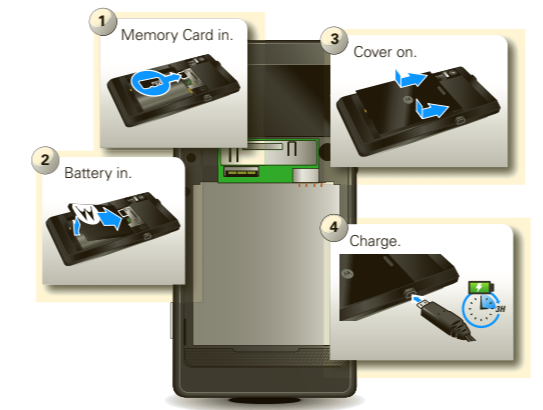

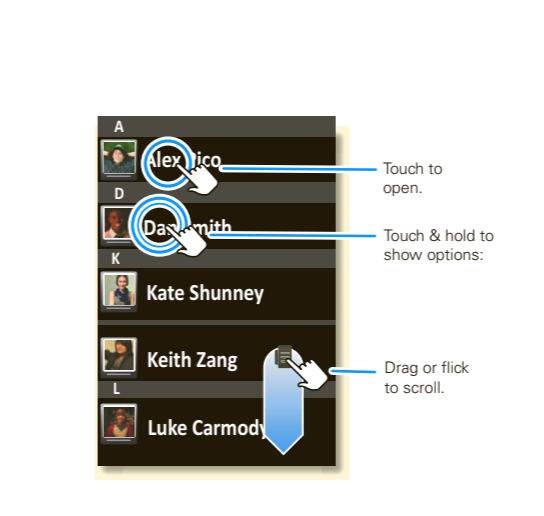

It's all in the touch:

- **Touch:** Choose an menu item or option.
- **Touch & Hold:** Open options or grab an object that you want to move.
- **Drag:** Scroll or move slowly.
- **Flick:** Scroll or move quickly. (Touch to stop.)
- **Double-touch:** Zoom in or out when you view when you view maps or web pages.

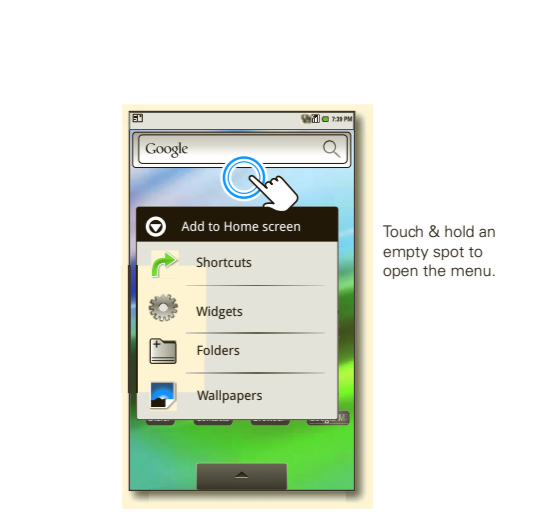

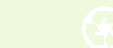

Lists your most frequently called numbers.

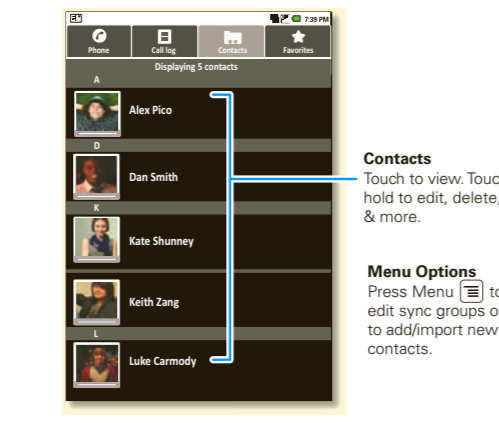

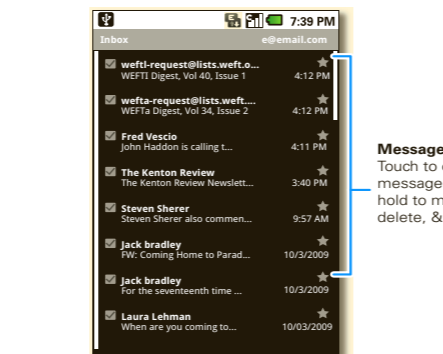
Menu Options

Tip: To type in a message, open your phone or touch a text field to open the touchscreen keypad.

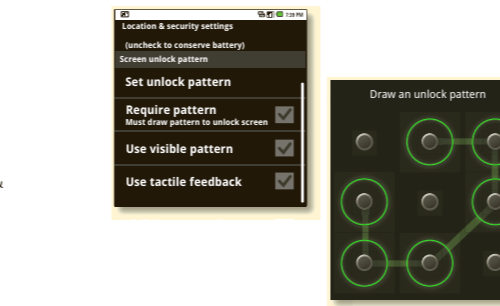


Message List

To see this and other locking options, touch Menu  > **Settings** > **Location & security**






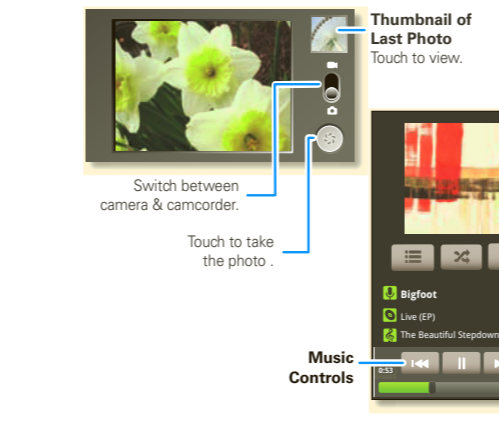
Media

You can easily expand how to use your phone with these optional accessories:

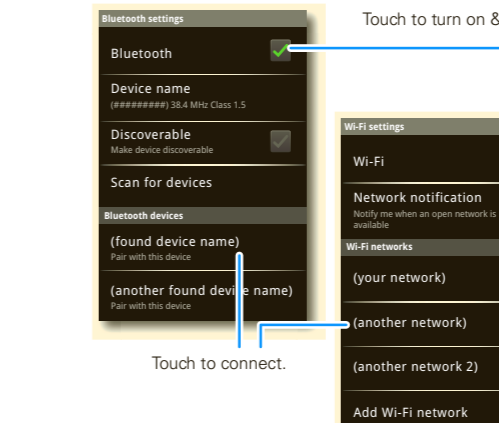
- **Car Mount Phone Holder:** With your phone secured to your windshield or dash, use Google Maps to show you the way.

Wireless
