

miosolo all-in-one nappy user guide

Important: Please read this user guide before using and/or washing these products. Washed and/or used items cannot be refunded. **Please note:** Bright colours may fade over time. Before using the nappies pre-wash in non-biological washing powder at 60°C at least once before use.

Laundry

Machine wash hot up to 60°C. Do not use chlorine bleach. May be tumble dried cold. Do not iron. Fold back Velcro® fastenings before washing. Remove any excessive soiling from the nappy.

No soak method

Nappies can be stored in a bucket until ready to wash. Simply lift off nappy liner and place wet nappy in bucket. When ready to wash add 15ml (1 scoop) of miofresh to your washing powder drawer and wash with non-biological washing detergent up to 60°C.

Staining

Due to the nature of the product we cannot guarantee that this can be completely prevented. If staining occurs, soak in a hand hot solution of miofresh for at least 2 hours. Use 30ml of miofresh for every 5 litres of water. After soaking, wash in the washing machine at 40°C and give your nappies an additional rinse afterwards. **Please note:** only soak the core of the nappy keeping the laminated fabric out of the soaking solution.

Drying

Pull absorbent core out using pull-out tab. Tumble dry on cold or line dry.

Nappy liners

mioliners help prevent heavy soiling of the nappies reducing the need for soaking and sluicing. Soiled liners can be flushed one at a time. Wet liners can be disposed of in the

rubbish bin. **Caution: Flushing liners may cause blockage in old or damaged drains. No responsibility can be accepted for individual drain systems.**

Troubleshooting checklist

If the nappies are leaking check the following:

- Have you pre-washed your nappies at 60°C? The nappies become more absorbent after the first few washes.
- Change frequently as nappies should be changed every 2-4 hours.
- Do not use fabric softener. This will reduce absorbency of the nappy.
- Check that the nappy is completely tucked in the cover at the waist and leg holes.
- Do not use a double layer of the nappy liner.
- Remove the liner to improve the containment of loose stools particularly for breastfed babies.
- Use sunlight as a natural bleaching agent.
- By adjusting the angle of the Velcro® style tabs, you can alter the size of the leg openings.
- Use mioboost to increase absorbency.
- Check the absorbent core is lying flat inside the nappy.

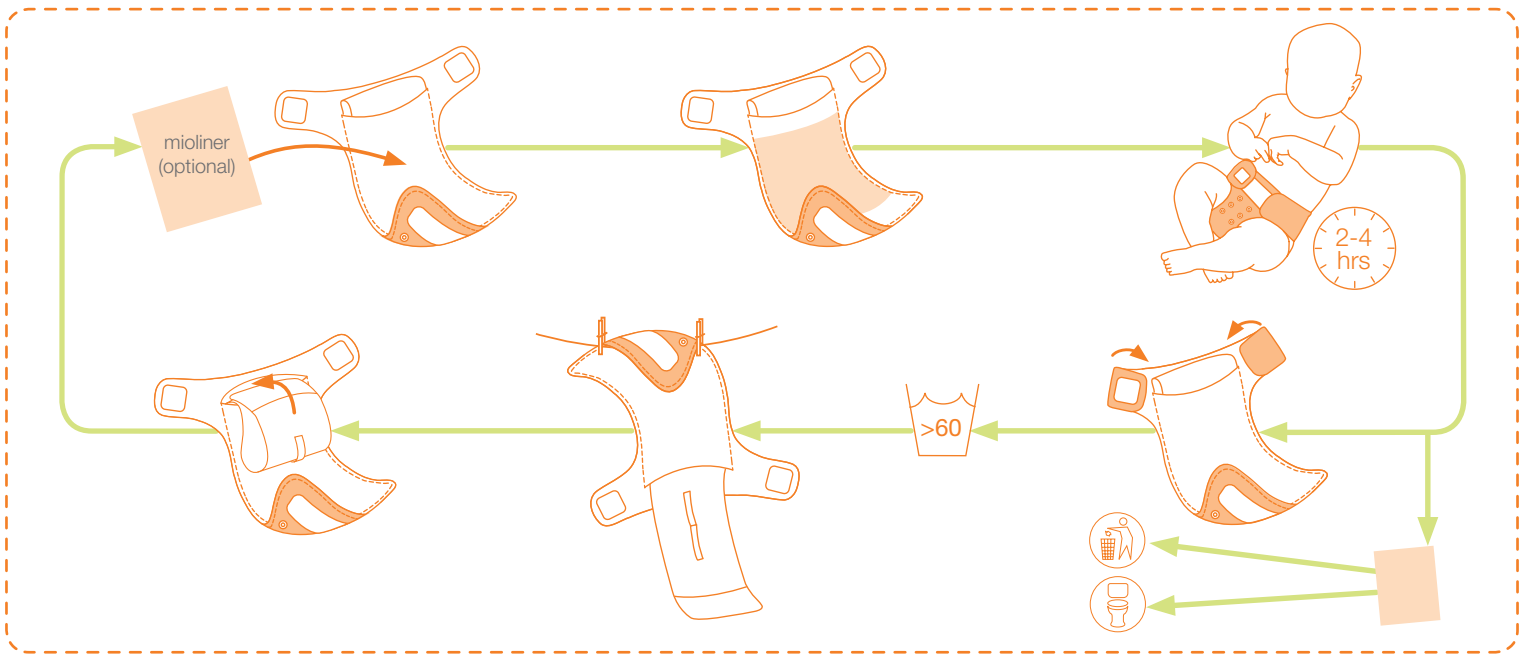

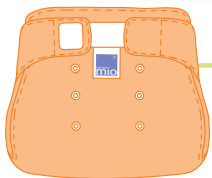

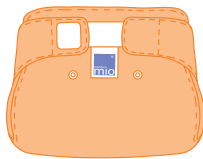


getting started
