GET STARTED

INSERT SIM CARD

The phone is a Dual SIM mobile phone allowing you to use the facility of two networks.

Steps:

1. Remove the back cover of the device and battery.
2. Insert the SIM cards in the device.
3. Attach the battery.
4. Push the battery cover until it clicks into place.



CHARGE THE BATTERY OR CONNECT TO A COMPUTER

You can charge your battery using the charger or connect the USB cable (supplied with this phone) to the computer.

Steps:

1. Plug the connector of the charger into the jack of the device.
2. Plug the charger into a standard AC wall outlet.

You must fully charge the battery before using the device for the first time. It is recommended to charge the battery for three hours before using the device for the first time.

MAKE IT YOURS

1) Home screen: It is your starting point to access all the features on your phone. It displays application icons, widgets, shortcuts, and other features.

2) Notification Bar: At the top of the screen, the Status bar displays the time, status, and notifications. If there is a new message, missed call or something in the notification bar, you can drag it down to open notification panel and click the desired one to have a view. When you finished, you can close it by dragging the panel up or pressing "Back".

3) Launcher: Touch the Launcher icon at the bottom of the screen to view all installed applications.





ADD WIDGETS AND MORE ICONS TO HOME SCREEN

ADD WIDGETS AND ICONS TO HOME SCREEN


Enter Launcher and long press and hold an application till the app displays on the home screen, and then release your finger hold.

REARRANGE OR REMOVE WIDGETS AND ICONS ON YOUR HOME SCREEN

- a). Long press and hold the widget or icon you want to move. Once “Remove” appears, don’t release your hold on the icon and drag the widget or icon to a new location on the screen.
- b). Press and hold on icon for several seconds, and drag the widgets or icon to remove!




ENTER LAUNCHER

OPEN AND SWITCH APPLICATIONS

The Launcher holds icons for all of the applications on your phone, including any application that you downloaded from Google Play


store or other sources. On the Home screen, touch the Launcher icon to open the main menu.



Press Home icon or Back icon to close the Launcher.


SWITCH TO RECENTLY USED APPLICATION

Double click  the icon on home screen to show the recently used applications.




MAKE A CALL

On the start screen choose , then click  and enter a complete phone number to make a call.



CALL LOG


Enter Phone interface, tap the **RECENTS** to enter into Call Log. In call log options, you can call back, add see the call details.

In the dialer:


Enter number > Tap  > Create new contact.



In the People interface:


Tap  and enter Contacts and then add a contact (see figure below.)

Tap  to add a new contact to Phone or SIM card.




SEND AND RECEIVE MESSAGE(S)

Enter **Messaging**, and then compose new message. You touch a text field where you want to enter text, to open the keyboard.



- a. When you are composing a new text message, you can select text for cutting or copying. The selected text is highlighted in blue. Touch the text field or portion that contains text.(see the below figure) You can select all contexts, copy, cut and paste.
- b. When a new message comes, you can read by dragging notification panel and click the message, or entering **Message** to read it directly.



1. Tap one of the all message thread, you can delete the message thread.



2.Touch and hold message in a message conversation window.


3. Touch **Forward** in the menu that opens.

Switch on Data connection or WiFi




Touch it to On/Off Wi-fi

Touch it to On/Off Data


Tips: To browse the web, you need switch on Data connection.

a. Add a Google™ account




b. Enter Google Play and download apps.



MANAGE APPS

Before you install downloaded Apps, you need to switch on “Unknown sources” in Security settings.

Enter Setting >Apps then manage the applications. Tap any app to view the information of the applications, and you can also force the apps to stop or uninstall the apps.



MAINTENANCE & SAFETY

Please read and observe the following information for safe and proper use of your phone and to prevent damage. Also, keep the user guide in an accessible place at all the times after reading it.

1. After sales service

2. Charger and Adapter Safety

Charger and adapter are designed for indoor use only.

3. Battery Information and Care

- Please do not disassemble the rear cover of the mobile phone, since the battery is inbuilt.
- Recharge the battery after long periods of non-use to maximize battery life.
- Battery life will vary due to usage patterns and environmental conditions.
- The self-protection function of the battery cuts the power of the phone when its operation is in an abnormal status. In this case, remove the battery from the phone, reinsert it, and turn the phone on.

4. Safety Precaution

- Do not use the phone while you are driving.
- Do not place magnetic storage media near your phone. Radiation from the phone may erase the information stored on them.
- Keep your phone and its accessories away from children.

- Mobile phones can interfere with the functioning of medical devices such as hearing aids or pacemakers. People having active medical implants should keep their cell phone at least 15 cm away from the implant.
- Permanent hearing loss may occur if you use earphones or headphones at high volume.
- Use a wireless hands-free system (headphone/ headset) with a low power Bluetooth emitter.
- Keep your calls short or send a text message (SMS) instead. This advice applies specially to children adolescents and pregnant women.
- Use cell phone when the signal quality is good.

If any functions referred to in this manual are different from those of your device, please follow your device.
- Do not use it in a place with flammable gas such as a petrol pumps. The temperature recommended for using the device is 5-35°C. Do not touch the charger, power cable or socket with wet hands. This may cause an electric shock.

SAR VALUE

- Your mobile phone model has been designed to compile with applicable safety requirements for exposure to radio waves. The radio wave exposure guidelines employ a unit of measurement called Specific Absorption Rate (SAR). The recommended SAR limit for mobile handset is 1.6 W/Kg averaged over a 6 minutes period and taken over a volume containing a mass 1g of human tissue.
- The highest SAR value for this mobile phone model is **0.864Watt/Kg** averaged over a 6 minutes period and taken over a volume containing a mass 1g of human tissue.
- Use cell phone when the signal strength is good. Keep your calls short or instead use headset or send a text message. This advice applies especially to children, adolescents and pregnant women.
- If you are using a Bluetooth headset device, please make sure it has a low power emitter.
