turn **24 Hour** Time Display On or Off, from the **24 Hour** Menu Bar, Touch **Select 2**. When you Move **Back 6** to the Home Screen, the Time will read 1:00 - 24:00 Hours.

Check the Spa Information - You can find out Information about your Spa or Spa Manufacturer on the Information Menu.









In the Settings Menu with Heating Mode Highlighted, Move Right to Information and Touch Select to open the Information Menu. The Information Menu will have different Information or Instructions, depending on the Brand of the Spa.

Set Fahrenheit or Celsius - Your Water Temperature can be Set to display in either Degrees Fahrenheit or Degrees Celsius. The Default is Degrees Fahrenheit.









To toggle back and forth between **°F** and **°C** Temperature display, from the **Settings** Menu with **Heating Mode** Highlighted, Move **Left** to **°F** and Touch **Select** to change from °F to °C or from °C to °F.

Lock the Control Panel - You can Lock the Control Panel so that none of the Panel Buttons operate. When the Panel is Locked, the only User Input the System will recognise is the Unlock Code Sequence.









In the Sattings Menu with Heating Mode Highlighted, Move Right (**) to Panel Look and Touch Select (**) to Lock the Control Panel.

Panel Lock (Continued)



Wait a few Seconds.





The **Panel Lock** Message appears on the Screen for a few seconds after the Panel is Locked, and then it goes back to the Home Screen. To Unlock the Control Panel, you Must Touch **Select - Select - Up** after the **Panel Lock** Message Closes back to the Home Screen. Touch a **Shortcut Button** to Display the Message again.

Lock the Water Temperature - You can Lock the Temperature Adjustment so that the Water Set Temperature cannot be changed. When the Temperature is Locked, you cannot change the Temperature with the **Temp** Button, and you cannot change the Temperature on the Water **Temperature** Screen in Navigation Mode.









In the Sattings Menu with Heating Mode Highlighted, Move Right to Temp Lock and Touch Select (2) to Lock the Water Temperature.









The **Temp Lock** Message appears on the Screen after the Temperature is Locked. To Exit the Message, Touch **Back** or **Select**. To Unlock the Control Panel, you Must Return to **Temp Lock** on the Home Screen, and Touch **Select** to turn it Off.

Check the Spa Event Log - You can Check the **Event Log** for Information about your Spa. The **Event Log** records Spa Events such as a Possible Freeze Condition, or if you have had any Power outages.









In the Sattings Menu with Heating Mode Highlighted, Move Left (2) to Event Log and Touch Select (2) to open the Event Log Screen.







The **Event Log** will Display the 12 most recent Spa Events. Each Event will have the Month, Day, and Hour that the Event occurred. Touch **Back** to Exit back to the previous Menu.

Set the Language - The Default Language is English, but you may have other Languages available on your Spa. If your desired Language is not Listed on the Language Menu, it may be available from your Spa Manufacturer.









To Set your desired Language, from the Settings Menu with Heating Mode Highlighted, Move Right to Language and Touch Select to Open the Language Menu. All Installed Languages will be shown on the Language Menu.

Language (Continued)







Turn the Power Off and Back On again.

Scroll down through the **Language** Menu to see which Languages are available on your Spa. To change to a different **Language**, Scroll to the desired **Language**, then Touch **Select** to turn it On. There will be a Message that tells you a Restart is Required to change to a different **Language**. Turn the Power to the Spa Off and then back On again, and the Spa System will start up again with the selected **Language**.

Invert the Screen - When the Screen is Inverted, the Spa Navigation Buttons are also Inverted, so that the **Up** and **Down** Buttons are switched with each other and the **Left** and **Right** Buttons are switched with each other. The **Back** Button does not change position. The Screen and Navigation Buttons are Uninverted the same way as they are Inverted.









To Invert the Screen and Navigation Buttons in **Spa Navigation Mode**; from the **Sattings** Menu with **Heating Mode** Highlighted, Move **Left** to **Invert Screen** and Touch **Select** to **Invert** the Screen.









To Uninvert the Screen and Navigation Buttons in **Spa Navigation Mode**; Move **Left** or **Right** to **Invert Screen** and Touch **Select**. The Screen can also be Inverted or Uninverted in **Spa Shortcut Mode** by Touching the **Invert** Button.

Set Reminder Messages - The Reminder Messages Pop-Up periodically to Remind you to perform the Normal Maintenance required for your Spa. They are all set to Pop-Up at various intervals from 7 Days to 1 Year, but you can change any of them.









