2. Do not use this unit near water.

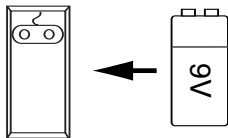
POWER SOURCES

Unravel the AC cord and connect it to a conveniently located AC outlet having 120V and 60Hz only. The Clock Display will illuminate and a flashing time will appear in the window. The Clock Display will continue to flash until the time has been set.



CAUTION: To prevent electric shock, match the wide blade of the plug to the wide slot and fully insert.

If the AC cord is disconnected or if there is a power failure, this electronic clock is designed to continue operating internally (without showing the time on the Clock Display) with a 9 volt battery (not included). To install the battery, open the Battery Compartment by pressing in the tab and lifting off the door. Connect the battery to the terminals of the battery snap inside the compartment (use of an alkaline battery is recommended) and slide the Battery Compartment cover into place.



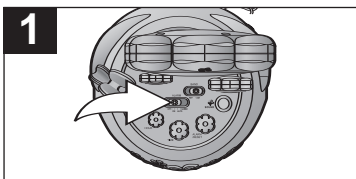
Be sure to check the condition of the battery periodically by disconnecting the AC cord and connecting it again 2-3 minutes later. The preset times should continue operating. If a flashing time appears on the Clock Display, it indicates the battery is dead or not connected properly. The 9 volt battery will keep the internal time accurately for approximately 30 minutes. If the power is restored after 30 minutes, the time may need to be reset.

BATTERY PRECAUTIONS

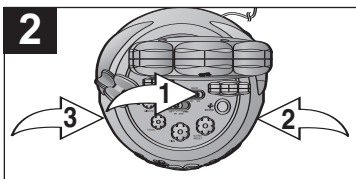
- * Replacement of batteries must be done by an adult.
- * Do not mix old and new batteries.
- * Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- * The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
- * Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
- * Exhausted batteries are to be removed.
- * Only batteries of the equivalent type are to be used.
- * Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity.
- * Dispose of batteries properly.
- * Do not dispose of batteries in fire; batteries may explode or leak.

OPERATION

TO LISTEN TO THE RADIO



Slide the ALARM switch to the ON position to turn the unit on.



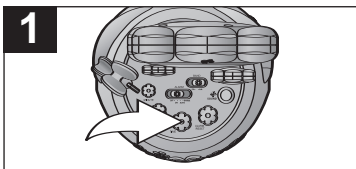
Slide the BAND switch **1** to the desired band (AM or FM) and tune a station by turning the TUNING control **2**. Adjust the VOLUME control **3** as desired.

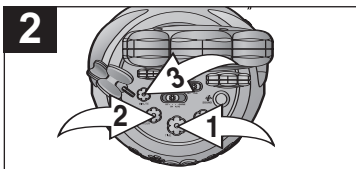
FM: Extend and rotate the AC cord for better FM reception.

AM: Turn the unit for better AM reception.

TO SET OR RESET THE ACTUAL TIME



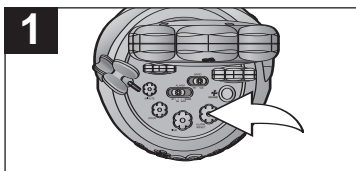
Press and hold the TIME button.



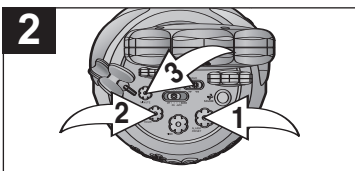
While holding the TIME button **1**, press the HOUR **2** and MINUTE **3** buttons to advance the time until the desired time is shown on the display. Make sure the AM indicator is lit if the time is AM and not lit if the time is PM.

OPERATION (CONTINUED)

TO SET OR RESET THE ALARM TIME

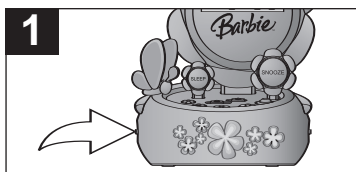


Press and hold the ALARM/RESET button.

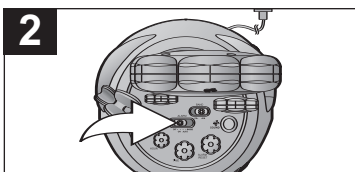


While holding the ALARM/RESET button ❶, press the HOUR ❷ and MINUTE ❸ buttons to advance the time until the desired alarm time is shown on the display. Make sure the AM indicator is lit if the time is AM and not lit if the time is PM.

TO SET THE ALARM TO WAKE TO RADIO



Set the alarm time as previously instructed. Select a radio station and make sure the VOLUME control is set as desired.



Slide the ALARM switch to the AUTO position. When the actual time matches the selected preset alarm time, the radio automatically turns on for one hour and 59 minutes and then shuts off.

