













ring style

Press (♠) > ●** Settings > Ring Styles > Style: style name

Tip: Your current ring style icon appears at the top of your screen.



Shortcut: To change your ring style volume from the **home screen**, just press the volume keys up or down. With your **phone closed**, press a volume key to see your ring style profile, press the smart key to change it, then press a volume key to store the change.

wallpaper

Choose your display background image:

screen saver

Choose the image or animation that appears when your phone is on and open but inactive.

Tip: This feature helps save your screen, but not your battery. To extend battery life, turn off the screen saver.

send a text message²

A text message can contain text and pictures, sounds, or other media objects.

Press $\mathbf{\Phi} > \mathbf{Press} \cdot \mathbf{\Phi}$ Messages > Create Message

1 Press keypad keys to enter text on the page.



Note: Press # to switch text entry mode (Primary, Secondary, Numeric or Symbol). Your Primary mode can be set to any iTAPTM an or tap 1 mode. Your Secondary mode can be set to any iTAP an or tap 2 mode or to None. Numeric mode enters numbers only. Symbol mode enters symbols only.

receive a text message²

When you receive a message, your phone plays an alert, and the display shows New Message with a message indicator, such as \square .

Press the **Read** key to open the message.





play music files

Your phone can play and store WMA and MP3 song files. You can use an optional removable memory card with your phone to store more songs.

You can open a list of All Songs, Recently Played songs, or the Playlists you created. You can also choose songs by Artists, Albums, Genres, or Composers.

When you select a song, with your phone **open**:

- Play or pause Press the centre key .
- Skip back or forward Press $\hat{\mathbf{O}}$ left or right.
- Change volume Press the volume keys.
- Hide the player Press Options > Hide. This lets you use other phone features while the song plays. To stop the hidden audio player, press in the home screen.

Tip: You can listen to tunes on the move, using Bluetooth[™] A2DP stereo headphones.











use Bluetooth

Your phone can make handsfree calls using an optional Bluetooth headset or car $\mathrm{kit.}^3$

Note: The use of wireless phones while driving may cause distraction. Discontinue a call if you can't concentrate on driving. Additionally, the use of wireless devices and their accessories may be prohibited or restricted in certain areas. Always obey the laws and regulations on the use of these products.

Before you try to connect your phone with a handsfree device, make sure the device is on and ready in *pairing* or *bonding* mode (see the user's guide for the device).

Your phone lists the devices it finds within range.

- 2 Press Yes or Ok to connect to the device.



When your phone is connected, the Bluetooth indicator appears in the home screen and the external

Bluetooth indicator light flashes.

Shortcut: When your phone's Bluetooth power is on, your phone can automatically connect to a handsfree device you have used before. Just turn on the device, or move it near the phone. If the device doesn't connect, turn it off and back on. To turn your phone's Bluetooth power on, press $(\mathbf{\Phi} > \mathbf{settings} > \mathbf{Connection} > \mathbf{Bluetooth}$ Link > Setup > Power > On.
