**Congratulations on purchasing your new RCA Wi-Fi Internet Radio.** Please follow these instructions to set up and start using the radio.

# (1) Unpack the unit

You should find the following items in the box:



Radio





Power adapter

Ethernet cable

AM loop antenna

# (3) Insert AAA batteries in the base of the radio



Follow the polarity markers in the battery compartment.

The batteries (not included) power the clock and alarm whenever the radio loses electricity.



Use an Ethernet cable if you do not have a Wi-Fi access point.

### Additional requirements

- Broadband Internet service
- Broadband (cable/DSL) modem, usually supplied by your Internet service provider
- An 802.11 b or g (Wi-Fi) wireless home network or Ethernet router/switch/hub with available
  LAN port

For Wi-Fi connections, you may also need:

- Your wireless network's SSID
- Your access password (for secure networks)

# 2 Setup your RCA Infinite Radio accounts

To simplify setup and avoid manual configuration on the radio please complete these steps:

- Find the Setup Information Card that contains your radio's MAC address number (MAC: 00-00-00-00-000) and activation PIN # (PIN: 0000). (This number is also found in the Device Info screen under the Settings menu in your radio.)
- 2. Using any Internet-connected computer, go to **www.rcainfiniteradio.com/setup** and follow the online instructions.
- You will need to input your radio's MAC address and PIN # to associate your radio with your personal settings.

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# Set up the radio

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- NOTE: When you turn on the radio for the first time, it will be in "DEMO" mode. To exit this mode, press preset 1, then SLEEP/SNOOZE, then preset 6 on top of the radio.
- 2. After exiting the DEMO mode, the radio displays the **Select Language** screen. Choose your preferred language.

- 3. The **Internet Setup** screen then displays:
- Connecting via Ethernet
- In the Internet Setup screen, choose Wired. The radio should then connect to the Internet.
- Connecting via wireless
- In the Internet Setup screen, choose Wireless.
- To display a list of available networks, choose Detect Networks, then choose your network.
- To use a known network SSID, choose Enter SSID and then input your SSID.
- If the network is secure, enter your password in the Network Security screen. The radio should then connect to the Internet.



# After connecting to the Internet

 If you did not activate your Infinite Radio accounts, or if the radio cannot get your details from the Infinite Radio server, the radio may ask for your ZIP code. Input your code.



• If your radio has successfully connected to the Internet you will hear a welcome message.

Use the navigation controls to make choices and input information:



▲ - move highlight up ▼ - move highlight down I - move selection/navigate left ► - move selection/navigate right SELECT - confirm selected option or character

When inputting characters, press  $\blacktriangle$  or  $\blacktriangledown$  to choose among uppercase, lowercase, numeric, or special characters.

To insert spaces or correct mistakes, press ▼ to display the Commands list and then press I← or →I to choose the desired command.

#### About passphrase:

- This radio supports secured access points using the Wireless Equivalent Privacy (WEP) keys or Wi-Fi Protected Access (WPA and WPA2) standards.
- WEP keys are either 10 or 26 characters long (e.g. 6e78214a52).
   Some access points for WEP support passphrases (e.g. changing entertainment again) which do not conform to the industry standard and are not supported in this radio.
- If you are using a WEP secured access point, enter the WEP key (HEX format) instead of the passphrase.

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# Using the radio

# General procedures

Turn on/off (standby) the radio	Press ON/STANDBY.
Choose an audio source	Press <b>SOURCE</b> to cycle through the audio sources (Slacker Radio, Internet Radio, FM/AM Tuner, Internal Memory, or USB Input).
Choose a preset radio station	Press <b>SOURCE</b> to choose the radio source (Slacker, Internet, FM, or AM), then press a preset button ( <b>1–6</b> ).
Assign the current radio station to a preset	Press and hold a preset button (1–6) until the radio beeps.
Display the menu while listening	Press 🗅 .
Record the current AM/FM/Internet radio station	Press <b>O</b> . Press <b>O</b> again to stop recording.
Start the sleep timer	Press SLEEP/SNOOZE.
Add time or cancel the sleep timer	Press SLEEP/SNOOZE repeatedly.
Display the time	Press CLOCK.
Set the time	Press and hold <b>CLOCK</b> until the hour is highlighted. Press I≪ or ≫I to choose hours, minutes or AM/PM. Press ▲ or ▼ to change the time. Press <b>SELECT</b> to set the time.

# Listening to FM/AM radio

Tune in an FM/AM radio station	Press <b>SOURCE</b> to choose FM or AM radio. Press and hold I or I until the radio beeps to auto- tune to the previous or next available station.
Step through the radio frequencies	Press 🕶 or 🍽.
Use the current station as the alarm sound	Press IP to display the options menu. Press ▼ to choose Send to Alarm and then press SELECT.

rt playing the selected station	Press SELECT.
rk the current station as a favorite	Press ♡ or press ♀ to display the options menu. Press ▼ to choose Add to Favorites and then press SELECT.
nove the current station from My Favorites	Press <b>S</b> .
the current station as the alarm sound	Press <sup>™</sup> to display the options menu. Press ▼ to choose Send to Alarm and then press SELECT.

## Playing recordings and audio files

y a recording	Press <b>SOURCE</b> to choose Internal Memory. Press ▲ or ▼ to highlight a recording and press <b>SELECT</b> .
y an audio file from a connected USB device	Press <b>SOURCE</b> to choose USB. Press $\bowtie$ or $\bowtie$ to exit or enter folders. Press $\blacktriangle$ or $\checkmark$ to highlight a file and press <b>SELECT</b> to start playback.
use playback	Press ▶II. Press again to resume.
p to the next recording/audio file	Press 🍽 .
p to the previous recording/audio file	Press I within the first 3 seconds of the current recording/file.