In the Settings Menu with Heating Mode Highlighted, Move Right (*) to Reminders and Touch Select (*) to Open the Set Reminders Menu.









To Set a Reminder Message, Scroll to the desired Message you want to change or turn off, then Move Right to the Set Reminders Menu. To turn the Pop-Up Reminder Message interval Off or On, Touch Select to the desired interval and Touch Select to turn it On. If there are no intervals Set to On, the Message will never Pop-Up. When a Pop-Up Reminder Message appears on your Screen, you can Touch any Button to return to the previous Screen.

The Service Menu - WARNING! The Service Menu is only for experienced Spa Electrical Technicians. The options that are available in the Service Menu are only used for Spa Electrical Service, and are not used in Normal Spa Operation.









In the Sattings Menu with Heating Mode Highlighted, Move Left (2) to Sarvice and Touch Select (2) to Open the Service Menu WARNING Message.

Set Water Temperature - The Water Set Temperature is the Water Temperature that the Spa Heater will maintain in your Spa. It can be Set in either **Spa Shortcut Mode**, directly with a Single Button Touch, or in the **Spa Navigation Mode** from the **Control > Temperature** Menu.

Spa Shortcut Mode - Set Temperature by using the Temperature Control (1) Button.









In the **Spa Shortcut Mode**, with the Key to the Button Functions on Screen, Touch the **Temperature Control** Button to open the **Set Temperature** Menu. On the **Set Temperature** Menu, Touch the **Up** and **Down** Buttons to Raise or Lower the Water Set Temperature in 1°F or 0.5°C increments. Touch **Left** to go to the Lowest Set Temp of 70°F (21.0°C), or Touch **Right** to go to the Highest Set Temp of 104°F (40.0°C). Then Touch **Back** to Exit. To Set a Temperature higher than 104°F (40.0°C), see "**Set Over Temperature**".

Spa Navigation Mode - Set Temperature by **Navigating** to the **Control** Menu.









In **Spa Navigation Mode**, with the Default **Interfallment** Highlighted, Move **Up** (a) to **Control**, and then Move **Left** (b) or **Right** (c) to **Temperature**.









With Temperature Highlighted, Touch Select (a) to open the Set Temperature Menu. Touch the Up (b), Left (c), and Right (c) Buttons to Raise or Lower the Water Set Temperature. Then Touch Back (a) to Exit.

Help with Messages and Maintenance - Help is available for various Pop-Up Messages you may see on the Screen, and for day to day Spa Maintenance.











For **Help** with Pop-Up **Messages**, in **Spa Navigation Mode**, with the Default **Intertainment** Highlighted, Move **Up** to **Help**, and then Touch **Select** to open the **Messages** Menu.











Move Up or Down to the desired Messages Menu Bar, then Move Right to View that Pop-Up Message.









For **More Help** on that Message, Move **Right** for additional information, or Touch **Back** to Exit Back to the Previous Menus.










For **Help** with **Maintenance**, in the **Help** Menu with **Messages** Highlighted, Move **Right** (a) to **Maintenance** and Touch **Select** (a) to open the **How To** Menu.

Maintenance Help (Continued)



Move Up or Down to the desired Maintenance How To Menu Bar, then Move Right to View that Maintenance Help information. Then, Touch Back to the Previous Menus.

The Message Screen Background Color will be **GREEN** for an Information or Instruction Message, **YELLOW** for a Caution Message, or **RED** for a Warning Message.

Set Your Moods - Unique preset Moods can be Modified any way you want them. You can preset Pumps and Speeds, Lights and Levels, and which Device you want playing Music in the Various Moods. Most Spas will have a Single Button assigned to Instantly turn On the Preset Mood.




To Setup the **Relax** Mood, in **Spa Navigation Mode**, with the Default **Interfall ment** Highlighted, Move **Up** (a) to **Moods**, and then Touch **Select** (2) to open the **Relax Setup** Menu.




To assign Relax to the Mood Button, on the Relax Mood Menu Bar, Touch Select . To Setup the Devices, Speeds, and Levels you want to operate in the Relax Mood, from the Select Devices Menu Bar, Move Right to the Mood Devices Menu.

Moods Setup (Continued)










Scroll through the list of available **Mood Devices**, and turn them On or Off, set the Pump and Blower Speeds, set the Spa Light Level, and set the Music Player for the **Relax Mood** by Touching the **Select** Button as required for each **Device**. Touch the **Back** Button to go back to the previous Menu.









