

let's get you up & running

basics

here are some basics to get you started

turn it on & off

Press and hold of for a few seconds or until the display turns on.



make & answer calls

To make a call, enter a phone number and press **(**.)



To answer a call, when your phone rings and/or vibrates, just open the flip or press **O**.

end a call

To hang up, close the flip or press ①.

basics

store a phone number

To store a phone number in your Phonebook:

- 1 Enter a phone number in the home screen.
- 2 Press Save

- Enter a name for the phone number, and enter other information as desired.
- 6 Press Save to store the entry.

basics

call a stored number

- **1** Scroll to **Contact List** and press •••.
- 2 Scroll to the contact you want to call.

Shortcut: In your **Contact List**, use the keypad to enter the first letters of a contact you want.

3 Press (to call the contact.


ringtones

To set ringtones for incoming calls and for other events (such as new messages), set Master Volume to High, Med High, Medium, Med Low, Low, 1 Beep, Vibrate Only, Alarm Only, or All sounds off. Then, select and assign ringtones.

set master volume

From the home screen, press the volume keys up or down to select a **Master Volume** setting:

High, Med High, Medium, Med Low,
Low—Phone rings for incoming



calls and other events, depending on the detail settings.

1 Been—Phone beeps once to indicate an incoming call.

Vibrate Only—Phone vibrates to indicate an incoming call.

Alarm Only—Phone plays an audible alarm to alert you to events. You can't change detail settings for events.

All sounds off—Phone does not alert you to incoming calls or events.

set ringtones

To set ringtones for calls:

- Find it: ♠ > ***** Settings > Sounds > Call Ringtone
- **1** Press to acknowledge the **Shuffle Multiple** message.
- Select Single Tone to assign a single ringtone to incoming calls, then scroll to the ringtone you want and press .

Select **Shuffle Multiple** to select downloaded ringtones to play randomly for incoming calls. Scroll to each downloaded ringtone you want and press • . When you finish selecting ringtones, press **Done**.

Note: Phonebook entries with assigned Ringer IDs will not be affected. **Shuffle Multiple** works only with downloaded ringtones and depletes your battery's charge more quickly than **Single Tone**.

3 Press o to return to the home screen.

To set ringtones for incoming text, multimedia, or voicemail messages:

Find it: (♠) > **%** Settings > Sounds

- Select Message Ringtone or Voicemail Ringtone.
- 2 Scroll to the ringtone you want and press .
- 3 Press o to return to the home screen.

buy ringtones

Find it: Main Menu > 🗐 Ringtones

Your phone connects to the Web site with ringtone collections. Follow the prompts on the screen to browse ringtone lists and to purchase and download a ringtone.

Note: Normal airtime and/or carrier usage charges apply.

wallpaper

Set a photo, picture, or animation as a wallpaper (background) image in your home screen.

Find it: ♦ > **Settings** > Display > Wallpaper

- To assign a single picture as a wallpaper, select Single and press • , then scroll to the picture you want and press • .
 - To select downloaded or captured pictures to be shown randomly as wallpapers, select **Shuffle Multiple** and press $\hat{\Phi}$, then scroll to each downloaded or captured picture you want and press $\hat{\Phi}$. When you finish selecting pictures, press **Done**.
- 3 Press 10 to return to the home screen.

skins

Set the overall look and feel of your phone's screen.

Find it: •• > Settings > Display > Skins

- **1** Scroll to the name of a skin and press ♠.
- 2 Press o to return to the main screen.

external buttons

press & go ...

using external buttons

With your phone's flip closed, you can use external buttons to play music, turn on Bluetooth® power, or mute the phone.



Note: If the external display is not already lit, press the smart/speakerphone key to turn it back on.

external buttons

If the external display times out while you are using the external buttons, press the smart/speakerphone key to turn it back on.

Tip: Lock the external buttons when not using them so you don't accidentally activate them when the flip is closed. To lock the buttons, press and hold the smart/ speakerphone key. Press and hold the smart/ speakerphone key again to unlock them.

mute button

During a call, press the mute button \checkmark to **mute your voice**. Press the mute button again to unmute your voice.

