
Using the Interplak® Direct Plug-In Toothbrush: The Fastest and Easiest Way to Brush

6 Simple Steps:

1. Charge the lower battery unit.

IMPORTANT NOTE: The plug blades and face must be clean and dry before plugging into AC outlet to reduce risk of burns, electrocution, fire or injury. Allow base to charge for at least **24 hours** before first use.

Note: If the outlet is controlled by a wall switch, be sure the switch is always on for a continuous charge. Plug the lower battery unit into a live outlet and leave it charging for 24 hours. Use only a 120v, 60Hz outlet.



2. After recharging:

Take lower battery unit out of outlet and line up prongs on base to the opening in the handle and push together until in place. The plug blades are polarized (one blade is wide) and can go into the handle only one way. Push together until there is no gap between handle and base.

IMPORTANT NOTE: The unit will not function with a slight gap between the handle and the base. Make sure that the base is fully pushed in.

3. Attach the brush head.

Attach and remove with just a simple twist.

4. Wet the bristles, apply a pea-size amount of toothpaste, and put in mouth.

Clear gel or low abrasion formulations are strongly recommended to enhance the life and performance of your brush head, but pastes may also be used. To avoid splashing, switch the power on after placing the brush head in your mouth.

Resolución de problemas

El aparato no se enciende

- Remueva el cabezal y encienda el aparato. Si el eje de rotación gira rápidamente, esto quiere decir que hay un problema con el cepillo. Cambie el cepillo.
- Si el eje de rotación no gira, esto puede significar que la unidad de carga y el agarre no están correctamente acoplados. Apriételos juntos.
- Si el eje de rotación gira despacio, esto puede significar que la batería está descargada. Asegúrese que el tomacorriente esté funcionando y cargue la unidad durante 24 horas. El indicador luminoso de carga se encenderá para indicar que la unidad está cargándose.
- Si esto no soluciona el problema, puede que necesite reemplazar la unidad de carga. Llame al servicio postventa.

Las cerdas del cepillo dejan de girar durante el uso

- Puede que esté ejerciendo demasiada presión sobre la superficie del diente. El Cepillo Recargable Interplak® no es como un cepillo regular. No hay que presionar para cepillar.
- Puede que el cepillo esté sucio. Lave el cepillo cuidadosamente el agua tibia o enjuague bucal.

El cepillo deja de funcionar durante el uso.

- Si el cepillo se enciende, pero después se detiene, puede que esté sucio o que la pasta de diente que está usando no esté adecuada para uso con el cepillo. Enjuague el cepillo después de cada uso y pruebe otra pasta de diente. Le recomendamos que use gel de dientes.

La unidad de carga está caliente

- Esto es normal. La batería se vuelve caliente cuando está cargada.


Cepillo Recargable Interplak®: El método más rápido y efectivo para cepillarse los dientes

6 sencillos pasos:

1. Cargue la unidad de carga

IMPORTANTE: Para reducir el riesgo de quemadura, electrocución, incendio o herida, asegúrese que la unidad de carga esté limpia y seca antes de enchufarla en el tomacorriente. Enchúfela en un enchufe de Corriente Alterna (120V, 60Hz) y permita que cargue durante **24 horas** o más antes de usar el cepillo por primera vez.


Nota: Si el enchufe está controlado por un interruptor de luz, asegúrese que el interruptor esté en la posición de encendido.



2. Conecte el agarre a la unidad de carga


Después de cargar la unidad de carga, hágala coincidir con el agarre y empuje ambas partes hasta que queden unidas. Nota: La unidad de carga está equipada con una clavija polarizada (un polo es más ancho que otro) y se podrá acoplar de una sola manera.

IMPORTANTE: La unidad no funcionará si la unidad de carga y el agarre no están correctamente ensamblados. Asegúrese que no quede ningún espacio entre ellos.




3. Instale el cabezal

Ponga el cabezal encima del agarre y gírelo para sujetarlo.



4. Moje el cepillo, ponga un poco de pasta de dientes encima e intórdúzcalo en su boca

Usted puede usar el cepillo con cualquier tipo de pasta de diente. Sin embrago, para prolongar la vida útil y el desempeño del cepillo, le recomendamos que use gel de dientes o pasta de diente poco abrasiva. Con fin de evitar las salpicaduras, introduzca el cepillo en su boca antes de encenderlo.



5. Encienda el cepillo

Oprima el botón de encendido/apagado una vez para encender el cepillo. Posicione el cepillo de tal manera que las cerdas se encuentren en forma perpendicular al diente. Guíe el cepillo **lentamente** de diente a diente, manteniéndolo en la superficie de cada diente durante unos segundos antes de desplazarlo al siguiente. Cepille las encías al igual que los dientes, comenzando por la parte exterior, luego la parte interior, y finalmente la superficie de masticación, prestando una atención muy particular a los molares. El Cepillo Recargable Interplak® limpiará cada diente efectivamente, sin necesidad de moverlo de atrás hacia delante. La mayoría de los dentistas recomiendan cepillarse los dientes durante 2 minutos. Para apagar el cepillo, vuelva a oprimir el botón de encendido/apagado.



6. IMPORTANTE:

Enjuague el cepillo.

Enjuague el cepillo encendido bajo agua corriente tibia después de cada uso. Permita que el agua corra por los orificios de limpieza durante 15 segundos, pues residuos de pasta de dientes podrían endurecer y perjudicar el buen funcionamiento del aparato. Seque la unidad de carga, el agarre y el cepillo cuidadosamente con una toalla.

IMPORTANTE: No desarme la unidad para enjuagar el cepillo. Evite mojar el cargador. Asegúrese que la clavija polarizada de la unidad de carga esté limpia y seca antes de enchufarla en el tomacorriente.

Le recomendamos que cambie el cabezal cada 3 a 4 meses.

Con el tiempo, el mecanismo oscilante del cabezal y las cerdas del cepillo pueden desgastarse, disminuyendo la eficacia y la potencia de la unidad. Si la unidad pierde velocidad, se atasca o hace un ruido extraño, o si las cerdas están desgastadas o dobladas, reemplace el cabezal.

Preguntas comunes

¿Es normal que mis encías sangren después de cepillarme los dientes?
Puede que sus encías sangren ligeramente las primeras veces que utilice el Cepillo Recargable Interplak®. Esto siempre pasa cuando uno empieza un nuevo programa de higiene dental. No obstante, esta reacción debería desaparecer después de unos días. Si persistiera después de dos semanas, consulte a su dentista.

¿Cuántas veces al día se debe usar el Cepillo Recargable Interplak®?
Utilice su Cepillo Recargable Interplak® dos veces al día, o según las recomendaciones de su dentista.

¿Cómo limpiar el cuerpo del aparato?

Separe el agarre de la unidad de carga y límpie ambos con un paño humedecido con agua tibia. No ponga la unidad de carga en agua u otro líquido. No se recomienda poner el agarre en el lavavajillas. **IMPORTANTE:** Asegúrese que la unidad de carga esté limpia y seca antes de enchufarla en el tomacorriente.

¿Es necesario descargar la batería periódicamente?

El Cepillo Recargable Interplak® contiene una batería de Níquel-Cadmio (Ni-Cd), similar a las de las rasuradoras y de los celulares. Para mejorar el rendimiento del aparato, le aconsejamos que de vez en cuando, permita que la batería se descargue completamente antes de cargarla otra vez.

¿Por qué vienen cabezales de varios colores?

Incluimos varios cabezales con su cepillo, cada uno codificado con un color diferente para que cada miembro de su familia reconozca su cepillo.
