### Lock Cylinder Replacement

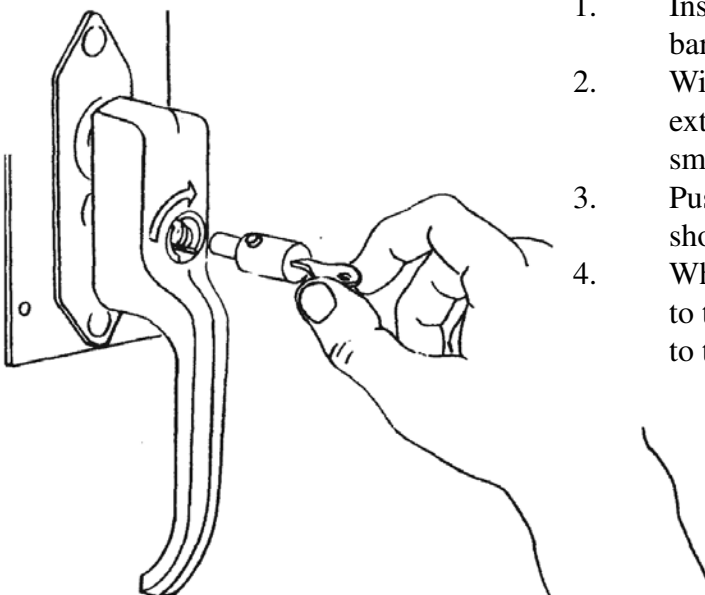
#### TO REMOVE CYLINDER

1. Push in lock cylinder until  $3/16$ " of cylinder is showing outside locking handle.
2. While holding the cylinder at this  $3/16$ " position, turn the key hard to the left (counter-clockwise). Cylinder should snap allowing spring to push cylinder out into hand.



#### TO INSTALL CYLINDER

1. Insure that spring is in position inside cylinder barrel.
2. With cylinder turned to the right extreme (clockwise), align lobe on cylinder with smaller slot in cylinder barrel.
3. Push cylinder into barrel until  $3/16$ " cylinder shows outside barrel.
4. While holding this  $3/16$ " position, turn key hard to the right (clockwise). Cylinder should snap to the right, locking into position.
