tips & tricks

То	Do this
lock keypad	Press 📵, then 🞵.
open recent calls	Press ①. To return a call, use the navigation key to scroll to the call, then press ②.
open quick options	Press and hold 📵.
play music or games on an airplane	To keep using your games and music on a flight, turn off your network and Bluetooth® services. Press and hold fa until the quick list appears, then select Wireless Manager > All.
save your battery	Press Start > Settings > Power Management, then choose how long your phone waits for the Backlight time out on battery (the display turns dim), and how long it waits for the Display time out (the display turns off).

e-mail & messages

set up e-mail

E-mail service depends on your e-mail and phone network service providers. set up Exchange server e-mail

Note: To get the information requested in these steps, contact your company's system administrator.

- Press Start > ActiveSync, then press Menu > Add Server Source.
- 2 Enter your e-mail address and check Attempt to detect Exchange Server settings automatically, then press Next.
- 3 Enter your User Name, Password, and the server's Domain, then press Next.

If your device finds your server settings, it tells you. You just have to press **Next**.

If your device doesn't find your server settings, or if you skip the automatic detection, you can enter the settings provided by your company's system administrator: Enter the Exchange Server Address (if necessary, check This server requires an encrypted (SSL) connection), then press Next.

- Choose if you want to synchronize Contacts, Calendar, Email, and Tasks, then press Finish.
- **5** Press **Sync** to synchronize with the Exchange server.

set up MSN or Hotmail e-mail

• Press Start > Windows Live > Sign in to Windows Live.

Note: If your network service provider does not offer Windows Live, use the **standard e-mail** set up procedure.

- 2 Enter your e-mail address and password, then press **Next**.
- 3 Choose the options you want, then press Next.
- 4 When synchronization is complete, press Done.

set up standard e-mail

- Press Start > Messaging > Setup E-mail.
- 2 Enter your e-mail user name and password, then press **Next**. Your device tries to retrieve your account settings from your e-mail provider.

If your device finds your account settings, it tells you. You just have to press **Next**.

If your device doesn't find your account settings, it gives you a chance to enter them. To get this information, contact your e-mail provider.

- 3 Enter your name (the messages you send will show up as "From" this name), then press Next.
- **3** Choose how often you want your device to check for new e-mail, then press **Finish**.



e-mail & messages

text entry

Press in a text entry view to select an entry mode:



entry modes	
abc	Enters the letter shown on a key (such as \mathbf{Q}).
Alt	Enters the small symbol or number on the next key pressed (such as !), then returns to the previous text entry mode.
ALT	Enters the small symbols and numbers on the keys until you press @모 again.

- To **delete** characters, press .
- To start a new line, press 🖸.
- To enter capital letters, press . Press it once for just the next letter, or twice for all letters.
- To choose from a list of international characters and other symbols, press @果 then \.\frac{1}{2}.
