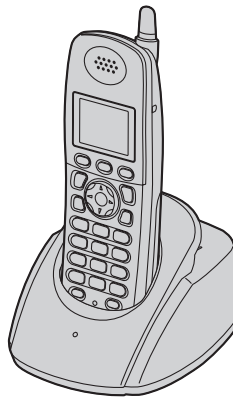

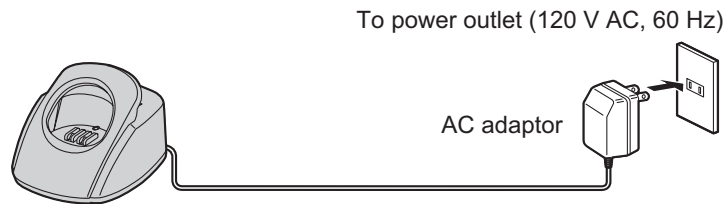

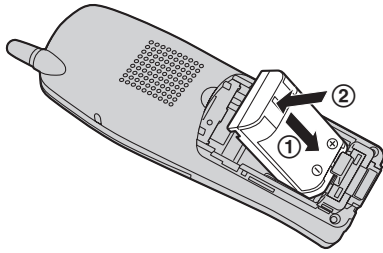
Note:

- Use only the included Panasonic AC adaptor KX-TCA1.
- The AC adaptor must remain connected at all times. (It is normal for the adaptor to feel warm during use.)
- The AC adaptor should be connected to a vertically oriented or floor-mounted AC outlet. Do not connect the AC adaptor to a ceiling-mounted AC outlet, as the weight of the adaptor may cause it to become disconnected.

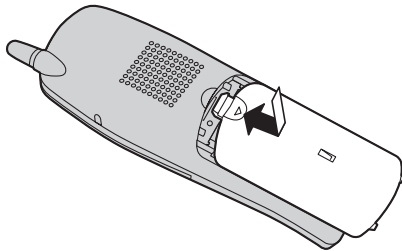
Preparation

Battery installation

- 1 Insert the battery (①), and press it down until it snaps into the compartment (②).



- 2 Close the handset cover.



Attention:

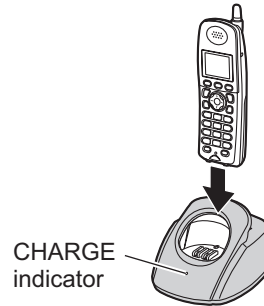


A nickel metal hydride battery that is recyclable powers the product you have purchased.
Please call 1-800-8-BATTERY for information on how to recycle this battery.

Battery charge

Place the handset on the charger for **6 hours** before initial use.

- The unit will beep once, the CHARGE indicator will light, and “Charging” will be displayed.
- “Charge completed” is displayed when the battery has been fully charged. The CHARGE indicator will remain lit.




Note:


- To ensure the battery charges properly, clean the charge contacts of the handset and charger with a soft, dry cloth once a month. Clean more often if the unit is subject to grease, dust, or high humidity.

Recharging the battery

Recharge the battery when:

- “Recharge battery” is displayed or  flashes on the handset display.
- the handset beeps intermittently while it is in use.

Note:

- If the battery has been discharged, the handset will display “Charge for 6 HRS” and  when you place the handset on the charger.

Battery performance

After your Panasonic battery is fully charged, you can expect the following performance:

Operation	Operating time
While in use (talking)	Up to 5 hours
While not in use (standby)*1	Up to 11 days
While using the clarity booster feature	Up to 3 hours

*1 Handset is off the charger but not in use.

Registration

Register the handset to a KX-TG5561/KX-TG5566/KX-TG5571/KX-TG5576/KX-TG5583 base unit.

Important:

- Charge the battery fully.
- Before registering, make sure the base unit and the other handsets are not being used.
- Have the handset and base unit near each other when registering the handset.

1 Base unit:

Press and hold **[INTERCOM]** until the CHARGE indicator flashes.

- After the CHARGE indicator starts flashing, the rest of the procedure must be completed within 1 minute.

2 Handset:

Press **[OK]** (right soft key), then wait until the handset beeps.

- Registration is complete.
- The handset's extension number (**1** to **8**) will be displayed.

Note:

- To cancel the handset registration, please see your base unit's operating instructions.

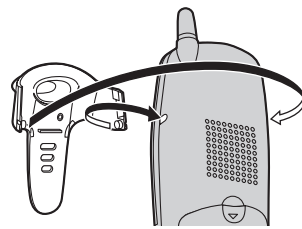
Changing the display language

- 1 Press **[MENU]**, then press **[#] [1] [1] [0]**.
- 2 Press **[1]** to select English. Press **[2]** to select Spanish.
- 3 Press **[SAVE]** or **[GUARDAR]**, then press **[OFF]**.

