## **ROLMPhone Keypad**

Pressing **LINE** followed by a digit (1-9) on the Wireless Telephone is equivalent to pressing one of the line keys on the ROLMPhone 400.

Pressing **FCN** followed by a digit (**0-9**) on the Wireless Telephone is equivalent to using one of the desk set feature buttons (see table on right).

The **MSG** icon lights on the Wireless Telephone when there is voice mail.

## SpectraLink 6020 Wireless Telephone

On/Off	Press and hold <b>END</b> . Two chirps on, one chirp off	
Make a call	Press START to get dial tone.	
Hang up	Press <b>END</b> . Be sure to do this at the end of each call.	
Answer call	Press <b>START</b> . Line indicator comes on steady when the call is answered.	
Answer second call	Press <b>HOLD</b> to put your current call on hold, or <b>END</b> to hang up. Press <b>LINE</b> + the digit that is flashing.	
Hold	Press HOLD	
Take off Hold	Press <b>LINE</b> followed by the digit for the line on hold, which will be flashing.	
Mute On/Off	Press the MUTE softkey.	
Function	Pressing <b>FCN</b> while off hook allows you to scroll through menu screens.	
User Options	Press the <b>CFG</b> softkey while on hook to change handset settings.