To Set the **Duration** of the Mood before it turns Off, on the **Set Time Duration** Menu Bar, Move **Right** to the **Set Time Duration** Menu. To Set or Change the Time Duration, Move **Left** or **Right** to Hours or Minutes, and then Touch **Up** or **Down** to change the Time. Touch **Back** to go back to previous Menus.

Set Your Wellness Timers - The **Timers** Feature has three different functions. There's a **Timer** that starts at 0:00:00 and counts up, three **Countdown Timers** that count down to 0:00, and an **Alarm** that Flashes the Spa Light at the Set time.









To Set your **Timer** in Wellness Timers, in **Spa Navigation Mode**, with the Default **Intertainment** Highlighted, Move **Down** (a) to **Timers**, and Touch the **Select** (b) Button to open the **Timer** Menu.

Timers Setup (Continued)









To Start or Reset the **Timer**, Move **Right** or **Left** to the **Start** and **Reset** Icons, and Touch **Select**. Touch **Back** to the Previous Menu.









To Set your **Countdown Timer** in Wellness Timers, from the **Timers** Menu with **Timer** Highlighted, Move **Left** to **Countdown** and Touch **Select** to open the **Set Countdown** Menu.










At the end of the **Countdown**, you can Flash an Alarm (Flash the Spa Light), turn Off all the Pumps that are running, or turn Off everything that is On except the Spa Light. To Set the **Countdown** Time, from any of the three **Countdown** Timer Menu Bars, **Flash Alarm** for example, Scroll **Down** to Flash Alarm, and then Move **Right** to the **Flash Alarm** Set Menu.

To Set the Flash Alarm Countdown Time in the Flash Alarm Set Menu, Move Left or Right to Hours or Minutes, and then Touch Up or Down to change the Countdown Time. Touch Back to the Set Countdown Menu and Start the Countdown Timer.

Timers Setup (Continued)



To Start the most recently Set **Countdown** Timer, on the **Set Countdown** Menu, from the **Start Countdown** Menu Bar, Touch the **Select** Button to turn it On.

The **Countdown Timer** Message appears on the Screen at the end of the **Countdown Alarm** time. To Exit the Message, Touch the **Back** Button to return to the previous Screen.



To Set your **Alarm** in Wellness Timers, from the **Timers** Menu with **Timer** Highlighted, Move **Right** (a) to **Alarm** and Touch **Select** (2) to open the **Set Alarm** Menu.



To Set the **Alarm** to On or Off, from the **Alarm** Menu Bar, Touch the **Select** Button. To Set the **Alarm Time**, from the **Alarm Time** Menu Bar, Move **Right** to the **Alarm Time** Set Menu.

At the Set **Alarm Time** on the Set **Alarm Days**, the Spa Light will Flash and there will be a Pop-Up Message on the Display Screen.

Timers Setup (Continued)









To Change the **Alarm Time**, Move **Left** or **Right** to Hours or Minutes, and then Touch **Up** or **Down** to change the Time. Touch **Back** to Exit Back and Set the **Alarm Days**. To Set the **Alarm Days**, from the **Alarm Days** Menu Bar, Move **Right** to the **Alarm Days** Set Menu.









By Default, all days of the week are turned On. To turn an **Alarm Day** Off or On, Move **Left** or **Right** to that day and Touch **Select**. To Exit back to the previous Menus, Touch **Back**.

The Alarm Time Message appears on the Screen at the Alarm Set Time on the Alarm Days. To Exit the Message, Touch the Back Button to return to the previous Screen. The Spa Light will Flash until the Back Button is Touched.

Your Entertainment and Games

Play Your Games - The **Games** Feature will allow you to Play several different Games on your Control Panel using the Navigation Buttons.









In **Spa Navigation Mode**, with the Default **Intertal Imment** Highlighted, Move **Down** (a) to **Carnes**, and Touch the **Select** (2) Button to open the **Trivia Quiz** Game.

Games (Continued)









To Play the **Trivia Quiz** Game, Touch **Left** , **Right** , **Up** , or **Down** to Answer the Trivia Quiz questions. You get Points for selecting the correct answers to the questions. Touch **Back** to Exit Back to the **Cames** Menu.

Entertain With Your iPod or iPhone - The **Entertainment** Feature will allow you to watch **Movies**, listen to **Music**, watch **Podcasts**, and view **Photos** or Slideshows from your connected iPod, iPhone, or other USB connected MP3 Player or Flash Drive. You will have complete On Screen Control of all of your iPod Entertainment Features, directly from your **Merlin** Control Panel.