Belt clip

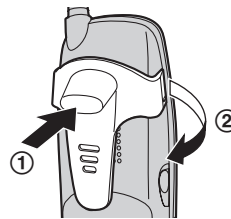
You can hang the handset on your belt or pocket using the included belt clip.

While pressing the top of the clip (1), pull the right edge in the direction of the arrow (2).

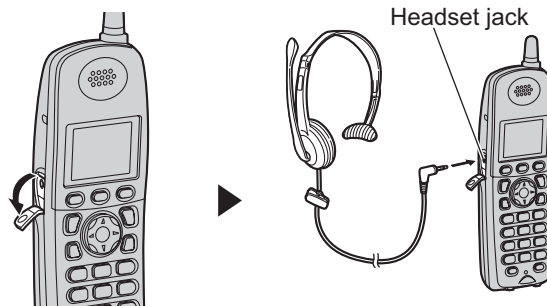

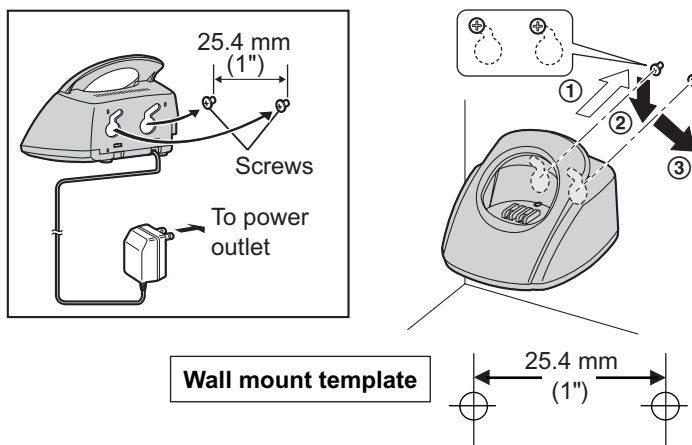

Wall mounting

The charger can be wall mounted, as shown below.

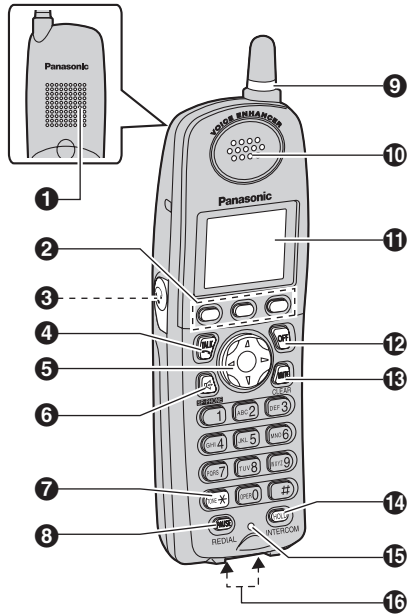
- 1 Connect the AC adaptor.
- 2 Drive the screws (not included) into the wall using the wall mount template (see below).
- 3 Mount the charger (1), then slide it down (2) and to the right (3) until it is secure.

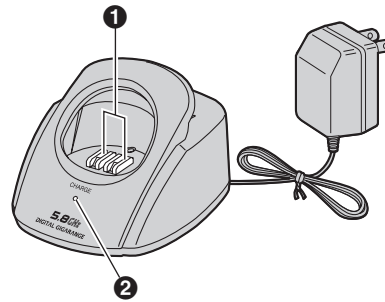




Operation

After registering this handset, refer to the operating instructions included with your KX-TG5561, KX-TG5566, KX-TG5571, KX-TG5576, or KX-TG5583 for details about operating the handset. Please note that the KX-TGA551 has certain features which differ from the handset included with your base unit. Read page 8 and page 9 beforehand.

Using the navigator key

This handset features a navigator key. The navigator key works the same as the joystick found on the handset included with your KX-TG5561, KX-TG5566, KX-TG5571, or KX-TG5576. Pressing each of the 4 areas on the navigator key indicated by the arrows (▲, ▼, ◀, and ▶) performs the same operation as pushing the joystick up, down, left, and right.

Use the navigator key as follows.

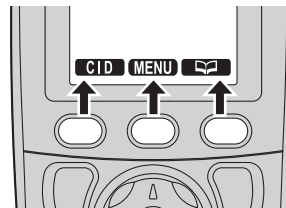
- To select the receiver or speaker volume, press [▲] and [▼].
- To scroll to a menu item shown on the display, press [▲], [▼], [◀], and [▶].
- To select a menu item, you can press [▶].
- To go back to the previous menu, you can press [◀].
- To move the cursor to right and left, press [◀] and [▶].

