Step 1:

Disconnect battery and remove the front turn signals by using a 14mm open end wrench to loosen the mounting nuts (2) located on the turn signal studs.



<u>Step 2:</u>

Remove the headlight bucket Phillips screws (2) located on the underside of the headlight.



Step 3:

Separate the headlight from the headlight bucket after removing the mounting screws and disconnecting the headlight connection.



Step 4:

Locate the OEM turn signal connectors in the headlight bucket and disconnect. This will allow the turn signals to be removed.

Step 5:

Install the new aftermarket turn signals by routing the electrical wires in the same way as the stock turn signals with the connectors ending in the headlight bucket. Tighten down the mounting nuts using a 17mm open end wrench.



Step 6:

First, connect the turn signal harness to the appropriate aftermarket turn signal connector by matching the color wires appropriately. See below:

New Adapter: Black (-) = Black/White Turn Signal Wire (-) New Adapter: Red (+) = Black Turn Signal Wire (+)



Next, connect the turn signal harness to the appropriate OEM turn signal connector by matching the color wires appropriately. See Below:

Left Side:

Black (New Adapter) = OEM Black Wire Red (New Adapter) = OEM Green Wire Right Side:

Black (New Adapter) = OEM Black Red (New Adapter) = OEM Gray



Step 8:

Connecting the headlight and install the headlight onto the headlight bucket by using the OEM Phillips mounting screws removed in Step #2.

Step 9:

Reconnect the battery and turn the ignition key to the run position and test the turn signals for proper connection.