Any **Apple iPhone**, **iPod**, or **iPod Touch** will work with the **eControl**, including iPhone 4, iPhone 3GS, iPhone 3G, iPhone, iPod Classic, iPod 5th Gen, iPod Touch 1st & 2nd Gen, and iPod Nano 3rd, 4th, & 5th Gen. The compatible Entertainment formats which are recognized by your **eControl** are MP3, WMA, MPEG, and MPEG4.

Open the door on your **iPod eControl Module** and connect the **Apple iPod Cable** to your iPod or other Apple compatible Entertainment Device (iPod, iPhone, iTouch, etc.). Or, plug a compatible USB Connected Entertainment Device (USB MP3 Player, USB Flash Drive containing Music or Movie files) into the **USB Connector**. Make sure your Entertainment Device is securely inside the **eControl Module**, and close the door securely to protect your Entertainment Device from water.







To View your **iPod Entertainment** on the **Merlin Screen**, and Control your iPod with the **Merlin Buttons**, in **Spa Navigation Mode**, with the Default **Intertainment** Highlighted and the **IPod** Icon Highlighted, Touch the **Select Button** to open the **iPod Entertainment** and Control Screen. When the **Entertainment Screen** opens, there will be a **Blue Screen** Displayed if Power to the **iPod** has not been turned On or if there is not a Movie playing.

Entertainment (Continued)



The 2 Delivery Button is used to Open the iPod Control Menu and turn On the iPod.

When the iPod Entertainment Screen opens, there will be a Menu Bar on each side of the Merlin Screen that indicates the Entertainment Shortcut Mode functions of the Numbered Control Panel Buttons. The other buttons can be used to Navigate the On Screen Menus, Left , Right , Up , Down , and Select . The iPod Entertainment Screen can be used to View or Listen to all of your iPod Entertainment.



To Navigate the On Screen iPod Menu, with the **Side Menus** on the Screen, use the **Left**, **Right**, **Up**, **Down**, and **Select** Buttons. To Exit the Side Menus and Entertainment Control, Touch **Back**, or wait 30 seconds for auto exit. When the **Side Menus** are not on the screen, the Buttons are in **Spa Shortcut Mode**, and all of the Buttons can be used to operate the Spa Functions, like Jets, Light, etc.



To open the **Side Menus** and return the Buttons to **Entertainment Shortcut Mode** Control, Touch **Back** , and then Touch **Back** again to close the **Side Menus**.

To Control the iPod while the Movie is playing, First touch **Back** to open the **Side Menus**, then use the Shortcut Buttons to Control the iPod. For example, touch 9 , which is Stop, to Stop the Movie and return to the On Screen iPod Menu.









The 3 Button is used to go back and forth between Page 1 and Page 2 of the Side Menus.

Control Your LED Spa Light (Optional Equipment) - If you have an Optional LED Spa Light that is Controllable, then you can select from five different LED Light Colors or three different LED Light Shows. Whatever Light Color or Light Show you have selected last will be turned On the next time you turn On the LED Spa Light.

Spa Shortcut Mode - Turn On the LED Light by using the Light Button.









In the **Spa Shortcut Mode**, with the Key to the Button Functions on Screen, Touch the **Light** Button to open the **LED Light Control** Menu. On the **LED Light Control** Menu, Touch the **Up** and **Down** Buttons to Scroll to one of the Five LED Light Colors or one of the three LED Light Shows, then Touch **Select** to Change to that **LED Light Control** Option. Then Touch **Back** to Exit the **LED Light Control** Menu, or the Menu will Auto Exit in a few seconds.

Using Your Nyrius Entertainment Control Menu - You Select and Play your Entertainment by Using the Nyrius Control Menu. To Navigate the Control Menu, with the Side Bar Menus on the Screen, use the Left , Right , Up , Down , and Select Buttons. To Exit the Side Bar Menus and Control Mode, Touch Back , or wait 30 seconds for auto exit. To open the Side Bar Menus, Touch Back , again.







The 2 Power Button is used to Open the Control Menu and turn On the iPod. If your iPod is connected, you will see Connecting...please wait, and then Connect OK.







1) To Play Video from your iPod, from the Home Menu, Select iPod Mode then Touch Select or Right to enter the iPod Menu. Scroll Down to Video and Move Right to the Video Menu.







To View and Play all the **Movie** Titles on your **iPod**, Move **Right** (2) 2 times to the **Movies>All** Menu.







Scroll **Down** (a) to the **Movie** you want to View, and Touch **Select** (2) to start the **Movie**. The **Side Bar Menus** will close in a few seconds, or Touch **Back** (a) to close the **Side Bar Menus**.