- To scroll through the caller list and phonebook, press [▼] and [▲].
- For KX-TG5571, KX-TG5576, and KX-TG5583 users only: To repeat and skip messages, press [◀] and [▶].

Using the soft keys

The handset features 3 soft keys. By pressing a soft key, you can select the function displayed directly above it.

- The functions displayed will vary depending on how you are using the handset and the base unit the handset is registered to.
- When a function does not appear above a soft key, the soft key has no function.



Note:

- When in standby mode, pressing [MENU] reveals the handset's main menu. From here you can access various features and settings.

Guide to programming

Available programming functions vary depending on the base unit the handset is registered to.

Please read the operating instructions included with your base unit.

- 1 Press **[MENU]** (middle soft key).
- 2 Press **[▼]**, **[▲]**, **[←]**, and **[→]** to scroll through the menu.
- 3 Press **[SELECT]** when the desired menu item is selected.
- 4 Press **[▼]** and **[▲]** to scroll through the menu.
- 5 Press **[SELECT]** or **[→]** when the desired menu item or setting is displayed.
- 6 Press **[SAVE]**, then press **[OFF]**.

*1 USB-support allows you to connect the handset to your PC and send pictures and songs from your PC to the handset, as well as create and edit phonebook entries using your PC. This feature is not available with KX-TGA551 and KX-TG5583.

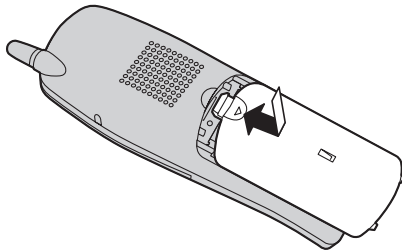
Preparación

Instalación de la batería

- 1** Inserte la batería (①), y presiónela hasta que encaje en el compartimento (②).

Carga de la batería

Coloque el auricular en el cargador durante **6 horas** antes de usarlo por primera vez.

- La unidad emitirá un pitido una vez, el indicador de CHARGE se encenderá y aparecerá "Cargando".
- "Carga completada" aparece cuando la batería se ha cargado completamente. El indicador de CHARGE permanecerá encendido.




Nota:


- Para asegurarse de que la batería se cargue correctamente, limpie los contactos de carga del auricular y el cargador con un paño suave y seco una vez al mes. Límpielos con mayor frecuencia si la unidad está sujeta a grasa, polvo o un alto nivel de humedad.

Para recargar la batería

- El auricular emite bips intermitentes mientras está en uso.

Registro

Registre el auricular en una unidad base KX-TG5561, KX-TG5566, KX-TG5571, KX-TG5576 o KX-TG5583.

Importante:

- Cargue por completo la batería.
- Antes de registrarlo, asegúrese de que no se estén usando la unidad base y los demás auriculares.
- Tenga el auricular cerca de la unidad base cuando vuelva a registrar el auricular.

1 Unidad base:

Oprima y mantenga oprimido **[INTERCOM]** hasta que el indicador de CHARGE parpadee.

- Después de que el indicador de CHARGE comience a parpadear, debe completar el resto del procedimiento en menos de 1 minuto.

2 Auricular:

Oprima **[OK]** (tecla de función de la derecha), y después espere hasta que el auricular de la unidad emita un pitido.

- El registro ya está completo.
- Aparecerá el nuevo número de extensión del auricular (del **1** al **8**).

Nota:

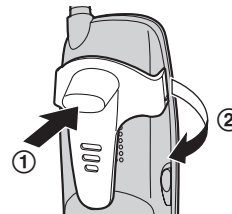

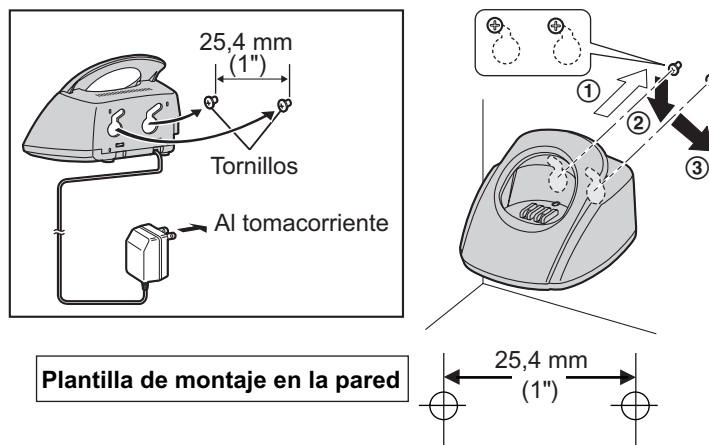
