



other hand, safely away from propeller. Insert Charge Rod all the way into Power Port (Charge Rod only fits one way. DO NOT force Charge Rod into Power Port the wrong way). Contact point on Charge Rod must match up with contact points inside Power Port.



Hold down button until charge is complete



4. Gently toss helicopter upward into the wind as shown and 30 degrees to the right or left. (The wind should be blowing toward you and to the side). Throwing the helicopter into the wind is necessary to lift Air Hogs® helicopter into the air.

CAUTION:

- 1. Never mix old batteries with new batteries. Replace all batteries at the same time.
