VIDEO SHARE

1. Dial the 10-digit phone number of another 3G Video Share capable phone.*
2. A few seconds after initial connection, **Video Share Ready** will display at the top of both screens. At this point, either calling party may start one-way video sharing.
3. Press the **Key**. It will take a few seconds to establish a video share connection.
4. If you're the recipient, press the **Left Soft Key** for **Accept** when prompted and you will see the live video from the sender's phone.
5. To end Video Sharing, select the **icon**, press the **Left Soft Key**, then **Yes (1)**. If you're the sender, select **Yes (1)** or **No (2)** to either save the video clip to **My Stuff** or discard it. Only senders can save video clips sent via Video Share – recipients do not have this capability.

*Both parties must be in a 3G service area—a **3G** icon and a **video** icon must appear by the signal bars prior to a call being placed.

TAKING PICTURES

1. To take a picture, press the **Key**.
2. Rotate the camera lens toward your subject. Press the volume keys to flip the viewfinder image.
3. Press **left** or **right** on the Navigation Key to adjust brightness and **up** or **down** for zoom.* Press the **Right Soft Key** to adjust image resolution, quality, self timer, or other options.
4. Press **Key** to take the picture.
5. To send your picture, press the **Left Soft Key**. Add text, then press **Key** to enter recipients. To choose a contact from the address book, press **Key**. Press the **Left Soft Key** to send.

Note: To take a photo with the flip closed, press the **Task Key**. Scroll down with the volume keys to **Take Photo** and press **Key**. Images and videos are saved under **My Stuff (7)**.

CELLULAR VIDEO

Access Cellular Video

1. From standby mode, press the **Left Soft Key** for **Menu**.
2. Select **CV (6)**, then press **Key** to connect.
3. Once connected, select the program or category you wish to view and press **Key**.

Personalize your CV Home Page

1. From the CV home page, select **EDIT** and press **Key**.
2. Select the content you would like added or deleted from your CV home page and press **Key**.

Note: You can add up to 20 favorites. Parental Controls available. See box insert for details. Access to Cellular Video requires a MEdia™ Max plan.

DOWNLOADABLE FUN

1. From standby mode, press the **Left Soft Key** for **Menu**.
2. Select **AT&T Mall (5)** and press **Key**.
3. Select **Shop Tones (1)**, **Shop Games (2)**, **Shop Graphics (3)** or **Shop Applications (4)** and press **Key**.
4. Choose a category and press **Key**.

ORGANIZE ME

1. From standby mode, press the **Left Soft Key** for **Menu**.
2. Select **My Stuff (7)** and press **Key**.
3. Select **Tools (6)** and press **Key**.
4. Select **Alarm Clock (1)**, **Calendar (2)**, **Notepad (3)** or one of the other handy tools.

MEDIA NET

Access MEdia Net

1. Press **Key** to launch MEdia Net.
2. Scroll and highlight the content you want to view and press **Key**.

Personalize your MEdia Net Home Page

1. From the MEdia Net home page, select **EDIT** next to My Links to add a link to your home page, and press **Key**.
2. Select the content you would like added or deleted from the MEdia Net home page and press **Key**.



MUSIC PLAYER

Transferring Music

1. You must convert your music to either .MP3, .AAC, or .AAC+ format using the media player of your choice.
2. Remove the battery and insert the microSD™ card* (gold contacts facing down) into the slot at the top of the phone.
3. Power on the phone and connect it to your PC using a USB data cable.*
4. When the Hardware Wizard pops up, click **Cancel**.
5. The PC recognizes the phone as a **Removable Disk** under **My Computer**. Open the folder where your music is stored and transfer your files by dragging and dropping them onto the **Removable Disk** icon.
6. When finished, press the **Right Soft Key** on the phone for **Exit** and disconnect the USB cable.

Warning! Do not disconnect phone while file transfer is in progress.
*microSD card and USB data cable sold separately; go to www.cingular.com.
Requirement: Windows 2000 or later. Not compatible with Mac OS.
Note: The number of files you can store depends on the size and format options of the memory card.

Playing Music with the Flip Open

1. Press the **Music Key**, select **Music Player (1)**, then **All Songs (1)** or **Playlists (2)**. Select a song or playlist.
2. Press **Play/Pause** to play/pause. Press **up** or **down** on the Navigation Key to change the volume, and **left** or **right** to go to the previous or next song.
3. Press the **Left Soft Key** for **Minimize** to access other phone functionality while music is playing.

Playing Music with the Flip Closed

1. Press and **hold** the **Play/Pause Key**. Select **All Songs** or a playlist. Use the left side volume keys to scroll.
2. Press **Play/Pause** to play/pause the music. Use the **Left** or **Right** keys to go to the previous or next song.
3. Press and **hold** the **Play/Pause Key** to exit the music player.

INSTANT MESSAGING

1. From standby mode, press **right** on the Navigation Key to access IM.
2. Highlight the IM community you want to enter, select **Sign In/On**, and press **Play/Pause**.
3. The first time you enter a community, enter your **Screen Name/ID** or **Email** and your **Password**. Check the **Auto Sign On/In** box to be automatically connected in the future. Press the **Left Soft Key** to **Sign In/On**.
4. Select a contact that is currently online and press **Play/Pause**.
5. Enter your message and press **Play/Pause** twice to send. To end a chat, select **Option**, then **End Conversation**.

Note: When you receive an incoming instant message, a "new message" icon similar to this one will appear on the screen.

TEXT MESSAGING

1. From standby mode, press the **Left Soft Key** for **Menu**.
2. Select **Messaging (2)**, then **Create New Message (1)**.
3. Type your message.
4. When completed, press **Play/Pause** for **Send To**.
5. Enter the recipient's telephone number or press **Play/Pause** for **Contacts** to select an existing contact.
6. Press the **Left Soft Key** to send.

MOBILE EMAIL

To Download Mobile Email

1. Press **Play/Pause** to launch MEdia Net.
2. Scroll and select **Mail & Messaging (3)**, then **Mobile Email**, and press **Play/Pause** for **Buy Now** to download the application.
3. Select **Yes** when asked if you'd like to download Mobile Email.
4. Once downloaded, select **Applications (2)** to save Mobile Email.

To Launch Mobile Email

1. From standby mode, press the **Left Soft Key** for **Menu**, select **My Stuff (7)**, **Applications (2)**, then **Mobile Email**.
2. Select a provider and press **Play/Pause**. Enter your **Screen Name/ID** or **Email** and **Password**. Check the box to automatically connect in the future. Press the **Right Soft Key** to **Sign In/On**.
3. Scroll to an email and press **Play/Pause** to download its content.
4. Press **Play/Pause** to delete or the **Right Soft Key** to reply or forward.
