This player supports "*.LRC" lyric files to support song lyrics display during music play.

The music file and lyric file must have the same name and be in the music folder. The only difference in the name will be the extension (ie: ".mp3" will be the extension for the song and ".hc" will be the extension for the song lyric file.)

If the song has lyrics to match during play mode, the icon in the top left corner of the display screen will change from \mathbb{Z} to \mathbb{Z} . . Hold \mathbb{M} button for 2 seconds when play music. The lyric will show on the screen automatically.

Select **RPL** on the Main Menu. To select a recorded voice file, and then press the Play/Pause button to start voice plaving. If you want to delete the selected voice file, you can press the M button to enter the sub-menu. Push the M button to select "Delete file". Press + and we to select the song to be deleted.

- A: Maybe the battery is of low power. You may replace it with a new battery, and try playing music again.
- Q: I cannot enter the MUSIC mode after using the player for a period of time.
- A: You should format the memory of the player under connection to PC. (Be sure you remember to backup the data in your player before performing the above action.)
