### **Overview – Multi-Product Mode (5050)**



Press once for current temperature. twice for setpoint. 360°F(182°C).

Lane Keys Press to initiate cook cycle. PROD appears in left display, press a menu key immediately after pressing the cook key to launch a cook cycle for the chosen product. Lane keys are also used to move through programming steps. Press second key to advance, first (yellow) key to go back. NOTE: The "B" (blue) key is disabled when setup for two-lane.

**Checkmark Kev** With computer off, used to enter and confirm programming modes.

### **Status Indicator**

Displays OFF when fryer is off, dashed lines when fryer is at setpoint. Displays HI, LO and HOT when the fryer is out of temperature range.

### Heat LED

LED is illuminated when the fryer is heating.

**Button LED's** LED's above buttons are illuminated when the product is cooking; flash to indicate holding time.






