Tagging the payment

Tapping the tag this payment form field will bring up the keyboard and allow the user to enter a tag for the payment. A tag can be used to remind the friend of the purpose of the payment as well as allow for categorization of payments for tracking (i.e. concert tickets).

Tagging the payment

The keyboard "done" button will remove the keyboard once the tag has been entered. This can also be accomplished by tapping any area outside of the form field.

Once a tag has been entered it will show up below the tag form field. Tapping the "x" button beside the tag will remove the tag from this payment.

Multiple tags can be entered for any payment. Once entered they will be displayed as a list with the oldest on the bottom below the form field.

PayPal payment review screen

Tapping the "Pay" button will bring up the PayPal payment review screen. If the user is not logged in to PayPal this screen will prompt them to log in as well as present the details of their payment for review.

Tapping the "Cancel" button will remove the review screen and return the user to the friend payment screen with their payment details intact.

Success message screen

If a successful transaction is completed after the user presses the "Pay" button they will be presented with a success message screen restating the details of their transaction.

If the transaction fails to complete the user will be shown a PayPal error message on the payment reveiw screen and prompted to try again.

Paying off a request

Tapping the "\$" button will indicate that you intend to pay this request. The amount will be automatically added to the amount form field, and the tag, associated by the friend when the request was originally sent, will automatically be added below the tag form field. The request message will be greyed back to indicate that it is in process of being paid and it's associated buttons will no longer be active.

Tapping the pay button would process the payment for this one request.

Paying off multiple requests

If more then one request is outstanding a user can pay any number of them by tapping the "S" button for each. As each request is tapped the request message is greyed back and the total is add to the grand total in the amount form field. Each requests tag is also add to the list of tags associated with this transaction.

Tapping the search button will execute the search based on user name, first, last or full.

The search results page will return users matching your query and will order them based on geolocation (if a location was provided to Facebook), with those in your home town or state listed first.
