


Before operating your washer, READ YOUR USE AND CARE BOOK.

SORT AND LOAD

Add sorted laundry to wash basket. Place large articles at the bottom and distribute evenly to balance the load. Do not wind around the agitator. See your Use and Care Book for sorting details.


Measure and add detergent to the wash load as recommended on detergent package. Powdered bleach may be added along with detergent. NOTE: Because of variations in contents, some granular detergents may be difficult to dissolve. If this is a problem:

Clothes level should be below the

- A typical full load:
 - 3 double sheets
 - 3 long sleeve shirts
 - 3 bath towels
 - 4 standard size pillow cases
- 4 T-shirts
- 2 pair of trousers
- 7 wash cloths
- 5 handkerchiefs
- basket next to the agitator, or,Use a liquid detergent.
- For use of bleach, fabric softener and other laundry aids, see your Use and Care Book.

- After loading the clothes, put the detergent in the wash

SET THE CONTROLS



CLOSE THE LID.

Lid must be closed for washer to operate. Washer will fill but will not agitate or spin with lid open.

• PUSH CYCLE SELECTOR KNOB IN and turn clockwise to your selected wash temperature and time.

RINSE WATER TEMPERATURE WILL ALWAYS BE COLD.

TURN OFF THE HOT WATER FAUCET.

Pull Cycle Selector Knob out to start washer.

- For cold water wash.



The wash cycle setting can be changed at any time. Push in the cycle selector knob to stop the washer and reset to the new position.

WASH WATER TEMPERATURE SELECTION

- For hot water wash,
 set cycle selector to "HOT" (11 min.) or "10".
- For warm water wash, set cycle selector to "WARM" (8 min.), "6", "4" or "2".
