


#### **Lock Cylinder Replacement**

#### TO REMOVE CYLINDER



#### TO INSTALL CYLINDER




- Insure that spring is in position inside cylinder barrel.
- 2. With cylinder turned to the right extreme (clockwise), align lobe on cylinder with smaller slot in cylinder barrel.
  - Push cylinder into barrel until 3/16" cylinder shows outside barrel.
    - While holding this 3/16" position, turn key hard to the right (clockwise). Cylinder should snap to the right, locking into position.