When the phone is idle, press and hold the mute button \checkmark to **change the Master Volume setting** to **Vibrate Only**. Press and hold the mute button again to switch back to the previous ringer setting.

external buttons

Bluetooth® power button

To turn Bluetooth power on and off, press the Bluetooth button (*). For more information on Bluetooth wireless connections, see your User's Guide.

music player buttons

To activate the music player or resume music playback after closing the flip, press the music player play/pause button ▶II. Use the music player external buttons to control music playback (see the next section).

when music is what you need...

get music

For instructions on copying music to your phone, see your *User's Guide*.

play music—flip closed

Note: You must have an optional microSD memory card installed in your phone to use the music player.

- 10 Unlock the external buttons, if needed (see page 18).
- Press the smart/speakerphone key to activate the external buttons

Note: If the external display is not lit, press the smart/speakerphone key to turn it back on. Press it again to activate the external buttons.

3 Press ►II.

Your phone displays the Music Player menu.

To make menu selections:

music buttons	
scroll up/ down through menu	Press N or I◀.
select menu option	Press ►II.

To control music playback:

music buttons	
play/resume	Press ▶.
pause	Press II.
fast forward	Press & hold ≫ I.
next song	Press ≫ I.
rewind	Press & hold I≪ .
previous song	Press I≪ .

play music-flip open

To activate your phone's music player while the flip is open:

Find it: • > 🎝 Music Player

Your phone shows the Music Player menu:




The Music Player menu includes:

option	
All Songs	Play a song.
	Note: All songs are listed here. Some songs do not have Artist , Album , or Genre information, so that information is not included.
Playlists	Create or play a playlist.
Artists	Play music by an artist.
Albums	Play music from an album.
Genres	Play music by genre (type of music) such as rock or jazz.

Note: If you can't find artist, album, or genre information for a song in **Artists**, **Albums**, or **Genres**, the information may not be available. All songs, with or without this information, are listed in **All Songs**.

While a song is playing, the music player shows the song title, artist, and artwork, if available. Your phone's screen will look similar to this:



Note: If you receive a call during a song, the music player pauses the song until the call is over.

Use these keys to control music playback:

controls with flip open		
pause/play	Press ·•••.	
	or	
	Press Options and select Pause . Press Resume to resume play.	
fast forward	Press & hold · �· right (for at least two seconds).	
next song	Press ·Ô· right .	
rewind	Press & hold ∙Ç∙ left .	
previous song	Within first two seconds of song, press • • left.	
restart song	After first two seconds of song, press • ộ· left .	
scroll up/down through list	Press • ़̂ • up or down.	
turn off player	Press .	

playlists

Personalize your music collection by creating your own playlists.

When you name a playlist:

- The name must be fewer than 32 characters.
- The name cannot include these characters: /\: *
 < > | "!

To create a playlist:

Find it: • > 🎝 Music Player > Playlists

- Press Options and select Create Playlist.
- 2 Enter a name for the playlist and press Done.

Repeat this step to add more songs.

◆ Press

when you finish adding songs.

To delete a playlist:

Find it: ♦ > ♣ Music Player > Playlists

- O Scroll to the playlist and press Options.
- 2 Scroll to Delete Playlist and press 💠.
- 3 When prompted to confirm the deletion, select Yes.

wake up music player

While the music player is active, your phone may conserve battery power by turning off the display and other lights.

To turn displays and lights back on:

flip closed Press any external button.

flip open Press a number key.

customize music player

Find it: • > 🎝 Music Player

Press Settings, then select one of the following options: Repeat, Shuffle, Audio Effects, and Visual Effects.

When you press **Settings** while a song is actively playing, you will see also see **Add to Playlist** and **Background Play**.

music player tips

- Note: Optional accessory required. Turn off the player before connecting the phone to a computer. If you connect the phone to a computer while the player is turned on, the phone automatically turns off the player.
- Note: Optional accessory required. If you use a headset with the phone, music plays through the headset. Music plays through the phone speaker when the headset is disconnected.