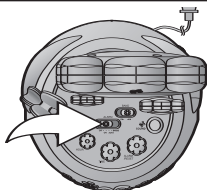
NOTES:

- Make sure the volume is not set to the minimum; otherwise, when it reaches the alarm time, you will not hear the radio sound.
- See next page to shut off the alarm and for the Snooze feature.

OPERATION (CONTINUED)

TO SET THE ALARM TO WAKE TO BARBIE™

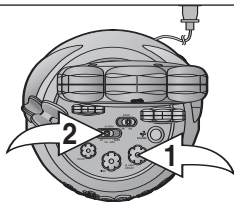

Set the alarm time as previously instructed. Slide the ALARM switch to the BARBIE position. When the actual time matches the selected preset alarm time, Barbie phrases will automatically sound for one hour and 59 minutes and then shut off.

TO SHUT ALARM OFF

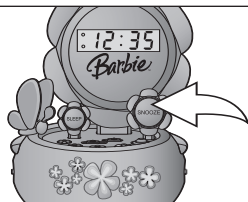

To shut off the alarm, press the ALARM/RESET button ❶ once and the alarm time will be reset for the next day. Slide the ALARM switch ❷ to the OFF position to turn off the alarm and not set it for the next day.

SNOOZE FUNCTION

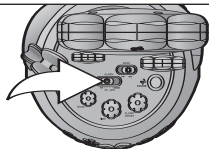


The alarm can be temporarily turned off manually by pressing the SNOOZE button; the alarm will turn back on automatically nine minutes later.

TO ACTIVATE THE SLEEP FUNCTION

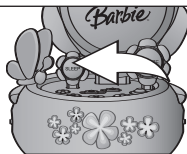

Slide the ALARM switch to the OFF, AUTO or BARBIE position.

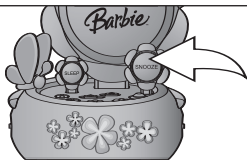
NOTE: When the ALARM switch is set to the ON position, the SLEEP function will be disabled.

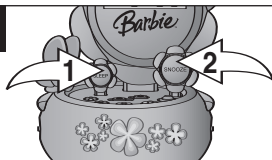
Press the SLEEP button, 0:59 will appear on the display and the unit will come on, then release the button.

To cancel sleep time before it counts down to "00" and turn the radio off, press the SNOOZE button.

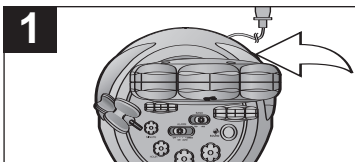
If you press the SLEEP button ❶ again after setting the sleep time, the sleep time will be set to 59 minutes automatically. To turn off the sleep time, press the SNOOZE button ❷.

NOTE:

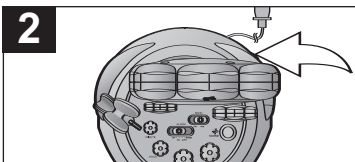
To select a longer playing time up to a maximum of 1 hour and 59 minutes, press the SLEEP and HOUR buttons simultaneously (the display will show 1 hour and 59 minutes). To adjust the minutes, press and hold the SLEEP button and press the MINUTE button until the desired time is shown on the clock display. Release the button when the preferred time is shown in the display.

OPERATION (CONTINUED)

TO ACTIVATE THE NIGHT LIGHT



Slide the NIGHT LIGHT switch to the ON position to turn the night light on.



Slide the NIGHT LIGHT switch to the OFF position to turn the night light off.

NOTE: The long-life LEDs inside the Night Light should last for the life of the clock radio; they are not user-replaceable.

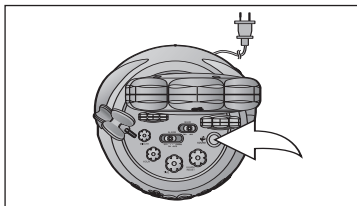
OPERATION (CONTINUED)



Barbie™ has a surprise just for you! Just follow the instructions below and see what you can do with your GEMSTONE FUN button!



Step 1



Press the GEMSTONE FUN (Sound) button on your clock radio.

SURPRISE! With your GEMSTONE FUN button, you can listen to Barbie phrases recorded for you.

NOTE: Press to hear these different Barbie phrases:

- Hi, it's Barbie. Time to wake up.
- Wake up, sleepy head.
- Rise and shine Barbie girl.
- Today's going to be a great day!



Step 2



There are three option modes for listening to the Barbie phrases. The default setting for the Barbie phrases is bilingual—first press English, second press French.

OPTION 1: To hear these phrases in French only, press and hold the GEMSTONE FUN button for five seconds until French is spoken twice; French only will be selected.

OPTION 2: To hear these phrases in English only, press and hold the GEMSTONE FUN button for five seconds again until English is spoken twice; English only will be selected.

OPTION 3: To reset back to bilingual (English/French), disconnect the AC plug and back-up battery for five seconds, and then connect the AC plug again; the default setting of bilingual will be selected.