2) To Play Music from your iPod, from the Home Menu, select iPod Mode then Touch Select or Right to enter the iPod Menu. Scroll to Music, then Move Right to the Music Menu.







To Select your **Music** by **Artist**, Scroll **Down** (1) to **Artists**, and Move **Right** (1) to the Music **Artists** Menu. Then Scroll **Down** (1) and select an **Artist**. Now Move **Right** (1) to View a List of **Music** by that **Artist**. Scroll **Down** (1) to the **Song** you want to Play and Touch **Select** (2).







3) To View Photos from your iPod, from the Home Menu, Select iPod Mode then Touch Select or Right to enter the iPod Menu. Scroll Down to Photos/Camera Videos and Touch 3 Page 2 to go to Page 2 of the Side Bar Menu.







Touch 9 Display to turn On Photo Display Mode. You Control your Photos from your iPod. In the Home menu of your iPod, select Photos > Photo Library to select a Photo, then Touch Select to View the Photo. To start a Slideshow, Touch Select again. Touch Left to Exit.

4) To Play Music, Video, or Photos from a USB Device, from the Home Menu, Scroll Down (1) to USB Mode then Touch Select (2) or Right (3) to open the USB Control Menu. Scroll to one of the Entertainment Folders on the USB Device, then Move Right (3) to the Photos, Music, or Video List.







For Photos, to Select your Photo from the Photo List, Scroll Down (1) to the Photo and Touch Select (2) to View that Photo Full Screen. To manipulate the Photo that's being viewed, Touch Up (2) to Flip the Photo Vertically, Touch Down (3) to Flip the Photo Horizontally, Touch Left (2) to Rotate the Photo 90° Counter-Clockwise, or Touch Right (2) to Rotate the Photo 90° Clockwise. To Play all the Photos in the Photo List, Touch 5 (3) Play for a Slideshow. For Music or Video, to Select your Music or Video from the List, Scroll Down (3) to the Music or Video and Touch 5 (5) Play or Select (2) to Play the Item. To Pause Playback of the Photos, Music, or Video, Touch 6 (6) Pause. To Resume Playback, Touch 5 (5) Play again. To Stop Playback, and return to the USB Control Menu, Touch 9 (9) Stop. You must Touch 2 (2) Power two times to Exit back to the Home Menu. This will turn eControl Power Off and back On.







5) To Play Music from an MP3 Player, Plug the eControl Headphone Cable into your MP3 Player. From the Home Menu, Scroll Down to AUX IN Mode then Touch Select or Right to Connect to the MP3 Player. Turn the Volume all the way Up on your MP3 Player, and then Touch 4 Vol Up to Raise the Volume or 7 Vol Dn to Lower the Volume. Touch Left to Exit back to the Home Menu.

SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING – Risk of Accidental Drowning. Extreme caution must be exercised to prevent unauthorized access by children. To avoid accidents, ensure that children cannot use a spa or hot tub unless they are closely supervised at all times.

DANGER – To reduce the risk of drowning from hair and body entrapment, install a suction fitting(s) with a marked flow rate that equals or exceeds the flow rate marked on the equipment assembly.

DANGER – To reduce the risk of injury, do not remove the suction fittings. Never operate a spa or hot tub if the suction fittings are broken or missing. Never replace a suction fitting with one rated less than the flow rate marked on the equipment assembly.

DANGER – Risk of Electric Shock. Do not permit any electric appliance, such as a light, telephone, radio, or television, within 5 feet (1.5 m) of a spa or hot tub.

WARNING – Risk of Electric Shock. Install at least 5 feet (1.5 m) from the inside wall of spa or hot tub using nonmetallic plumbing.

WARNING – To reduce the risk of injury:

The water in a spa should never exceed 40°C (104°F). Water temperatures between 38°C (100°F) and 40°C (104°F) are considered safe for a healthy adult. Lower water temperatures are recommended for young children and when spa use exceeds 10 minutes.

Since excessive water temperatures have a high potential for causing fetal damage during the early months of pregnancy, pregnant or possibly pregnant women should limit spa water temperatures to 38°C (100°F).

Before entering a spa or hot tub, the user should measure the water temperature since the tolerance of water temperature-regulating devices varies.

The use of alcohol, drugs, or medication before or during spa or hot tub use may lead to unconsciousness with the possibility of drowning.

Obese persons and persons with a history of heart disease, low or high blood pressure, circulatory system problems, or diabetes should consult a physician before using a spa.

Persons using medication should consult a physician before using a spa or hot tub since some medication may induce drowsiness while other medication may affect heart rate, blood pressure, and circulation.

SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS
