## **User Manual**



2.4GHz wireless Mobile AV receiver and MPEG-4 Recorder



## **Safety Notice**

#### Internal rechargeable battery


- Do not use a damaged battery or charger.
- Do not charge the battery for longer than the specified time period.
- If the battery is being used for the first time or if the battery has not been used for several months, charge or recharge the battery before use.
- In order to protect your battery, please charge your battery before use. If possible, the battery should be fully discharged before it is charged again
- Overcharging will shorten the battery life.
- If the usage period of a fully charged battery is short, you will need to replace your battery.





## Connect to AC socket (to charge the battery)

- Before using this product, please charge using the supplied DC adapter
- The battery indicator will light Red when it is charging.
- The battery indicator may light Green when it is fully charged some versions do light Green and some switch off the Red light when fully charged
- Before first use, please charge the battery for circa 4 hours in order to fully charge the battery.
- Charge period is circa 4 hours from fully discharged.



#### **Important notice:**

During video recording or when transferring files, data errors may occur when using a nearly empty battery. In order to prevent this, check the battery level before using this product. If necessary, fully charge the battery before use.



## Wireless receiving mode

- Use wireless receiving mode to receive video/audio signal
  - Slide the receiving mode key to "R" (Wireless receiver). Press the ♡ Key to select the video channel note that, by default, ZedCam cameras are set to channel 4:
    - o CH1: 2414MHz; CH2: 2432MHz; CH3: 2450MHz; CH4 2468MHz.
  - Press REC key to save the video/audio to the SD card
  - Press REC button, to stop recording.
  - After recording, the files will be in the folder: Multimedia menu\DCIM\100COACH
  - The files will be sequentially named PICT001, PICT002 as MPEG files in AVI format.
  - The volume cannot be adjusted during recording and ZedCam has replaced the earphone socket with the long range antenna.
  - If internal/SD card memory is full, recording will stop. Note that the video/audio data is stored in half hour long files, and that if the device runs out of memory, then it may lock up and the last file is not retrievable. This means you will lose between 0 and 30 minutes of data. Hence it is important that you manually stop recording, before the memory card is full.
  - If the PVR locks up, then press a thin item into the RESET hole on the base of the unit. An unfolded paper clip works well for this purpose.


## Multimedia player mode

- Use multimedia player file
  - Slide the receiver mode key to "P" mode and the PVR will display the main menu of the Multimedia explorer, showing four file folders (MP3, VIDEO, DCIM, PHOTO).
  - Press ⋈/⋈ key to select the function menu. Press ⋈ to enter the function menu
  - M/M: moves up and down to select a file folder. Press II to access the file.
     +/-: moves to the selected file. Press II to play the file. Press II to stop play and move back to the previous file
  - During play mode, use +/- to adjust audio volume.
  - When a file has completed playing, it will start playing the next file.



## Connect to external equipment

#### Use AV Cord to connect to external equipment



#### ■ Play video/audio through a TV

- Connect AV connector to the AV OUT plug of the PVR, connect 3 RCA plugs to TV set: Yellow is Video; the White ones are Audio (L); and Audio (R)
- Turn TV to AV mode (external input), to receive video from the ZedCam PVR.
   The screen will display the operating instructions. See previous section to playback a file

### ■ Use wire cable to record AV file (not usually required for ZedCam)

- Connect AV cable to the AV IN plug of the PVR, connect 3 RCA plugs to the TV set. Yellow: Video; White: Audio (L); Audio (R)
- Slide receiver mode to "P" (multimedia receiver) mode, select recording function to record video from external equipment.
- Resolution setting: slide receiver mode switch to "P" (multimedia receiver) mode, select recording menu, press **MENU** Key to enter the Resolution, AV Quality sub-menu. Press the +/- key to select the function. Press **MENU** Key to enter function menu; press +/- Key to select setting; press **MENU** key to select either "320 x 240" or "640 x 480" resolution. The factory default setting is "640 x 480".

## Connect to external equipment


This product supports the industry standard OTG (On the Go – see (<a href="http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/USB">http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/USB</a> On-The-Go), which connects to a Udisk or removable hard disk for accessing and storage.



