The codes are indexed in alphabetical order by manufacturer and series. This method of dual indexing allows for easier location of code series information. Also, each page either refers to or shows you complete key cutting information. Proper key blanks by the original manufacturer, as well as the Silca, Ilco and Curtis comparatives are displayed on each code page. The proper 1200CM Code Card number, Codemax depth and spacing data number and pictorial Depth and Spacing reference page number are also presented. This information and the codes themselves are printed with easy-to-read, clear-cut graphics by a laser printer. Finally, since these code books are computer generated, annual updates containing newly produced code series can be issued and inserted quickly and accurately in the form of Code Book Updates. Annual updates are available for General, Foreign, Padlock, and Depth and Space Books.

The HPC Code Book System allows the beginner to enter the code cutting business in stages, providing the opportunity to invest in codes for a particular need, such as Domestic Automotive, Padlock Pin Tumbler, Combination Codes, General Locksmith Shop Codes, etc. For the advanced locksmith, major sets of books are available that cover the spectrum of codes used around the world.