#### Delete and Copy function:

- If there is a SD card inserted, the PVR will default to that SD card. If no SD card is inserted or if the SD card has been inserted after the power has been turned on, the default memory card needs to be selected. When selecting "copy a file", you need to set the memory type in advance. In player mode there is only one "memory". It cannot precede copy process.
- When memory is set to memory, entering into multimedia player will have four options (MP3, VIDEO, DCIM, PHOTO). When memory is set to Udisk, entering the multimedia player will display a listing of the main memory.
- Enter player; select the file or player option. Pressing MENU key will display "delete, copy to" operation, select ⋈/⋈ key to select option.
- Select "copy to" option, press **III** to enter, will display "memory", "main memory" or "Udisk". Select the appropriate memory using +/-. Press **III** key to complete the copy process.
- Press ►II key to display "all, present and cancel" options. Press +/- press then ►II key, it will display "Yes" or "No" options. Select "Yes" to delete or "No" to cancel the delete operation.

## Connect to external equipment



Gently open the rubber cover on the bottom of the receiver; use a USB cable to connect with the PC using a USB 1.0/2.0 interface.

## Parameter setting

Slide the receiver mode switch to "**P"** (Multimedia player) and the Mode, Main menu will appear.

• Press M/M to select Setup function. Press the M key to confirm and display the following sub-menu: Time & Date setting, voice setting, language setting, memory setting, display, logo, contrast setting, default setting, system upgrade, auto shut down and format.



- Press +/- to select "Storage" Menu. Press ►II key and 3 options appear:
  - "Storage" Main memory, U disk (Nand Flash, MSDC, U Disk), press +/- key, select storage location, use II to confirm, Press ■ to exit. Note MSDC is short for Memory SD Card
  - \*: When SD is inserted, system default is SD card. If no SD is inserted select "Storage Media".
- Press +/- to shift to (Logo) function menu, press ▶II to access the initial screen.
- "DATE/TIME" SETTING:
  - Press +/- to shift to date & Time menu. Press II to enter 3 sub functions: Date Format, Date Setting and Time Setting. Press to exit.
  - Press +/- to shift to the "Date Format" submenu, press II to enter "YY/MMM/DD" or DD/MM/YY, use +/- key to select. Press II to exit.
  - Press +/- to shift to the "Date Setting" submenu. Press ►II to enter. Press
     IM/►II to move to desired location, press +/- again to make a change.
     After you have made your change, press ►II to confirm and to exit.
  - Press +/- to shift to the "Time Setting" submenu. Press ►/- to enter.

    Press ►/- to move to desired location. Press +/- to change your setting.

    After this has been done, press ►/- to confirm and to exit.
- Press +/- shift to "Beep" function menu. Press ►II to enter. This function is used to control the "on/off" key tone. Press +/- to select. Press ►II to confirm and exit.
- Press +/- to enter the "Brightness" submenu. Press ►II to enter. Press ►II to enter. Press ►II to confirm and to exit.
- Press +/- to shift to the "Format" submenu. Press ►II to enter the three options available: Storage, Main memory Disk (Nand Flash, MSDC, U Disk). Use +/- use ►II to select the desired option. Select Yes or No for each option. Press +/- to select. Press ►II to confirm and to exit.
- Press +/- and select "Language" menu. Press ►II to enter. The choices are English and Chinese. Press ►II to confirm and to exit.
- Press +/-, select "Power Off" menu. Press ►II to enter. Setting time option: 1 min, 5 min, No auto-power off. Select and press +/- to confirm and exit.



- Press +/- shift to "Display" menu. Press II to enter. Three options are available: LCD, PAL, NTSC LCD. Make connection with "receiver" and "TV set", PAL and NTSC are TV modes, please select suitable TV mode for your country – PAL in the United Kingdom. Press ■ key to exit operation.
- Press +/- to reach default sub-menu. Press → to enter, press +/- to enter. Select "Yes" or "No", if "No" is chosen, the PVR will keep the existing settings.

#### Settings
